January 23rd, 1988, was the 31st birthday of the Indianapolis Hiking Club, and during those years there has been change and progress. The members have contributed much to the programs and hiking activities as the Club followed its purpose as outlined in the Constitution; "To encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing". No organization can stand still - it must go forward or it will go backward. It has been the good fortune of the Club to have had energetic leaders who have encouraged and supported the activities of the Club in such a way that the membership has grown dramatically. Total paid membership increased during the year just ended to 505.

The Indianapolis Hiking Club is a leader in outdoor recreation, and during 1988 the Club sponsored 241 hikes, 1 backpack, and 3 weekend outings. There were 4 General Assembly meetings, a Christmas party, and a summer picnic. Social activities included a visit to the Boggstown Inn by about 45 people.

Leading the Club each year are unpaid volunteer officers and directors. Through their efforts and dedication they have contributed much to the promotion of Club activities, and have given direction and purpose to our organization. The Club recognizes with thanks the people who led the Club during this past year.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS - The business and social meetings of the Club are held quarterly, and are excellent opportunities to visit with other members while enjoying interesting programs. In November, Brian Cossell showed slides on a "Trip Through Yugoslavia". The March meeting featured information about "Abandoned Rail Greenways" by a representative from the Hoosier Rails-To-Trails Council. Paul Sherwood of the DNR was our guest speaker in May, discussing Indiana's "Long Distance Trails". After the election at our September meeting, Dave LeBlanc of Holcomb Research Institute presented a program on "Hiking In Nepal".

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - There is always a large turn-out for this event at the height of Holiday Season. This is a time for family gatherings and the many children present added to the spirit of the occasion. Following the pitch-in supper, where most ate too much, we were entertained by a "Hand Bell Choir". Santa Claus made his usual appearance.

ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - The Club met in Shelter "B" at Eagle Creek Park the last Saturday in July for some good times at our annual picnic. Mary Kidwell led us on hikes before and after the pitch-in dinner. And Gerry O'Reilly had some fun games for us - particularly the one with the water-filled balloons.

WORK ON THE KNOBSTONE TRAIL - This year the Club did maintenance on the trail near the Elk Creek trail head. Seven members led by Bill Flora contributed several hours of work on the trail. Paul Sherwood and his crew from DNR supervised and worked with us.

REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

The first part of October Libby took us on a backpack in Hoosier National. Went with Jim Stern to the festival at Cataract, and visited Yorktown with Cheryl. Hiked in Morgan-Monroe several times with Bill Flora. And about 130 people enjoyed the 30th Anniversary Stew hike at Gnow Bone, where peas were a featured item as served by Win Pulsifer. Had several hikes in town, and walked the Knobstone with Al. Ended October at Cordry/Sweetwater with Joe.

Began November at Lieber Park, and then went on the Salamonie Snowmobile with Karleen. Visited Shakamak, Shades, Tippecanoe River, McCormick's Creek, and Brown County as we took advantage of our beautiful State Parks. The Christmas lights at Metamora were beautiful in the rain as we hiked along the canal with the Pulsifers.

In early December Charley led some hikers from Meridian Middle to Brown Co. by way of Spearsville. Walked in Greenfield with John, and saw covered bridges near Moscow with the Begemans. Hiked the Olio road with Ron, and then Robin showed us the town of Kokomo. Started a series of hikes around the county with Dennis Taft

New Year's day found a group on a cold hike from Ellenberger with the Begemans. Tuesdays during January Sam led hikes at Bradford Woods. Saw Shannon Lake with Bob, and Jackie took us around Wanamaker. Then visited Washington's Drummer Boy grave with Bob Pedigo.

In early February we walked downtown with John. And hiked the trails in Eagle Creek several times during the month. We followed Bob & Marge on the Metamora/Laurel loop. Tuesdays found us hiking the Speedway Variety hikes. Went on a rugged hike with Pat Foreman at Brown County Park. And Rose showed us Westfield & Noblesville. Back to Morgan-Monroe a couple of times. Then strolled through Crown Hill with a largest crowd we have had on a hike.

The winds of March found us hiking at Morgan-Monroe on Tuesdays. Ron Craig led a rugged hike in the Deam Wilderness. Went to Zionsville, and took the Riley Trail at Greenfield. Hiked along the Wabash near Logansport. Then some rugged hiking near Story and environs. Around the county a couple of times, and then walked the Bloomfield-Brick with Bob Begeman.

April began with a Good Friday hike at Morgan-Monroe with Al. Saw the Whitewater Gorge with Mabel & Louise. On Tuesdays we hiked at Beech Grove. And spent Easter afternoon at Garfield Park. MEMORIAL WEEKEND AT GNAW BONE - About 65 people plus day hikers enjoyed this weekend at the beautiful camp in the hills of Brown County. Good hiking all three days. Saturday evening Marge & Charles Johnson presented "Dutch Treat" in the amphitheater followed by Cindy Foley who sang and played the dulcimer. After the worship service Sunday, we had our usual hikes. Then we had our Sunday Cook-Out around the fire in front of the stage. Most people spent the afternoon at the lake as the weather was perfect. Sunday evening Gerry Gray, Jerry Hammons, and GR & Carol Davis entertained us with their "Second Hand Music". After the Memorial Service Monday morning we had another hike. And we hated for the weekend to end.
