The TRAIL BLAZER is published each year as a record of the Club's activities and a record of members' hiking accomplishments. In 1956 a group of people who had been hiking under the banner of AMERICAN YOUTH HOSTEL were working on a 22-mile trail. On January 23, 1957, several of them had a meeting to discuss the formation of a new hiking club. They decided to name it THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB. The constitution they drafted listed the following: "The purpose of the Club shall be the encouragement of the love of nature; the dissemination of knowledge of the attractions of the out-of-doors; the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and the sponsoring of other activities incidental to the foregoing."

Following the desires of the founders, the Club has remained faithful to the objectives for which it was founded. However, the Club has changed with the times and the desires of newer members.

2014 YEAR IN REVIEW

The Indianapolis Hiking Club concluded another successful and event-filled year on September 30, 2014. We finished the year with 594 members, down 25 from the prior year. This is the third year in a row our membership dropped slightly, a falloff we anticipated following the death of Club patriarch, Bill Larrison, in 2011. Still, we added 59 new members and the percentage of members actively hiking remains high. This past year the Club scheduled 2,111 hikes - an average of 5.8 hikes a day - making us one of the most active hiking clubs in the country. In all, 14,767 members hiked a total of 89,462 miles. The average attendance was 7.6 people per hike. Although these numbers are down from 2013, this was understandable considering Indianapolis experienced its 2nd snowiest and one of the coldest winters on record, which caused over 120 hike cancellations during the first quarter.

Throughout the year the Club scheduled numerous morning, afternoon and evening hikes. We visited most Indiana state parks and state forests, the Hoosier National Forest, nature conservancies, the Knobstone Trail, wildlife refuges and numerous rural communities in Indiana and nearby states. Many themed hikes were offered, including wildflowers, museums, concerts, restaurants, flower gardens and opportunities to learn more about the history of our great city and state. Eight multiple-day trips were scheduled in Indiana and to out of

state and international destinations. Although hiking remained the primary focus, leaders often tacked on pitch-ins and visits to museums, gardens, concerts and restaurants at the conclusion of a hike. Following a number of regularly recurring hikes, it has become a tradition for hikers to meet for coffee, lunch or dinner. Hiking with the Club is as much a social experience as physical exercise.

Following are some notable highlights from the past year:

In mid-October 42 hikers visited Gnow Bone Camp for our annual Octoberfest. Thank you to Ron Craig for once again organizing an orienteering hike where teams of hikers attempted to locate specific markers in the woods using only a map and compass. Mary Ann Layman led an easier hike for those who just wanted to enjoy the woods. The weather was so beautiful that many enjoyed picnics and the fall scenery after the hikes.

Also in October, Narcisso Povinelli hosted his annual Halloween party. About 80 members and guests, many in costume, attended the fun event, which included a roaring outdoor fire, costume judging and great food and drink provided by Narcisso and his family.

In November, the Club sponsored a "Soup's On" event similar to the "Chili Cook Off" the prior fall. Following a six-mile hike, about 60 people sampled 12 different homemade soups and numerous side dishes and desserts. Thanks to Narcisso Povinelli, Joe Sergi and Ed Wright for organizing the event. Cheri Seeman received the most votes for her cream of potato with shrimp soup (yum), with June Sergi and Debi Cox rounding out the top three vote getters. All three winning recipes are posted on the Club website.

For the first time since 1975 when pets were banned from Club events, we scheduled "pet (dog) hikes". Thank you to Susan Roberts for developing ground rules for these hikes that the board was comfortable with. Although weather sometimes interfered, the three pet hikes were popular and went off without a hitch. We will offer more "pet hikes" in 2015.

On December 1 the Club held its annual Christmas Party with about 140 members and guests attending. The party gives us a chance to see our Club friends dressed up in something other than hiking garb. The catered event featured wonderful food and live entertainment. Thirty-one 2013 Achievement Award winners were announced. Each received a windbreaker donated by Bob Kriz. Six new 25-year members were also recognized. David Kincaid received special recognition for winning the Pinnacle Award for the fourth time.

The Club made its annual visit to Bradford Woods in January; however bad weather limited us to only one Tuesday rather than a weekly hike. Still we had a total of 22 hikers on that one morning. We hope for better weather in January 2015.

In mid-March, the Club held its annual winter three-day winter weekend at McCormick's Creek SP. We tried something new this year by offering two different speeds of hiking which was very successful. Jean Ballinger led the faster hikers and Mary Ann Layman led a slightly slower hike. The weather was nice and we had many day hikers that joined those staying overnight at the Inn. Thanks to Mary Ann Layman for organizing this event.

Once again, Mary Ann Layman led wildflower hikes every Tuesday in April. The Indiana woods come alive in the spring and Mary Ann really knows her stuff. You can learn a lot by listening to her commentary. With the later than usual spring weather, we were able to enjoy seeing more of the early wildflowers. And since there were five Tuesdays in April, the season was extended. Those who came to the last hike at McCormick's Creek SP finally got to see the Pennyworts blooming. We even added a well-attended Sunday wildflower hike at Holliday Park for those unable to make the Tuesday hikes.

For the 17th year in a row, the Club enjoyed three days of hiking in mid-April at Smoky Mountains National Park. About 60 members and guests attended. Although she was injured and couldn't lead hikes, Jean Ballinger deserves a lot of credit for continuing to organize this fun trip every year. Thanks to Jeff Edmondson who assisted with leading the longer hikes.

