This yearly report to the members explains in detail the events of the year, and is a continuing history of the Club. The Club is proud of the program it presented during the year, as it completed 35 years of existence, following the purpose for which it was organized: "To encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing".

The Indianapolis Hiking Club is a leader in outdoor recreation in Indiana. Last year the Club sponsored 390 hikes, 3 weekend outings, 2 backpacks, and a summer picnic. In addition there was the annual Christmas party, and the four general assembly meetings. Total paid membership was 433 people at year's end.

Each year the Club has had capable and dedicated officers to guide and lead the activities. Their efforts have given direction and purpose as they spend many hours behind the scenes in achieving the goals they have set for the growth of the Club. The annual election of officers was held at the September meeting, and the program presented a speaker from the Crime Prevention group explaining how not to be a victim of crime by using common sense precautions.

WEEKEND OUTINGS

BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - During the middle of November some 41 people plus 10 day hikers enjoyed the beauty of the Park. We stayed at the Abe Martin Lodge, where we had a nice social hour before supper. The Saturday evening program featured Jim Eagleman, park naturalist, who brought us up to date on problems and events in the Park, particularly the exploding deer population which has caused much concern. Lots of good hiking during the weekend.

MCGORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - It was a great place to spend a couple of nights during the height of the winter season. The group of 41 members stayed at the Canyon Inn. Had a good social hour before the Saturday supper. And the Park naturalist, Tia Hornung-Self, conducted our evening program discussing the history and geology of the area, particularly in the time before it became a Park. The hiking was superb during the weekend.

GNAW BONE CAMP - Back to the hills of Gnow Bone Camp for the 22nd annual Memorial Day Outing. Had an orientation hike Saturday afternoon. In the shelter house that evening we watched a comic skit "The Ballad of Ice Worm Cocktail" as some of Gnow Bone Players brought to life Robert Service's poem while listening to a recorded narration by Win Pulsifer. The cloggers of Jim & Carol Ernsting ended the evening's entertainment. Hiked on Sunday morning, then free time in the afternoon. Following the social hour and supper that evening we assembled in the shelter house for some good music by the "Johnson County Folk Singers" under the direction of Linda Norton. After the flag raising Monday morning, another good hike. After lunch it was time to say goodbye. (PS - it was cold! Monday morning we saw 38°)

gan October on the Snowmobile with Karleen. Then to Shades and to the Cataract festival with Jim. Nanette took some to visit the Frances Slocum area. Hiked the 3 lakes trail, and explored the Fox Island preserve. Walked on Turkey Track, and then saw five covered bridges. Weekday hikes included Morgan-Monroe, Warren, Zionsville, and downtown.

We walked at Laughery Creek early in November and also visited the Lieber S.R.A. A group followed Al on hills near Spurgeon Hollow. Back to Gnow Bone for some hilly hiking. Visited Twin Swamp and Indy low spot. Hiked the Knobstone again. Followed the Monon Corridor with Tom. Walked on some of the Lincoln Trail. The early birds went around Eagle Creek. Weekday hikes at Butler, Plainfield, Chapel Glen, and Target east side.

Hiked near the Naval Armory in early December. Followed the Wabash near Logansport. Visited Atterbury with Dave. Greencastle had 5 bridges we saw. The Fern Hills preserve was pretty. Christmas at Ellenberger. The Little Miami Scenic Trail in Ohio was rainy. Weekday hikes at Downtown, Zionsville, Irvington, Fall Creek, and Broad Ripple.

New Year's day at Ellenberger and at Speedway. Lots of cold weather hiking in January at such places as Plainfield, Greenfield, the Monon trail, Crosley Area, and Glendale, and Ohio road. Also to Vincennes for George Rogers Clark Memorial. Weekday hikes at Bradford Woods, Devonshires, Butler, and Speedway.

Early February found us walking around the airport. And also to Metamora with the Begemans. Interesting hike from Brown County to Yellowwood. Greenwood was an interesting town to explore. The hills of the Yellowwood trail made a rugged hike. There were several covered bridges near Rushville. Nan took a group to the Shirley Creek Horse area, and some followed Tom on a Liberty walk in Carmel. Weekday hikes included; Zionsville, Speedway, Irvington, and Downtown.

March first found us in Westfield and in Knightstown. Explored the ravines in Turkey Run. Saw several covered bridges near Flat Rock. The Cedar Bluff Preserve was interesting. We walked through the town of Brooklyn. And John took us on the Riley trail of Greenfield. Ron led a rugged hike near Story. Hiked the hills of Versailles Park the last of March. Walked at Walnut Creek north, and then visited Fox Island Preserve again. Walked the Bloomfield Bricks. Easter found us at Garfield Park. Don & Barbara took us to Shakamak, and Hal led us through Anderson College. Some weekday hikes at Downtown, Beech Grove, Target east side, and Indy east side.

May is a beautiful month and we started at Clark forest. Took a Fort Harrison Volksmarch. Visited Whip-Poor-Will woods. Another hike at Morgan-Monroe, followed later with a hike on the Knobstone. Took part in the 500 mile mini marathon. Hiked through Martin forest. And visited Ellis Park in Danville. Walked in the Camby area with the Overton's. Jim Cable took a group on the four lakes of Morgan-Monroe. Weekday hikes: Warren, Eagle Creek, Chapel Hill.

Started June at Eagle Creek west. Took a hike on Possum Trot road. Then to Raccoon S.R.A. Took a stroll around Morse Reservoir. And visited Buck Creek with Cheryl. Hiked at Spring Mill and at Mary Gray Sanctuary. Explored Glen Helen and John Bryon parks. Weekday hikes included: Broad Ripple, downtown, Fall Creek, Irvington.

Mary Lester led us at Martinsville in early July. Visited Whitewater and Shades Parks. Also Morgan-Monroe forest. Walked through lots of poison ivy at Lieber.
