As the members of the Indianapolis Hiking Club take part in the schedule of events planned during our 28th year, it is pleasant to look over the history of the Club in 1984 as we chronicle the various happenings during our 27th year. The Club grew as the year was certainly an active one in many ways.

The Club had a total of 368 members as of the end of our fiscal year, October 1, 1984. We had 159 sponsored hikes, 4 overnight outings, 3 weekend backpacks, one week long backpack, a summer picnic, and a Christmas party. These were in addition to our General Assembly meetings throughout the year, the official business meetings of the Club at which time members are updated on the Club's progress, and are entertained with programs selected especially for them.

The Indianapolis Hiking Club has always been fortunate in having capable and dedicated people available to be officers. They spend a great deal of time in running the Club - and the support and involvement of so many of the members is really appreciated, and makes their job so much easier. Good hiking and good eating - the proper ingredients for a hiking club picnic. We had 'em all on a warm summer day at Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary July 21st. The beautiful 600 acre park belonging to the Indiana Audubon Society, situated between Rushville and Connersville, was certainly the right place. About 25 hikers enjoyed the morning hike, and the balance of the approximately 80 people arrived around noon. The Club sponsored throughout the year a series of self-guided hikes meeting at various locations. During October, on Wednesday evenings, we took the Riverview hikes with Marsha Hutchins. And then in June and July the meeting place was Ellenberger on Tuesday evenings under the guidance of Ursula Breeding. Jim Stern took over the self-guided hikes at Riverview on Wednesday evenings during August. And we finished the self-guided hikes with Carol Sutcliffe signing us in on Wednesday evenings again at Riverview. These hikes were very popular with many of the members and gave them a chance to get out during the week and hike at their own pace for the distance they chose.

The ever popular backpack with Libby Moore in Hoosier National Forest started our year in October. Then Janet Kinney took us along Upper Fall Creek. And Bob & Marge Begeman led us to Crooked Creek and Wrecker. The Cassettys strolled the Speedway levee, and Rose Damm showed us the Morse Reservoir. Most took the group tour Saturday afternoon sponsored by the New Harmony Historic Society. This included most of the old areas of the town including the Atheneum and the buildings of the Harmonist Decade. Many people visited additional places in this most fascinating southern Indiana town. After dinner at the Shadblow restaurant, the evening program was presented in the Entry House of the New Harmony Inn. Many ate one or more meals at the Red Geranium restaurant, the lovely eating place next door to the Inn. Sunday we drove a short distance to the New Harmonie State Recreation Area and followed our leaders on a hike in this area near the river.

WINTER AT SPRING MILL STATE PARK

One of the old favorites of the Club, Spring Mill, was enjoyed again on our winter overnight February 4th and 5th. About 70 people from the Club strolled the trails in this beautiful park, and enjoyed the visit to the old village. Early Sunday morning, Robin Ott, helped us limber up with some aerobics. And after the morning worship service conducted by Harrison Feldman, we took to the trails again. And what a beautiful morning to hike, as there had been a light snowfall during the evening. It was indeed inspiring!

MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND AT GNAW BONE CAMP

We packed our sleeping bags and drove again to the rustic retreat at Gnow Bone Camp for the Club's 14th annual Memorial Day outing. About 80 people plus several day hikers enjoyed the weekend. Finding sleeping quarters was the first order of business. After a short hike during the afternoon Saturday, we visited the dining room for the evening meal, and an introduction to the rules of the camp. That evening we were entertained by "THE OLE PERFESSER" with his "MUSIC THAT IS DIFFERENT" What a lot of talent!! We all enjoyed him. After worship service on Sunday morning, we had our regular Sunday hikes under the direction of John Williams, with a shorter hike led by Bill Larrison. Of course Sunday afternoons at Gnow Bone is always leisure time - to enjoy the lake and the boating, to play horse shoes, perhaps to do some lawn bowling, or maybe some volley ball, and some even do a little more hiking. Many rested on the lawn below the cabins and had a social hour or two. Sunday evening saw the spectacular "OPENING NIGHT AT THE GNAW BONE PALACE" This had been advertised on bill boards and other forms of advertising, and a large audience enjoyed the first production. THE GNAW BONE PLAYERS presented with great pride their review for the enjoyment of all "OLE TYME VAUDEVILLE". Over the entrance to the building was the large sign with the flashing lights - "THE GNAW BONE PALACE". It was created by Win Pulsifer and really emphasized the fact that this building was no longer just a shelter house, but was now one of the few places still featuring vaudeville. On Monday, after breakfast, we

had a brief Memorial Service reflecting on the meaning of the holiday. as in the distance we heard the sound of taps as played by Allen Pekar. We then took our usual Monday morning hike.
