The first meeting of the Indianapolis Hiking Club was in January of 1957. The Club has now completed 36 years of providing activities in the form of hikes, outings, backpacks, picnics, meetings, and other events. In January of 1994 we will celebrate our 37th birthday. The Club was organized by a group of hikers who had been working on the Yellowwood Trail. When they later wrote a constitution for the Club they listed as the purpose "To encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing". The Club has indeed lived up to those ideals. Last year there were 397 hikes, 3 weekend outings, 3 general assembly meetings, a Christmas party, a summer picnic, a bus trip, and a canoe outing.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS - These are excellent meetings to visit with other members on a social basis and to learn more about the Club. The meeting on November 12th, 1992 featured the dulcimers of Tull Glazener and his group in a musical presentation even including "The Stars and Stripes Forever". On March 11th 1993, the featured speaker was Ray Irvin of the White River Greenway Development Board who brought us up-to-date on progress being made along White River. The annual election of officers was held at the September 16, 1993 meeting. We were honored to have James Ridenour as our speaker. Mr. Ridenour was director of the Indiana Department of Natural Resources for several years, and more recently was the director of the U. S. National Parks during President Bush's administration. His talk was most interesting.

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - This festive affair was enjoyed by quite a few members and their friends while visiting and chatting during the pitch-in dinner - lots of good food. The North Central High School Choir entertained us with their musical selections. Santa Claus showed up and passed out apples. Our first Christmas party at John Knox Church was a huge success.

ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - We started our morning hike from Shelter "B" at Eagle Creek. The rest of the people arrived later in time for the pitch-in - everybody ate too much but who is counting. Fred Eckstein had some fun games - throwing brooms for distance, and then some tried to see who could pull a small object attached to a long string through their shirts and pants the fastest. Fun!!

BUS TRIP TO BERNHEIM FOREST - On May 15th some 40 members and guests boarded a bus in Greenwood and took off for Bernheim Forest about 20 miles south of Louisville. The weatherman cooperated and we had a great time. The Arboretum area at Bernheim (about 2000 acres) was beautiful on this spring day and the flowers were a special treat. After lunch the bus took us to the trailhead in the wilderness area where we enjoyed some hilly hiking. On the way home we stopped in Clarksville for supper. It was a great day.

SUGAR CREEK CANOE TRIP - On June 19th several members met Larry & Helen Kahl for a trip down Sugar Creek near Turkey Run. There were experts and beginners, but all enjoyed the trip and learned something about canoeing.

WEEKEND OUTINGS

SPRING MILL STATE PARK - About 45 people plus 6 day hikers enjoyed a winter weekend at Spring Mill in late January. Early Saturday evening we met for a hospitality hour, and then after dinner, the naturalist, Marquita Manley, presented a slide program about the Park. She then discussed at some length the origin of the State Park system and we had an interesting question and answer period. Had about 16 miles of hiking during the weekend.

GNAW BONE CAMP - MEMORIAL WEEKEND - Back for the 23rd Memorial weekend at beautiful Gnow Bone Camp were some 52 members and guests and 16 Day Hikers who joined in the hiking. An orientation hike on Saturday afternoon was followed that evening by a clogging show at the amphitheater presented by the Ernsting cloggers. The Gnow Bone players had a program about when to grin, and also about the sourdough and the belly button. After the Sunday morning hike, we had our cook-out lunch. After the social hour and evening meal, we assembled in the shelter for a musical treat from the Johnson County Folk singers under the direction of Linda Norton. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance as we had a flag raising on Monday morning. Another hike and then lunch, and it was time to say goodbye to another great time at Gnow Bone.

CUMBERLAND FALLS STATE PARK - We visited Cumberland Falls Park for the Labor Day Weekend. This is the home of the "Moon Bow". Some 53 members and guests enjoyed the trails and steps in the Park. The weatherman cooperated by having the rain at night. A. T. Mulberry showed slides of their recent trip. And the square dancing and other entertainment provided by the Park was in a shelter near by. Got in 21 miles of hiking during the weekend.

REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

OCTOBER - Began October with a couple of hikes in Metamora. The Cataract Falls Festival was a lot fun. We visited the Columbus Ethnic Expo. Hiked in Mooresville, North Salem, Terre Haute, and Cincinnati (tall stacks). The Wabash Heritage was interesting. And we enjoyed the Muscatatuck National Refuge. Weekday hikes included Zionsville, Morgan-Monroe, downtown.