Katy Smith, Kathy Whalen and Peggy Christiansen introduced "Book Club" hikes, where members were encouraged to read a specific book and join a discussion of the book after a hike. They scheduled five book club hikes last year.

Jeff Edmondson, Mick Parker and Chuck Turner led longer and more rugged woods hikes most every weekend, including many on Indiana's most challenging trail – the Knobstone. These hikes are challenging but rewarding and are attracting a regular following of up to a dozen or more of the Club's strongest hikers. If you would like to stretch yourself in 2015, consider joining these hikes.

Jim Rench, the Club's Trail Maintenance officer, organized four trail maintenance hikes to remove trash and clear underbrush from a two-mile section of the Three Lakes Trail in Morgan Monroe State Forest that the Club adopted in 2013. This effort will be ongoing in 2015.

Consistent with the goal of offering more slow and easy 3-4 mile options for our members who prefer less challenging hikes, the Club averaged about 3 to 4 easier hikes every week. We hope to add more slow and easy choices in 2015.

As we have done every year since the mid 70's, the Club visited Gnow Bone Camp in Brown County over the three-day Memorial Day holiday. Members love bringing their grandchildren to stay in the rustic cabins for three days. Quite a few hikers drove down for the day and participated in the hikes. Thanks to Karleen Huneck, Beth Maschino and Barbie McNeely for coordinating the weekend.

In early June 22 members enjoyed a week of hiking (about 11 miles a day) and sightseeing along Hadrian's Wall in northern England. No one will forget the scenic views of rolling farm country and pastures and the quaint little stops along the way. There are great photos of this trip on the website. Many thanks to Jackie King for organizing this great trip.

In late June more than 40 members and guests enjoyed three days of hiking in beautiful Shenandoah National Park coordinated by Ron Mutzl. This was followed by hiking and sightseeing in Washington DC organized by Jeff Edmondson. Jeff led three hikes, including one focusing on fountains and gardens, a night hike to visit the major memorials on the mall, and a final hike through Georgetown to Arlington Cemetery. Two great back-to-back trips!

Under Katy's Smith's able direction as Director of Publicity, our Club actively sought to provide information about and create interest in the organization. Many members helped represent the Club at a variety of events, including the IUPUI Health & Benefits Fair, the Quiet Sports Expo, the Boy Scout Expo, and the Hoosier Outdoor Experience. The Indianapolis Star, Urban Times, and Indianapolis Monthly featured IHC hikes and members. The Central Library in downtown Indianapolis spotlighted the Club in one of its display cases. Also during the year we upgraded from a traditional tri-fold brochure to a rack card, complete with QR code.

Our annual picnic was held at Eagle Creek Park in late July. About 100 people attended and enjoyed good weather, a pre-picnic hike and great food. Thank you to Sue Bullock, who just completed a two-year stint as the Club's Social Chairperson, for coordinating this and other social events throughout the year.

On September 4 the Club held its annual General Assembly at Eagle Creek Park at which the new board was elected. This was the best attended General Assembly we have had for many years. President John Gaebler turned over the reins for leading our club to president elect Pat Lawler. Member Jim Dashiell gave a very entertaining slide presentation about his experiences thru-hiking the Appalachian Trail in 2012.

Also in September, we honored former two-time president and 40 year board member Bill Larrison with a memorial hike. Bill passed away in 2011. Thirty-five members hiked in the rain on trails around Robin Run Village and enjoyed a picnic afterward at Nell Larrison's house. We are all looking forward to Nell's 100th birthday in 2015.

In mid-September, 35 members attended two day's of hiking at historic Harpers Ferry, WV and Antietam National Battlefield (America's bloodiest day) where we walked the hallowed grounds where 22,000 men fell during a 12-hour period in September 1862.

Being part of the Indianapolis Hiking Club is often a springboard to other great adventures. This past year many of our members hiked on their own and with other organizations to exciting destinations all over the world, including the John Muir Trail, the Appalachian Trail, Scotland and the Grand Canyon. When they return, we enjoy sharing their adventures.

The Club will celebrate its 58th anniversary on January 23, 2015. We finished the year with 80 people who have been active members for 25 or more years. Nell Larrison has the longest tenure with 51 years. Seventeen people have been active for more than 40 years. Our 25-year members represent the backbone and history of our club. Take time to remember several long-term members who passed away this past year, including Tom Fritch, John "Big John" O'Drain, JC Overton, George Newhall, Becky McKibben and Win Pulsifer.

Our new year is off to a great start. The October/November 2014 hike schedule is one of our biggest yet, offering a wide variety of hikes. We expect to schedule more than 2,000 hikes again this year. Extended trips are already planned for Turkey Run in November 2014, Rio Grande Valley, TX in late February, Spring Mill SP in March, Smoky Mountains NP in April, Gnow Bone Camp in May, and Rocky Mountain National Park, CO in September. Also, this winter we will be featuring a number of hikes in Florida for winter snowbirds. As we do every year, the Club will host a Christmas Party, Club Picnic, General Assembly and Oktoberfest.

Hiking with our Club is not just great exercise it is a great opportunity to interact with old and new friends. As one member put it "Hiking is better than therapy". We hope to see you, your family and friends on many hikes this coming year. Make it a point to bring in at least one new member this year. As we all know you will be doing them a favor. We would also encourage everyone to consider leading hikes. We need new ideas and leaders and everyone enjoys a new hike.
