The TRAIL BLAZER is published each year as a record of the Club's activities and a record of members' hiking accomplishments. In 1956 a group of people who had been hiking under the banner of AMERICAN YOUTH HOSTEL were working on a 22-mile trail. On January 23, 1957, several of them had a meeting to discuss the formation of a new hiking club. They decided to name it THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB. The constitution they drafted listed the following: "The purpose of the Club shall be the encouragement of the love of nature; the dissemination of knowledge of the attractions of the out-of-doors; the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and the sponsoring of other activities incidental to the foregoing."

Following the desires of the founders, the Club has remained faithful to the objectives for which it was founded. However, the Club has changed with the times and the desires of newer members.

2015 YEAR IN REVIEW

The Indianapolis Hiking Club concluded another successful and event-filled year on September 30, 2015. We finished the year with 570 members, down 24 from the prior year. This continues the slight downward trend in our membership in recent years. Still, we added 52 new members and the percentage of our members actively hiking is up. This past year the Club scheduled 2,037 hikes - an average of 5.6 hikes a day. This was the sixth year in a row that the Club had more than 2,000 hikes, making us one of the most active hiking clubs in the country. In aggregate, 15,131 members hiked a total of 88,747 miles. The average attendance was 7.4 people per hike. The overall hiking statistics are comparable to last year.

Throughout the year the Club scheduled numerous morning, afternoon and evening hikes. We visited most Indiana state parks and state forests, the Hoosier National Forest, nature conservancies, the Knobstone Trail, wildlife refuges and numerous rural communities in Indiana and nearby states. Many themed hikes were offered, including wildflowers, museums, concerts, restaurants, flower gardens and opportunities to learn more about the history of our great city and state. Six multiple-day trips were scheduled in Indiana and other states. Although hiking remained the primary focus, leaders often tacked on pitch-ins and visits to museums, gardens,

concerts and restaurants at the conclusion of a hike. Following a number of regularly recurring hikes, it has become a tradition for hikers to meet for coffee, lunch or dinner. Hiking with the Club is as much a social experience as physical exercise.

Following are some notable highlights from the past year:

October in Brown County, IN at Gnaw Bone Camp just cannot be beat especially when the weather is warm and sunny and the leaves are beginning to turn. Thirty-four hikers enjoyed the day with David Kincaid leading the long hike and Mary Ann Layman leading the short hike. Many hikers enjoyed picnics and visiting after the hike.

On the third Saturday in October, Narcisso Povinelli hosted his annual Halloween party. About 70 people, many in costume, attended this fun event, which included a roaring outdoor fire, costume judging and great food and drink provided by Narcisso and his family.

The first weekend in November we visited Turkey Run State Park, the first time the Club scheduled an overnight at this popular park. Weather was cool but sunny with frost and some slippery footing in the morning. Ed Wright led the long hikes and Mary Ann Layman led the short hikes. We had 52 hikers for Saturday morning's hikes and 54 hikers in the afternoon and 28 hikers on Sunday morning. Those who stayed overnight at the Inn enjoyed local restaurants and games of cards and dominos.

Also in early November, the Club sponsored a "Hot Dog Roast" similar to the "Soups On" and "Chili Cook Off" events the prior two autumns. Following a six-mile hike around the Del Webb Britton Falls neighborhood, about 50 people enjoyed hot dogs and brats and all the fixings, plus numerous side dishes and desserts. Thanks to the Wright's for opening up their home for the event; Narcisso Povinelli who provided much of the food, drinks and setups; and Joe Sergi who brought homemade sides and did all the cooking. The fall weather provided a perfect afternoon and everyone enjoyed sitting outside.

On December 7 our annual Christmas Party on December drew almost 150 people. It is always a fun event and a chance to socialize with our friends at a non-hiking venue. Social Committee chairperson Jo Anne Starzyk and her helpers did a wonderful job decorating the hall and tables and providing door prizes. As usual, the food was great and there was lots of it. Forty-three 2014 Achievement Award winners were recognized, including David Kincaid who received the Pinnacle Award for winning four different awards for the sixth time. Bob Kriz donated high quality fleece vests to all the award winners. Thanks also to the many members who brought foodstuffs that were donated to a local food-bank.

A total of 74 hikers enjoyed the Club's annual visit to Bradford Woods on Tuesdays in January and the weather was much better than in 2014. These woods are uniquely beautiful in the winter. We had two cold but nice Tuesdays and one Tuesday of warm, sunny weather. As much a tradition as the hike, many of the hikers enjoyed lunch after the hike at either Po's or Gray's cafeteria.

