The Indianapolis Hiking Club was organized in January 1957 by a group of hikers who had been working on the Yellowwood Trail in the Brown County Area. Article II of the Club Constitution which was adopted in July of 1957 explains the purpose of our Club: "It shall be the encouragement of the love of nature; the dissemination of knowledge of the attractions of the out-of-doors; the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and the sponsoring of other activities incidental to the foregoing". Over the years the Club, under the guidance of capable and dedicated officers, has adhered to the principles for which it was founded.

The Indianapolis Hiking Club has been in the forefront of outdoor activities in Indiana, and during the 1989 fiscal year ending October 1, the Club sponsored 250 hikes, one backpack, and four weekend outings. In addition there were four General Assembly and Social meetings, the annual Christmas Party, and the annual summer picnic. In November the Club sponsored a night at the Boggsstown Inn and Cabaret which was attended by about 50 people.

The Club recognizes the valuable contribution made by the 1989 Officers. The Club has benefited greatly from their leadership as they gave direction and purpose to all Club activities.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS - The Club has quarterly business and social meetings. These events present an excellent opportunity to visit with other members, and meet new friends, while enjoying interesting programs. The November meeting featured Marian Cassell who showed slides on "The Countries of Scandinavia" A feature of the March meeting was the voting on the Constitutional Amendment to abolish the 10¢ per person hike fee. This fee had been a part of Club tradition for 32 years. At the May meeting the Club honored Sam & Billie Lloyd for their contributions to the Club. Sam was a two time President of the Club. They were presented a book on Indiana Wildflowers, which will help them to remember us after their move to Tennessee. Sam had an interesting program of slides entitled "A Potpourri of Club Events". The September meeting included the election of officers. After the election Mary Kidwell discussed with slides "Why the Barrier Islands?"

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - The holiday season is a time for parties as people get in the mood of friendship and goodwill. The large turn-out attested to the fact that many members and their families were anxious to share in this festive event. Following the pitch-in supper, we were entertained by the "New Beginnings" featuring Paul & Debbie Dunham and their music. THE WEEKEND OUTINGS

FALL OVERNIGHT AT BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - About 50 people plus some day hikers enjoyed the Fall weather in mid November at the Abe Martin Lodge in the Park. We got in about 13 miles of hiking in the beautiful hills surrounding the Lodge. Had our usual social hour in a private meeting room before supper. After supper we assembled back in the same room for a program presented by the Park Naturalist, Jan Jose, featuring a slide show on "Brown County State Park through the Seasons". Sam Lloyd then entertained us with a slide show featuring recent hikes and outings.

WINTER WEEKEND AT POKAGON - Pokagon State Park in northern Indiana was the scene of our February outing. The snow covering was spectacular (although the roads were clear) and we shared the trails with cross country skiers. Got in about 10 miles of hiking in between all the other activities. The toboggan slide was the hit of the weekend, even though it was a long walk back to the starting point up the stairs. The warming hut sure came in handy. In the evening after supper many went to an open field near the campground to visit with an astronomy club from Michigan. We enjoyed looking at the stars through their telescopes as they explained what we were looking at. Our social hour featured a game by Fred Eckstein which helped break the ice between old and new members.

GNAW BONE CAMP - The Lorenz's of Gnaw Bone were again our hosts for our 19th annual outing at the Camp. About 60 people plus 17 day hikers enjoyed the facilities available, and we hiked about 21 miles in between the other activities. Saturday evening we gathered around the campfire at the amphitheater and watched Marie Webster put on a skit. And then we joined in some group singing. After the Sunday noon cook-out, many enjoyed the activities at the lake, while some loafed near the cabin area. Sunday evening found us again at the Gnaw Bone Palace for a musical treat from Gerry Gray and Jerry Hammons, with help from G.R. and Carol Davis. Allen Pekar played taps during our Monday morning memorial service, and we hated to see the weekend over, so some stayed a little longer after lunch on Monday to reminisce and to visit the lake one more time.

BARKLEY STATE PARK - The queen of the Kentucky State Park system, Barkley State Park sits on the east side of Barkley Lake. 43 people from the Club enjoyed the beauty of this luxurious Lodge over the Labor Day weekend. The group got in 17 miles of hiking, and many also went sight seeing in the Land Between the Lakes. After supper quite a few drove over to Aurora on the west side of Cumberland Lake for an evening entertainment at the Saturday Night Jamboree. Sunday evening Sam Lloyd showed us some new slides in our private meeting room.

REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

October began with a Volksmarch and a back pack in Hoosier National. Then a visit to the Cataract Falls festival. There were weekly hikes all month at Morgan-Monroe and at Zionsville. We hiked many of the State Parks and the State Forests. Helped Cincinnati celebrate its 200th birthday. And we also visited French Lick and West Baden.

On Tuesdays during November we hiked at Eagle Creek. Explored Whip-Poor-Will Woods and then visited Graw Bone Camp and hiked the hills. John Behrmann took us along the Laughery Creek Trail. Hiked through Zionsville a couple of times. And walked along the Turkey Track with Charles. We went to Summit Lake State Park with Hal. And the luminaries were beautiful at Metamora as they celebrated the holiday season.

