As we start our 27th year, it is good to look back over the activities of last year, and reflect on the progress and growth of the Club. This edition of the TRAIL BLAZER covers our fiscal year ending October 1, 1983. One of the first events was the 25th Anniversary Stew Hike at Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary - the final event of celebrating 25 years as "THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB".

The Club was organized in January of 1957, according to the Constitution "To encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing". Most people join the Club because of a love of nature, and many become active supporters of the Club's activities. The joy of hiking with good friends is something most members look forward to. And there is a thrill in meeting the many moods and challenges of nature in the various areas of Indiana.

Our membership at the end of the fiscal year was 375 members. During the year the Club scheduled 136 hikes, 4 weekend outings, 4 weekend backpacks, 1 week long backpack, the Christmas party, and the summer picnic. There were also 4 General Assembly meetings, during which business is discussed, there are elections of officers at the September meeting, and this is the time for members to present their views about the Club. WORK ON THE KNOBSTONE TRAIL

As most of you know the Indianapolis Hiking Club has been doing volunteer work on the Knobstone Trail over the last couple of years. This trail is being developed by the Department of Natural Resources as a long distance backpacking and hiking trail, and is now about 57 miles long. Pat Fox coordinated our efforts with members of the Department, and the following members joined with Pat on September 17th, 1983, to help plant trees, repair ground cover, and do general maintenance work; John Behrmann, Linda Elliott, Mary Kidwell, Hazel Morrison, Barbara McNeely, Ronald Craig, Mary Pulsifer, Win Pulsifer, and Bob McConnell.

A REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

This year something new was added to the basic weekly hikes. Midweek evening set-your-own pace hikes every Wednesday evening from June 8th through August 10th starting from Broad Ripple. And they were continued by changing the location to Speedway from August 17th through September.