Jean Ballinger orchestrated a weeklong trip between February 22-27 to the Rio Grande Valley in Texas, that attracted 50 people. Although Jean was nursing a broken ankle and was unable to hike, she organized the entire week and participated in all of the non-hiking activities. Jill McFall and Ricki Jo Hoffmann ably led the hikes on Jean's behalf. Although the weather did not always cooperate, morning and afternoon hikes were held in three Texas State Parks, several wildlife refuges, a national battlefield and South Padre Island including the beach. Social activities included a visit to Progreso Mexico, a boat ride on the Rio Grand River, a shrimp boat tour and shrimp boil and a variety of seafood, Mexican, BBQ and American restaurants. Jean is a master at putting together a jam packed week that will be long remembered.

Nell Larrison, matriarch of the Indianapolis Hiking Club, celebrated her 100th birthday. Nell and her late husband Bill were the beloved "leaders "of our club for 40 years. They always said the members were their children since they had none of their own, and they treated us as such. On Sunday morning March 15 we set out in Speedway for a 5-mile hike. We returned to MCL and gathered in a large room and did an amazing job

of being quiet. When Nell arrived with the Tiptons, we greeted her with "Happy Birthday to You". Boy, was she surprised and delighted to see us there. Forty-nine members enjoyed eating and talking with Nell.

March 20-22 was the Club's annual winter weekend once again at Spring Mill State Park. The weather was nice and we had many day hikers joining those that were staying the weekend at the Inn. This year we saw many more early spring wildflowers in the park that added pleasure to our hikes. Thank you Mary Ann Layman for coordinating this very popular weekend.

As we do every year on Tuesdays in April, Mary Ann Layman led wildflower hikes that usually draw a big crowd. In 2015 we visited Holliday Park, McCormick's Creek SP, Mounds SP and the west side of Eagle Creek. Under Mary Ann's expert tutelage, some of the hikers are really beginning to know their spring wildflowers. Unfortunately, a planned Sunday wildflower hike for those unable to make the Tuesday hikes had to be cancelled due to heavy rain. We will try again in 2016.

As we have for the past 18 years, the Club enjoyed three days of hiking in mid-April at Smoky Mountains National Park. Over 50 members and guests made the trip. A major highlight were two hikes on the same day to the top of Mt Laconte; Jeff Edmondson led a faster hike for stronger hikers, and Jim Shoufler led a second slower hike to the top. Although it was a major challenge for many, a number of hikers on Jim's hike were proud to make it to the top for the first time. As always, many thanks to Jean Ballinger who organized the three-day event for the 18th year in a row.

Memorial Day Weekend at Gnaw Bone Camp was enjoyed by many day hikers as well as those staying in the rustic cabins. This weekend gives many wonderful memories for Club members and their grandchildren and even great grandchildren. Long and short hikes were led by Jean Ballinger, David Kincaid, Marti Applegate, Bill Boyd, and Mary Ann Layman. Thanks again to Karleen Huneck, Beth Maschino, and Barbie McNeely for coordinating the weekend.

The annual picnic was held on July 25th at Shelter A in Eagle Creek Park. About 100 members and guests attended and the weather was prefect. People brought their favorite food to share and the Club provided fried chicken and drinks. Ed Wright and Mary Ann Layman led hikes before the meal. Many members brought surplus hiking equipment to trade or give away, which proved very successful. Thank you to Jo Anne Starzyk for coordinating this and other social events throughout the year.

On September 2nd the Club held its annual General Assembly at the Earth Discovery Center in Eagle Creek Park during which the new board was elected. Outgoing president, Pat Lawler welcomed incoming president John Gaebler. After the election, Chuck Turner and Jeff Edmondson gave a very informative and fun presentation on their recent backpacking adventures and how dramatically equipment has changed and gotten much smaller during the past ten years. Thanks to all the board members who brought snacks to the meeting.

In early September, Narcisso Povinelli organized a trip to Rocky Mountain National Park in Colorado, the third time he has done so in the last ten years. Fifty-five members and guests enjoyed themselves. In all, there were 14 hikes led by Narcisso, Jean Ballinger, Ron Mutzl and Jeff Edmondson. There were many memorable incidents, including an encounter with a bear inside a cabin while hikers were inside, many elk and deer up front and very personal, and beautiful fall scenery.

Also in September, similar to an event we did in 2014 we honored former two-time president and 40 year board member Bill Larrison with a memorial hike. Bill passed away in 2011. Members hiked around Robin Run Village and enjoyed a picnic afterward at Nell Larrison's house.

Consistent with the Club's goal of offering more slow and easy hike options, we averaged 3 to 4 such hikes each week throughout the year. The downtown Indy Cultural Trail hike every Wednesday and Marsha Hutchins Crown Hill Cemetery hikes are especially popular, often drawing 20 or more people.

In 2014 we held our first pet (dog) hike since 1975. This past year, five more pet hikes were scheduled. Although the attendance has not been large, the participants and dogs all seem to have a great time.