We looked at the Christmas decorations in Zionsville in early December. Took a little cross country hike with Al at Crosley Fish & Game. We explored Eagle Creek several times and also walked the canal. Vernon was interesting to visit. And then Bob & Marge took us on a hike at Crooked Creek. Hiked at Ellenberger on Christmas Day. And then we finished the month racing around Speedway.

During January there were weekly hikes on north Pennsylvania on Mondays, and in Bradford Woods on Tuesdays. Pat took us on a fast rugged hike in Brown County Park. And then we had self-guided hikes around Hendricks County. Princess Lakes were nice to visit. And we walked the Olio with Ron. Visited the town of Greenfield. And in late January took the Metamora Laurel Loop.

We were at Eagle Creek on Tuesdays during February. There were a couple of Half-Century hikes starting from the Statehouse. Visited Crown Hill. And we had a tour of the State Capitol Buildings. Went to Morgan-Monroe again. And Joe Lehman showed us the various area of IUPUI. Hikes at Zionsville and Speedway Levee finished out the month.

On Tuesdays during March we hiked at Morgan-Monroe. We also visited Butler. Saw the town on a hike from Glendale to the Circle. Went to Lake Hart with Carol. It was interesting to walk through the covered bridges over Flat Rock with Bob & Marge. Walked along the Turkey Track again. Spent Good-Friday at Morgan-Monroe on a rugged 20 mile walk. We visited Garfield Park and the Conservatory on Easter.

April found us at the Whitewater Gorge and Earlham. And then there was a three lake hike at Morgan-Monroe. Tuesdays during April we hiked at Eagle Creek in the mornings and in Beech Grove in the evenings. Had hikes at Logansport, Cascade Park, Indiana University, Turkey Run Park, Clifty Falls Park, Madison, and Ball State Univ. Struggled up the hills Of the Knob Lake hike near Brownstown, and also hiked along the 10 o'clock line trail out of Yellowwood Forest. John Behrmann showed us the Bears of Blue River trail.

We started our hiking in May at the Speedway Area and also at Eagle Creek. And repeated these hikes during the month. Tom took a group to Illinois to take the historic Lincoln Trail from New Salem to Springfield. Visited Yellowwood again, and also went back to Summit Lake. The Adventure Trail, north and south, was explored by a group led by Al Dreho. Went south again to St. Meinrad, and also over to the Muskogean trail near Evansville.

The summer found us in June taking weekly hikes at Speedway, Ellenberger, and Zionsville. We started the month on the rugged Knobstone from Deam Lake to New Chapel. Also took the Back Country Loop. Walked the Fort Harrison Volksmarch for a couple of days. Visited the town of Mooresville. And we also walked all the way around Eagle Creek Park. Had an interesting visit to Historic Fountain Square.

We started our July hiking at Lieber State Recreation Area. We walked downtown via Woodruff Place. And on weekdays we had hikes at Eagle Creek and also on the Canal. Jim took us on a hot hike (across some trestles) to visit Dupont and the Morgan Raiders festival. Visited several State Parks; Brown County, Versailles, Shades, and Spring Mill. Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary was a beautiful place to hike. And then there was the picnic at Shelter "B" and we had some good hiking in the Park. John Behrmann took a group along the Wabash Heritage Trail north of Lafayette.

During August there were hikes on the White River Parkway on Tuesdays, and at Ellenberger Park on Wednesdays. We went to several more State Parks; Raccoon Lake, Shakamak, Turkey Run, and McCormick's Creek. Went on a stroll through Castleton. Jim Stern took us to an interesting Swiss Wine Festival at Vevay. We hiked at Mississinewa, and then went to a Cordry picnic courtesy of the Ernstings. Then we walked around Franklin with Jim Stern.

Each Wednesday during September we had hikes along the Canal and also in Zionsville. Went to German Park to participate in a Volksmarch. Walked along the Knobstone from New Chapel to Elk Creek on a hot day. The Wildlife Refuge at Muscatatuck was an interesting place to hike. Walked through several towns; Knightstown, Scottsburg, and Greencastle. Took a long hike on the Covered Bridge Trail with Regina and Mary. And then we found ourselves back on the Knobstone from Elk Creek to Spurgeon Hollow. There was a back pack in Hoosier National Forest. And we again hiked Morgan-Monroe on the Ed Chambers four lake hike. And a group assembled on the last Saturday in Morristown for an "Idiots Delight" hike of 41 miles (Club record).

The yearly Trail Blazer is a resume of the Club's activities during the year, and is a continuing part of the history of the Club. On following pages is a detailed listing of all the sponsored hikes, and a membership listing giving number of hikes and mileages for each member. New members who were voted in during the year are at the end of the list and the month of admittance is shown before their name. This yearly report is possible only because of the hard work of many officers of the Club, but particularly it is the result of many hours of labor on the part of membership officers. Each year the Club has been most fortunate in people who are willing to spend the time to insure accurate records. This fiscal year Betty Woodward and Fran Maguire worked together to insure that mileage records were both accurate and timely. The Club is lucky to have people of this caliber available.
