The Indianapolis Hiking Club celebrated its 30th birthday during 1987 with two official functions: a banquet in April and a Stew Hike in October. The Club was organized at a meeting on January 23, 1957 attended by 10 people who had been hiking under the name of "Indianapolis Hosteling". Motion was made to adopt a new name "The Indianapolis Hiking Club", and to charge a hike fee of 10¢ per hike. Dues were to be discussed later. A constitution was written later in the year defining the purpose of the Club: "To encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing".

Total paid membership increased to 467 as of October 1, 1987. Many of the newer members became active supporters of Club activities and joined with older members in making the Indianapolis Hiking Club a leader in outdoor recreation. There were 196 hikes and 4 overnight outings scheduled during 1987. Also 4 General Assembly meetings, a Christmas party and a summer picnic. Social activities were sponsored throughout the year, including a trip to the Boggstown Inn and Cabaret, a visit to Weliever's Smorgasbord, an evening at Ski World at Nashville, and watching the finals of Golden Gloves. A detailed resume of Club activities will be found on following pages.

Officers of an organization such as this club spend much time in the promotion of activities and in the bookkeeping necessary to maintain records. This is all volunteer work and the Club wants to recognize with thanks the people who led the Club during 1987.

The Burton trio furnished dinner music during the buffet, which was immediately after the singing of the Lord's Prayer by Rosita Genovese. During part of the dinner program there was recognition of many individual members, and there was an explanation of the many traditions of the Club. One of the humorous anecdotes was one given by Alice Roth as she related a typical hike for her and Bert. Our after dinner entertainment was a one man show by Kent Lockman.

The second official celebration was the 30th Anniversary Stew Hike on a misty day in October at Gnaw Bone Camp. We visited Holliday Park with Alice Brink, and went to Eagle Creek Park several times with various leaders. Charlie Brunette took a group along the Yellowwood trail.
