The TRAIL BLAZER is published each year as a record of the Club's activities and a record of members' hiking accomplishments. In 1956 a group of people who had been hiking under the banner of AMERICAN YOUTH HOSTEL were working on a 22-mile trail. On January 23, 1957, several of them had a meeting to discuss the formation of a new hiking club. They decided to name it THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB. The constitution they drafted listed the following: "The purpose of the Club shall be the encouragement of the love of nature; the dissemination of knowledge of the attractions of the out-of-doors; the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and the sponsoring of other activities incidental to the foregoing."

Following the desires of the founders, the Club has remained faithful to the objectives for which it was founded. However, the Club has changed with the times and the desires of newer members.

2019 YEAR IN REVIEW

The Indianapolis Hiking Club wrapped up another eventful year in 2019. On September 30, 2019 (end of our fiscal year) our membership was 571, about the same as the prior year. To remain a vibrant club we need to actively recruit new and younger members. This past year (fiscal year) the Club scheduled 2088 hikes, up from 1,996 last year, an average of 5.7 hikes a day. Collectively we hiked 83,371 miles, up about 5% from 2018.

Throughout the year we continued to schedule numerous morning, afternoon and evening hikes essentially every day of the year. We visited numerous state parks, state forests, the Hoosier National Forest, Nature Conservancy's, the Knobstone Trail, wildlife refuges and numerous rural communities in Indiana and nearby states. Many themed hikes were offered, including wildflowers, museums, concerts, pet hikes, book club hikes,

restaurants, flower gardens and opportunities to learn more about the history of our great city and state. Four multiple-day trips were scheduled in Indiana, Ohio and Tennessee. Although hiking remained the primary focus, leaders often tacked on pitch-ins and visits to museums, gardens, concerts and restaurants at the conclusion of a hike. Following a number of regularly recurring hikes, it has become a tradition for hikers to meet for coffee, lunch or dinner. Hiking with the Club is as much a social experience as physical exercise.

Following is a brief recap of the major highlights of the past year and three months which covers the period of October 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019:

GNAW BONE OKTOBERFEST - 2018 Attendance at this fun annual hike and cookout at beautiful Gnaw Bone Camp in mid October had been waning in recent years, so Marthene Kohlmeyer and Narcisso Povinelli took it upon themselves to rejuvenate the event. And what a success it turned out to be. More than 50 people attended two hikes led by Mary Ann Layman and Harold Crooks, followed by a hot dog roast with all the trimmings, including drinks and dessert. All the food, drinks and set ups were donated by Marthene and Narcisso.

ANNUAL WINTER BANQUET - 2018 Our annual holiday season party was another resounding success. attracting more than 150 members and quests. This year we added an expanded social hour with appetizers before the dinner, which proved very popular. During the social hour attendees were entertained by a Trivia quiz regarding IHC history. The table with the most right answers got certificates of achievement. Following a great meal provided by Excalibur Catering, we recognized 42 members for winning 58 different 2018 Achievement Awards. Each of the winners received an umbrella with a large Club logo on it. We also recognized five new 25 year members, all of which received an embossed paper weight. Thank you to Social Committee Chairperson Pat Lawler and her team of helpers who organized the event. We also appreciate the many guests who donated foodstuffs for needy Indianapolis families.

WINTER WEEKEND AT MCCORMICK'S CREEK Always a popular three day weekend during late winter and in 2019 we visited McCormick's Creek State Park on March 15-17. There were two hike leaders for this popular hiking venue. John Schlechte led the longer, faster hikes and Mary Ann Layman led the more moderate pace hikes. We had beautiful weather and had approximately 50 hikers for each of the Saturday hikes. Mary Ann led the Sunday morning's hike on which we had 33 hikers. Many day hikers joined us since this state park is close to Indianapolis. The hikers enjoyed seeing some of the early spring wildflowers already blooming.

MORGAN MONROE STATE FOREST HIKES In 2019 Mary Ann Layman, with assistance from Nanette Tate, continued the Club's almost 30 year tradition of hiking in beautiful Morgan Monroe State Forest every Tuesday in March and October, when the autumn color makes the woods especially beautiful.

C&O CANAL ONE DAY HIKE Four lady members completed the annual 62 mile (100K) endurance race tying our Club's single day distance record. Rita Bymaster has completed this hike from Washington DC along the Potomac River to Harpers Ferry WV an incredible 10 times. Theresa Ray has done it four times and Sara Wingate for the 2nd time. Sandra Nichols completed this incredible feat for the first time. So much for the weaker sex.

WILDFLOWER HIKES As she does every year Mary Ann Layman led very popular wild flower hikes at four different locations - Holliday Park, McCormick's Creek SP, Mounds SP and west side of Eagle Creek Park every Tuesday in April. Over the course of the month we got to view the early blooming species come and go followed by later blooming varieties. So pretty to see and learn about Indiana's varied spring wild flowers, assuming you paid attention to Mary Ann's ongoing commentary. If you didn't, then you just enjoyed the beauty of spring unfolding before your eyes.

SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK This is the 22nd year in a row that our Club has visited America's most popular national park in April when the wild flowers are at their peak. All told about 45 members and guests attended the three days (Thursday thru Saturday). John Schlechte hosted the event and led moderate

speed AM and PM hikes attended by 25 or so hikers on Jakes Creek loop trail, Spruce Flats Falls, Porters Creek and Old Sugarland Trail. A hike on Friday afternoon from Newfound Gap to Charlies Bunion had to be cancelled due to rain. Jeff Edmonson led two all day strenuous hikes to Chestnut Gap (12 miles and 17 hikers) and Mount LeConte on Saturday (15 miles and 13 hikers). His first try at Mount LeConte on Friday had to be postponed to Saturday because of rain.

HOCKING HILLS GETAWAY, OHIO Organized by Terry Roesch, over 40 members and guests made the 300 mile trek in mid-May to Ohio's favorite state park Hocking Hills and enjoyed two marvelous days of hiking in glorious weather. Terry, along with assistance from Nan Tate and Lynn Thurston, led hikes (sometimes rugged) to many famous locations in the park including Whispering Cave Trail, Old Mans Cave, Rock House, Buckeye Trail, Ash Cave to Cedar Falls loop and Conkles Hollow Nature Preserve.

ANNUAL PICNIC This year's annual picnic at Eagle Creek Park took place on July 6 a few weeks earlier than usual because of a mix-up in reserving the shelter. As always a fun time was had by all of the 100 attendees. About half the members arrived several hours early and enjoyed three hikes led by Michele Kestle (5 miles), Harold Crooks (4 miles) and Marsha Hutchins (3 miles). The weather was close to perfect. New members enjoyed meeting and socializing with our long term older members. People brought their favorite food to share and the Club provided drinks and fried chicken, which was a little late in arriving because the vendor was overwhelmed by the order. Pat Lawler kept us entertained during the wait. Many members brought school supplies for under privileged IPS students. Thank you to our Social Chairperson, Pat Lawler, for coordinating the picnic and other social events throughout the year.

MARY GRAY BIRD SANCTUARY Mary Ann Layman led hikes at this special place twice during 2019, in the spring and again in November that also included a hot dog roast on a beautiful fall day.

ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY - 2019 On September 12th our Club held its annual General Assembly. Before the meeting, about 50 attendees enjoyed a social hour with snacks provided by members of the board. The first order of business was to approve several minor revisions to the Club Constitution, previously distributed to the membership in the prior newsletter/schedule, to reflect the way the club actually does business today. These were approved. Next came the election of a new board of directors to take office on October 1, 2019, Candidates, recommended by the nominating committee, were approved by acclimation. After which, new members of the board were recognized and departing members thanked for their service. Following the election, outgoing president Phil Smith welcomed our incoming president Marti Burton. Next Pat Lawler our Social Committee chairperson introduced our guest speaker for the evening, Greg Harger, co-chair of the White River Committee and Project Manager of the Urban Wilderness Trail. He gave a most interesting talk with lots of questions regarding urban trail development along the White River in downtown Indy. There was so much interest in his talk that Greg was invited to lead a hike in the October schedule along the White River to show us what has been accomplished to date and what is planned. This has already taken place and hopefully can be repeated to a bigger audience this spring.

MICHIGAN'S UPPER PENINSULA After much urging Bill Halik repeated a trip in mid-September he first led in 2016 to Michigan's Upper Peninsula; 570 mile north of Indy to Munising MI. Over 50 members and guests made the trek and enjoyed beautiful scenery and mostly nice weather for the three days of hiking. We enjoyed hikes in picturesque Hiawatha National Forest, wrapping up with an ice cream stop, and several 7-10 mile hikes to Lake Superior where we saw Chapel Falls, Chapel Rock and Chapel beach along with scenic stops along the banks of Lake Superior.

MICHIGAN UPPER PENINSULA EXTENSIONS On the way home from the Upper Peninsula we were treated to three hiking related side trips over the next three days, each very different and led by a different hike leader. In all about 40 people made each of the side trips. Our first stop was orchestrated by John Lyghtel to hike to beautiful Tahquamenon Falls. Our next stop was St. Ignace where we took a ferry to famous Mackinac Island where we hiked 8 miles around the island. Thanks to Jean Ballinger who was responsible for this side trip. Our last stop on our way back to Indy was Petosky and Bayview, MI on Little Travese Bay, both historic summer vacation communities dating from the 1800s. John Schlecthe orchestrated this enjoyable side trip and hike.

