### SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS - These business and social general meetings are open to all members and their invited guests. They are held four times a year and they provide excellent opportunities to learn more about future plans for the Club as well as to enjoy a good program. The November meeting featured Robert Meurer's slide program "From Sea to Shining Sea" on the National Parks. In March "Appalachian Trail Reflections" was presented by Bob Corya and assisted by Will Harrer and Tom Patterson. Bill Brink's marvelous pictures of the wildlife at Eagle Creek was the program of the May meeting. The election of officers was a feature of the September meeting, Tim Maloney of the Hoosier Environmental Council gave an illustrated talk on the Hoosier National Forest, and brought us up to date on future plans.

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - What a wonderful way to enjoy the holiday season with good friends in the Club. A large turn-out enjoyed the pitch-in supper which was followed by a musical program by the Northview Middle School choir. Santa (Win Pulsifer) gave out apples to all the good boys and girls (and adults).

ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - On a beautiful Saturday in July we all met in Shelter "B" at Eagle Creek. The morning hikers left at 10:00 AM on a walk and the rest of the people who were coming for the picnic arrived in time for the pitch-in. Gerry O'Reilly, as usual, got everybody in the mood for some crazy outdoor games. Ask Gerry about the raw egg down her blouse.

WORK ON THE KNOBSTONE TRAIL - On a hot day in October, 7 members of the Club worked on the Knobstone under the direction of Mike Martin of the DNR. They put in 55 steps, 35 waterbars, and 150 feet of cribbing. The help of volunteers such as this is needed to maintain the trail. This long distance trail in southern Indiana is of particular interest to the Club, and all members are urged to watch the schedule for the next time we plan a work detail.

#### WEEKEND OUTINGS

WINTER WEEKEND AT McCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - Approximately 70 people enjoyed this beautiful park in the middle of winter. Lisa Schools, naturalist, gave us an illustrated talk and also had some of her wild friends to show us. Enjoyed the social hour Sunday evening in Oak Room. And we got in a total of 15 miles hiking.

GNAW BONE CAMP - This was the Club's twentieth outing at Gnow Bone. Saturday evening we gathered in the Shelter to watch a clogging show put on by Jim Ernsting and some of his fellow cloggers. After the noon cook-out on Sunday, many enjoyed the activities at the lake, while others did their own thing near the cabin area. The afternoon social hour was a special occasion. Sunday evening at the Gnow Bone Palace, we enjoyed the special music of Gerry Gray, Jerry Hammons, and G.R. & Carol Davis. During the Monday Memorial Service on the true meaning of the Holiday, we listened as Allen Pekar played taps in the distance. During the weekend we got in a total of 18 miles on the trails. It was a great Memorial Day weekend.

NEW HARMONY - Labor Day Weekend found us at New Harmony, Indiana. We hiked also at nearby Harmonie State Park on Sunday. The New Harmony lodge was a beautiful setting for our activities. All of us got together one evening for a social hour. We explored the historic old town of New Harmony on two different hikes. The Red Geranium restaurant next door to the lodge was enjoyed by many. Got in about 15 miles of hiking during the weekend.

#### REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

October started with a hike from Glendale to the Circle. Visited the Eiteljorg Museum. Many explored Crosley Fish & Game with Al. Jim took us to the Cataract Festival for ham & beans. Spent some time in Terre Haute and also Cincinnati. Took a rugged hike to Starve Hollow. And climbed the hills of Clark forest. A great Halloween party in Zionsville. Many weekday hikes included Morgan Monroe, Broad Ripple, Speedway, and Zionsville.

Went to Gnow Bone in early November and then to Ouabache Park. Visited Yellowwood Lake and took a visit to Brazil. Walked on two Riley trails - Greenfield & Indianapolis. Took a hike at Atterbury Fish & Wildlife. Then saw one of our newest parks, Summit Lake. Had weekday hikes at Eagle Creek, Downtown, and the Speedway levee.

December found us on the Frances Slocum trail at Mississinewa. Our usual Christmas visit to Metamora was followed by a visit to Vernon and dinner at the Old Stage Inn. Many walked along the Little Miami Trail - Parts I & II. A Christmas Eve hike along the Canal, and a Christmas Day hike at Ellenberger. Finished December hiking on the Bloomfield Brick. Had weekday hikes at Eagle Creek, Zionsville, and Speedway.