Also started in 2014, Book Club hikes have become quite popular. This past year we averaged a Book Club hike every month. Suggested books are published in the schedule at least a month before the hike, with an orchestrated book discussion, either before, after or during the hike. The number of participants and leaders continues to grow. Thanks to Kathy Whalen and Katy Smith for continuing to organize these hikes and encourage new leaders.

Under Mike Khalil's direction as Director of Publicity, our Club actively sought to provide information about and create interest in the organization. Many members helped represent the Club at a variety of events, including the IUPUI Health & Benefits Fair, the Quiet Sports Expo, the Hoosier Outdoor Experience, and several other employer wellness fairs. The rack card we began using last year in place of the tri-fold brochure has proved quite popular at these events and we have already needed to print a new supply. The Indianapolis Star, Urban Times, and Indianapolis Monthly featured articles on IHC hikes and members.

Regarding the Club's conservation activities, we have continued trail maintenance of the Three Lakes Trail in the Morgan Monroe State Forest that the Club adopted in 2014, by doing periodic brush clearing, trash pickup, and clearing some steel rebar from the trail. Beginning in 2016 we have also adopted the Coffer Dam Trail in Eagle Creek Park. In return for our work on the trail, the Club will receive credit towards fees for our events at the park, like the annual picnic. Watch a Yahoo groups email, Facebook page notice, and the schedule for planned work on the Coffer Dam Trail. We encourage all members to give something back to the trails we all enjoy by volunteering for trail building or maintenance. The Hoosier Hiking Council has volunteer opportunities every month. The location, time, and scope of their work can be found on their website. Also, Eagle Creek Park has opportunities for volunteers the first Saturday of every month at 9 a.m. at the Ornithology Center. They do training on several subjects that benefit the park. Please remember to submit the Trail Maintenance form on our website to report your volunteer work.

We have also become quite concerned about the plight of our state forests. With losses from the ash borer beetle, construction of I-69, and the lumber industries cutting in our state forests, the impact has been significant. The Forestry Division of the DNR is selling our trees to partially cover budget cuts. Planned cutting is up significantly from past years. The Forestry Division's mission statement says that they are to "Preserve and Protect" our forest. Living in a major metropolitan area it may not seem like its a big deal, but if you visit Morgan Monroe State Forest, the Knobstone Trail, Yellowood State Forest, or take a drive down around Scottsburg and Paoli, you are likely to be shocked by what you see. These are our forests and a treasure of our state. We encourage you to get involved in protecting our forests by visiting the Hoosier Forest Alliance website. They have some great ideas on how to help and can direct your efforts in the right direction. Thanks for your continued support of our conservation efforts.

Many of our members had exciting hiking adventures outside of the Club. We enjoy reliving their experiences when they return. Notably, several of our members hiked portions of the Appalachian trail. One member through hiked it for the third time. Five members hiked the 170-mile Tahoe Rim Trail in California. Many of us enjoyed following the progress of three of our lady members – Mary Bruss, Kathy Hough and Kae Ramey – as they hiked the 500-mile Camino de Santiago pilgrimage across northern Spain this past summer. We posted photos of their journey on our website as they progressed.

The Indianapolis Hiking Club will celebrate its 59th anniversary on January 23, 2016. We finished the year with 85 members who have been active for 25 or more years. Nell Larrison has the longest tenure with 52 years. Nineteen people, most of who no longer hike, have been members for more than 40 years. Our long-term members are the backbone and history of our club. See who they are on the "About Us" page on our Club website. Take a few moments to remember long-term members who passed away this past year, including Len Behling, Karey Brooks, Bob Davis, Cliff Hoard, Adena Rynerson and Betty Steed.

Our new year should be very exciting. To help celebrate Indiana's bicentennial and the 100th anniversary of Indiana's first state park, we have hikes planned in all 25 Indiana state parks during 2016. A special Bicentennial logo and new logo merchandize is available, along with State Park Passports which will allow members to record their attendance on the state park hikes. As exciting as the Bicentennial hike series will be, once again there will be more than 2,000 other hikes to choose from. Extended trips are planned for Tucson, AZ in March, Smoky Mountains NP in April, Gnaw Bone Camp in May, and Michigan's Upper Peninsula in

September. Several overnights are also planned in conjunction with the Bicentennial hikes, including Indiana Dunes State Park, New Harmony, Lincoln State Park and Falls of the Ohio State Park. Florida hikes will be on the schedule for our winter snowbirds. As always, we will also host a Christmas Party, Club Picnic, General Assembly and Octoberfest at Gnaw Bone Camp.

For some of our members it is all about the exercise, and we offer lots of options if that is your primary interest. For most however, hiking with the Club offers an opportunity to interact with old and new friends. The Club is very much like an extended family. Do your friends and family a favor and invite them to a hike. Do yourself a favor too and plan to hike more often this year. Your doctor will be happy if you do. We look forward to seeing you often this year. If you haven't led a hike in the past, make it a goal to lead a hike this year. Everyone loves a new hike and leading is a rewarding experience.