BOOK CLUB HIKES This tradition started in 2014 is as vibrant as ever, attracting upwards of 20 hikers each time. During 2019 we had a book club hike every month. Hikers read a suggested book before each hike and there is a book discussion usually before, during and after the hike. Many thanks to Kathy Whalen and Katy Smith who continue to orchestrate this popular program. They already have volunteers lined up to lead for quite a few months in 2020.

GNAW BONE OKTOBERFEST - 2019 Patterned after 2018's very successful event, all preparations were made for what was supposed to be another well attended series of hikes and cookout - only the weather decided not to cooperate. It rained buckets all day and only 25 members and guests braved the conditions. Twelve hardy hikers even did a 4 mile woods hike in pouring rain. Following the hike, attendees were treated to hot dogs, potato salad, drinks and dessert, all prepared and eaten indoors in a large wooden cabin with a cozy fire place. Thanks again to Narcisso Povinelli who provided all the food, much of which had to be donated to charity after the event. All in all, we had a very damp but memorable day. Let's hope the weather in 2020 is better.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS This popular program started in 2006 to recognize hiking, trail maintenance and service accomplishments for the year. Awards are given in 11 categories, such as walking over 1,000 miles in a year, leading over 50 hikes or volunteering over 16 hours to trail maintenance. Winners are announced at the annual Winter Banquet and all receive a gift from the Club (usually a piece of apparel, sporting the Club logo). This year we had 46 winners of the awards, including 18 members who walked at least 1,000 miles, 4 members who did the longest hike (62 miles) and 14 who led at least 50 hikes. Notable this year were the 7 winners of the Trail Maintenance award, a record for this award, most volunteering their time at Eagle Creek Park. Also selected by the Board of Directors were five winners of the Club Service award. See the names of all 46 winners of this year's Achievement Awards on the Club website.

ANNUAL WINTER BANQUET - 2019 This year's annual seasonal gathering took place just last month in early December. Over 130 members and guests really enjoyed themselves. Sometimes it was difficult to recognize folks dressed up and not in hiking attire. We retained the expanded social hour started in 2018, with many positive comments. This year we featured a new dinner menu which everyone seemed to enjoy. Following the meal, Ed Wright announced 46 winners of the 2019 Achievement Awards all of who received quality rain jackets sporting the Club logo. As he has done on four other occasions, member Bob Kriz donated the jackets to the Club for which he was warmly praised by the crowd. Marti Burton then announced five new 25 year members, all of which will receive a recognition paperweight. After a couple additional door prizes, Pat Lawler, Master of Ceremonies, wished everyone a happy holiday season.

WEBSITE ENHANCEMENTS Continuing the trend of recent years, a number of significant enhancements were made to the website and our internal processes during 2019, including giving the Pathfinders the ability to add new hikes to the schedule after the printed schedule has been distributed. The added hikes will appear only on the website and notification of their presence will be electronic only. We are nearing the end of our trial period, during which we placed significant restrictions on when and where hikes could be added to the schedule. Based on the few problems we have experienced so far, we expect the Board will soon relax the limitations we placed on the process, thereby permitting members to schedule hikes anywhere and very close to the effective date of the hike.

LET'S NOT FORGET One of the main reasons that our Club continues to be strong after 63 years is because of the traditions established by our long time members. Sixty five of our members have been active for 25 or more years - 18 for over 40 years. We have four 90 year olds who still regularly hike and more than a dozen members in their 80s are active hikers. Our 25 year members proudly represent the roots and backbone of our club. Sadly on March 17 we lost Nell Larrison who was 104 years old when she passed away. Nell was our Club's longest tenured member with 55 years. Nell and her husband, Bill, were patriarchs of the Indianapolis Hiking Club for a half a century. Both Bill and Nell will be sorely missed but many of the traditions they were instrumental in establishing and sustaining through the years are still with us today. Take a few moments to

remember other Club members who passed away this past year, including Otis "Odie" Cassetty, Peggy Lavagnino, Jill Goeglein, Judy Timberman and Ron Clark.

ON TO 2020 The first few weeks of January 2020 have been wet, but not bitterly cold and luckily no snow. Although a few hikes have been cancelled or moved to a mall due to the wet conditions, we still anticipate that 2020 will be another busy year for our club. Once again, we expect to schedule over 2,000 hikes, allowing our hikers to choose from almost 6 hikes a day. Monthly book club hikes and pet hikes will continue. As will April wildflower hikes, spring and fall trips to Morgan Monroe State Forest and return visits to Gnaw Bone Camp and Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. We will continue to offer many slow and easy options for our elderly members. Multi-day trips are planned for Spring Mill SP in March, Smoky Mountains NP in April and the highlands of Scotland in September. Florida hikes are on the schedule for our winter snowbirds. As always, we will also host an annual picnic in July, General Assembly in September, Oktoberfest at Gnaw Bone Camp in October and Winter Banquet in early December. Make it a point to hike more during 2020 and ask your family and friends to join you. You and they will be glad you did.
