## THE HIGHLIGHTS OF 1978

The Club has completed 22 years of presenting varied programs of hikes and outings in accordance with the purpose for which the Club was founded as defined in the Club Constitution, which is to "encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing".

The growth and vitality of the Club is a reflection of the enthusiastic and active interest by so many members. And this is probably because most members joined because of a love of the out-of-doors, and are anxious to take part in the hikes and outings. What are the reasons for this back-to-nature desire in so many of us? Probably there are many. However, most enjoy the companionship of the hike in the various seasons --- a quiet stroll in the early spring, enjoying the wildflowers --- a challenging hike in autumn, with a relaxing lunch break along the trail --- the coolness of a windswept ridge in the heat of summer --- and bundled up like eskimos trudging through the snow in the chill of winter. There is enjoyment in meeting the moods of nature, hiking through the wooded hills and valleys in our own Hoosier State.

The Club ended the year with 309 active paid-up members on the roster, and as you can tell from the listing of hikes on one of the following pages, there was active support from the members on the hikes and outings. This is encouraging to officers of an organization such as this. LABOR DAY WEEKEND AT SHAWNEE LODGE, SHAWNEE STATE PARK

Our Labor Day Weekend for 1978 was at a most delightful rustic looking lodge overlooking hills and valleys just north of the Ohio river. Shawnee State Park is just 12 miles west of Portsmouth in beautiful Ohio hill country. There were well over 70 members and friends who drove down for the three day outing, and many of them took the scenic route that followed the Ohio river.

Besides three interesting and different hikes, our Hiking Club members enjoyed swimming, tennis, volley ball, and the putting green outside -- and inside we all enjoyed the ping pong tables and pool tables. Like most of the lodge, the banquet room was decorated with one huge Indian mural along one wall depicting the Indian Corn Harvest. After our dinner, Luwana, a young Indian woman, gave a talk about the Indian life in the United States, and how the Indians now live. She especially dwelled on the sweat lodges and their meaning, and of the earth prayers. These she classified as "apologies" to "Mother Earth" when they had to either use or disturb anything in the forest.

Another special event was the night hike on Sunday, by many of us who were watching "Humming Birds" under the lamplight with Win Pulsifer. It seems that Win has a little difficulty in telling the difference between leaves caught in a spider web in the wind, moths flying around the light, and the real thing. The sounds of humming birds that night under the light sounded suspiciously like members of the Hiking Club.

Then another incident was a snake about two feet long that lay in the road on our Monday morning hike. Its markings were that of a copperhead, however, its actions were not. Some just knew it was a copperhead, others were equally positive that it was not. We will never know.

We all left shortly after noon on Monday for home after enjoying a perfect weekend.
