WINTER HIKING: Hike leaders are responsible for safety first. In adverse weather the leader may reroute, shorten or cancel a hike. If the weather is inclement or the roads are icy call the leader to confirm a hike. Whenever possible out of town leaders should make cancellation decisions by 6 PM of the preceding day. If you cancel a hike we suggest you send an email to the members who participate in Yahoo! Groups.

TRAILBLAZER REPORT: If you receive the schedule by mail, the annual Trailblazer report, which recaps everyone's annual and lifetime mileage, is included. If you access the schedule from the website, the Trailblazer is available on the "Mileage" page at www.indyhike.org/mileage.

ANNUAL DUES REMINDER: To date 530 members out of a year-end membership of 719 have paid their annual dues. If you have not, please do so now and save us the cost of sending out reminder letters. Please return the dues notice with your payment. If you misplaced the notice you may print one from the "forms" page on the Club website at www.indyhike.org/forms. REVISION TO CLUB CONSTITUTION: Even though a major revision to the Club Constitution was approved at the September 2011 General Assembly, a situation has arisen that requires other minor revisions. The Club is in the process of filing paperwork to become a not-for-profit legal entity. Article I Section 1 of the Constitution presently reads, "The name of this Club shall be the Indianapolis Hiking Club". Section 1 needs to be changed to read, "The name of this Club shall be the Indianapolis Hiking Club, Inc. doing business as The Indianapolis Hiking Club". We will also register the name change with the State of Indiana so we can preserve our name and differentiate our identity from several emerging central Indiana hiking groups.

The board also proposes to delete the words "regular meeting of the" from several places in the Constitution that currently read "...next regular meeting of the General Assembly...". Even though the proposed changes are very minor, the Constitution still requires that the change be voted on at a General Assembly. Accordingly, the Board has decided to call a special General Assembly to take place at this year's Christmas Party on Sunday, December 4. The entire matter, including the vote, should not require more than five minutes and then we can get back to the real purpose of the party – having fun.

PRESIDENTS CORNER: This is my first chance to communicate with you via the president's letter. As we honor our past and secure our future in this transition era, board members and fellow hikers have heard me talk frequently about a **PR** campaign for the year; that is, to **preserve**, **protect**, and **promote** the Indianapolis Hiking Club. The PR campaign will help direct our decisions as we face change and maintain some of the status quo. Let's look at some PR events that have happened recently or will happen soon.

We have had at least two opportunities to promote the Hiking Club in the past month. The *Indianapolis Star* published an article in November entitled *Even in chilly weather, club says, take a hike*. There is a link to the article on the home page of the Club website. On November 13, Greenfield Central High School radio station WRGF 89.7 aired a 30-minute interview with members Jeff Edmondson, Jan Stevens and Marsha Webster. Jim Grieg, the narrator, had been a guest on one of our hikes in September and was so impressed with the Club that he wanted to share our story with his listeners. We hope to post the interview on the Club website.

Besides hiking, we will also work to preserve, protect, and promote our social events like the Christmas Party. Make sure you wear your dancing shoes instead of hiking shoes! The same band will play as last year. This year's party also presents a unique opportunity for all members who attend to participate in a vote to preserve and protect our Club as an organization as we seek to make minor revisions to the constitution and preserve our long-held name. Please see REVISION TO CLUB CONSTITUTION prior to my remarks for details. Voting at the Christmas party eliminates the need to bear the financial burden of calling a special General Assembly. Generally, the Christmas party has better attendance than a General Assembly anyway so we will get more member participation in the vote.

What are your PR goals for the Club? Let one of the board members know.

- 9:00 AM LAKE KESSLER AND FALL CREEK ON THE BOULEVARD TRAIL Meet at Windridge Center at 5435 N. Emerson Way to the left of the pond for a 6-mile self-guided* hike north on the Fall Creek Trail. Repeats each Thursday in December and January. Charlie Brunette will be taking over this hike from Elaine Wright for the winter. (F,PS,3-3.5) Leader: (815-5953, 518-4555 cell)
- 9:30 AM EASY AT EAGLE CREEK Meet at the Earth Discovery Center parking lot in Eagle Creek Park (fee), which is located off of west 56th St just west of the Colts facility. Continue until you pass the football field on the left and turn left on Lions Path. Meet in the lot across from Rushville High School (okay to use restrooms). Turn left on SR 252 and go to SR 135. Turn right on SR 135 and go to SR 45. Turn right on SR 45 and go to Lanam Ridge Rd. Turn left, then right on Yellowwood Lake Rd to campground/shelter house. - 9:30 AM BLOOMINGTON TRAIL Take SR 37 south to Tapp Rd. Turn left and go 2 1/4 miles on Tapp Rd//Country Club Rd past the golf course on the right. Continue across Rogers St to just before the next traffic light (Walnut St), turn left into the shopping plaza and park behind the Old National Bank. This will be a 10-mile hike with a 6-mile option.