We were at Ellenberger on New Year's day for an early hike. Walked around three different counties during the month. Had an interesting walk at Mooresville. Saw the Northwest Passage. And ended January on Fall Creek and with a visit to Noblesville. Weekday hikes included Bradford Woods and Speedway.

We were in Southeastern Hamilton county in early February. Walked along the Ohio Road. And took some trails in Eagle Creek. Visited Metamora again. And then explored the Marott Park Nature area. Had weekday hikes at Holiday Park, Speedway, and Chapel Hill.

The winds of March found some on the Freedom Trail in Randolph County. And then there was a rugged hike along the Forks of Salt Creek. The covered bridges over Flat Rock near Moscow were very interesting. Visited Ball State University. And Tom took some of us to the highest point in Indiana. Walked all around New Palestine. Explored a couple of our State Parks. And many found that Brown County and Yellowwood can be wet and muddy. Finished March at the reservoir near Huntington. Weekdays found us hiking at Morgan Monroe and at the Speedway.

Took an April Fool's hike on a Super City walk. Fred showed us the Avoca Fish Hatchery. And April was a beautiful month to explore Turkey Run and the Shades. Went to Hickory Ridge in Hoosier National. Had 2 Good Friday hikes in Morgan Monroe. Strolled through the Butler Campus. And on Easter we had morning hike and an afternoon hike. Followed some of the trails in Whip-Poor-Will woods. Saw the wild flowers at Madison and also on the trail near Anderson Falls. Drank sassafras at a festival in Vernon. Took the historic Lincoln Trail near Lincoln State Park. And we helped the Department of Natural Resources celebrate the Knobstone Trail from Delaney Park. Walked 22 miles seeing some covered bridges, and then ended April at Starve Hollow. Many weekday hikes in April - Butler, Eagle Creek Park, Speedway, and the Farley Fling.

May found us in southern Indiana hiking at Clark State forest and also along the Knobstone to New Chapel. Decided to visit McCormick's Creek again. And some took a high water hike in Morgan Monroe with Dave. Walked around Yellowwood Lake, and explored Brown County Park. There was a tri-county hike out of Charlottesville, and some participated in the 500 Mini-Marathon. Weekdays in May we hiked the White River Parkway, Speedway Area, and Broad Ripple.

Attended the Metamora Strawberry festival the first part of June. Enjoyed the Adventure Trail in Harrison Crawford, both South and North. Don't forget the Amtrak Train ride to Chicago. Fort Harrison was the site of a Volksmarch. Visited the Salamonie Reservoir for an interesting hike. And we visited the campus of Indiana University. Left at 5:00 AM one morning for a hike around Eagle Creek Reservoir. And the three lake trail at Morgan Monroe was enjoyable. June weekday hikes at Eagle Creek, Beech Grove, and Broad Ripple.

July started at Leiber State Recreation Area. Followed Buck Creek out of Yorktown. And Mary Gray Sanctuary was beautiful. Enjoyed hiking before the picnic at Eagle Creek. Took a rugged hike from Yellowwood Lake. And the Ernstings were hosts for an enjoyable hike and picnic. Then walked the Whitewater Gorge. John took us on a completed portion of the Wabash Heritage Trail. And then we ended July with a hike at Peru. Eagle Creek Park, Warren Central, and Chapel Glen were the scene of weekday hikes during July.

Went to Hardin Ridge in August and then to Zionsville. The volksmarch at Shades was a good hike. Al took a group to the Deam Wilderness. Visited at Eagle Creek a couple of times. And then there were 2 self-guided hikes out of North Salem. Visited the Carmel area a couple of times with Jim. And then explored a couple more State Parks. Weekday hikes during August were at Eagle Creek, O'Malia downtown, and Christian Park.

The final month of September found us on the Knobstone Trail to Elk Creek and also another hike to Spurgeon Hollow. Had a beautiful wildflower hike at Brown County Park with Nanette. Crawfordsville was an interesting town to walk through. Fort Wayne was the site of a three rivers hike. Went to Shakamak and to Turkey Run. Jim took us to Cincinnati and a train trip to Portsmouth. Walked along the Frances Slocum Trail. And ended September with a backpack in Hoosier National. Weekdays found us hiking at Butler, and at Chapel Hill.
