TRAIL MAINTENANCE OPPORTUNITIES

To earn the Trail Maintenance Achievement Award you must complete 16 hours of trail maintenance with an organization such as the IHC, Hoosiers Hiker Council, National Forest Service, National Park Service, Indiana Department of Natural Resources, American Hiking Society, the Nature Conservancy, or any of the many other trail organizations sponsoring volunteer trail work. To count toward the award, volunteer hours must be completed during the Club's official year, which ends on September 30.
