A REVIEW OF THE CLUB YEAR ENDING OCTOBER 1, 1980

The Indianapolis Hiking Club was organized in January of 1957, and has now completed 24 years of hiking and other activities dedicated to the love of the out-of-doors - the principal purpose of the Club as defined in the Club Constitution.

January of 1982 will be the 25th birthday of the Club, and your officers even now are planning the celebration. It should be a great year for the Indianapolis Hiking Club, as the special programs and activities under consideration will give all the members an opportunity to take part and to share in the recognition of our 25th anniversary.

Many of the approximately 300 members of the Club participated in Club activities during 1980. The strength of our organization lies in the support of the members, and as you can tell from a perusal of the statistical pages at the end of this report, the hikes were well attended and enthusiastically supported. Your officers really appreciated this, as a lot of hard work is put into the running of the Club by many dedicated people.

Take a good look at the list of hikes and overnight outings on pages 4 and 5. There were 73 hikes and 4 overnights scheduled during the year - a total of 729 miles of hiking. Of course some of the hikes were long and short hikes scheduled on the same day, so it would have been impossible to have taken all of them. But look at the Special Honor Roll! There were some really impressive performances by some of the more serious hikers. The hikes varied from 2 miles to 29 miles in length, and the terrain was everything from city pavement to rugged hills of our Indiana forests.