NOVEMBER - We struggled up the hills of Clark Forest, and we walked along Brookville Lake. Shakamak was interesting this time of year, and so was Shadyside Lake. There was some rugged hiking in the Deam Wilderness, and also on the Yellowwood Trail. Brown County Park is always interesting. Visited Mooresville and Plainfield. Weekdays at Broad Ripple, Eagle Creek.

DECEMBER - Starve Hollow was a rugged hilly hike. Went around the county with Dennis. We crossed covered bridges over Flat Rock with the Begemans. Hiked a state park with the unusual name of Ouabache. Christmas lights in the rain in Greenfield. Anderson orchard was interesting. And we walked from Martinsville to Mahalasville. Some weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Zionsville, and Christmas downtown.

JANUARY - Celebrated New Year's at Ellenberger. And then to Morgan-Monroe forest. Hiked at Cedar Bluff. The levee to Thatcher was interesting. We walked around the Airport. Visited Indianapolis University. There was light snow on Ohio Road. We visited Celina and Indian Lakes. Saw the west side of Eagle Creek. Ended January at Metamora and a hike at Broad Ripple and the canal. Weekdays found us at Bradford Woods, Speedway, Glendale, and Irvington

FEBRUARY - Took some rugged hikes in Brown County and also at Yellowwood. Then on to Logansport and the Wabash River. Visited Patoka lake. Saw such diverse places as Atterbury, Pea Ridge, and the Crosley preserve. Hiked along the levee and the canal. Turkey Run was nice. Weekday hikes at Plainfield, Irvington, Chapel Hill

MARCH - Visited the towns of Brooklyn, Shelbyville, Martinsville, and Greenfield. Hiked at Eagle Creek a couple of times. Saw Gustafson Park, and we hiked at Bradford Woods. Visited the Fern Hills preserve. Took a couple of Riley trails and we walked along the White River. Some weekday hikes included Plainfield, Chapel Hill, and Irvington.

APRIL - Visited the high point in Indiana. Explored McCormick's Creek, Whitewater, and Spring Mill State Parks. Saw the wild flowers at Blatchley Woods. Easter found us at Garfield Park. Some rugged hikes included Forks of Salt Creek, Yellowwood trail, Yellow Birch Ravine, and the Adventure trail. At Eagle Creek several times. Weekday hikes at Fall Creek, Eagle Creek.

MAY - Around Eagle Creek on the Early Bird. Walked the Whitewater Gorge. Hiked the Low Gap trail at Morgan-Monroe and also the Stonecarver's Hike. Enjoyed the Bus Trip to Bernheim. Visited T.C. Steele. Hiked around Yellowwood Lake. There were five covered bridges in Parke county. Visited Oldenburg. Weekdays found us at Broad Ripple, Farley Fling, and Irvington

JUNE - Walking the Knobstone trail on National Trails Day. We were also on the Monon loop. Explored the Deam wilderness. Visited Brown County, Turkey Run, Versailles, and Clifty Falls State Parks. Celebrated railroad days at North Vernon. Saw the historic sites at Crawfordsville. Hiked at Madison and at Muncie. Some weekday hikes at Eagle Creek, Ellenberger, downtown

JULY - Started out at Lieber S.R.A. And we hiked areas near Plainfield. The Wabash Heritage trail was wet. Visited Mounds State Park, and also McCormick's Creek Park. Went up and down some hills on the Crooked Creek/Wrecker hike. Visited historic Irvington. A long walk in the Hamilton Southeastern area. Then we went to Greensburg. Weekday hikes were at Eagle Creek, Beech Grove, and Chapel Glen.

AUGUST - Visited Greenwood, Plainfield, French Lick, and Martinsville. Enjoyed a picnic hike with the Ernstings. Went around Hendricks county. And then took a Volksmarch at Fort Harrison. Saw the four lakes at Morgan-Monroe along with a wiener roast. Whitewater Park was an interesting hike. And so was Mary Gray Sanctuary. Weekday hikes Plainfield, downtown.

SEPTEMBER - Walked across the state (part I, II, and III). There was a volksmarch at German Park. Climbed the hills on the Delaney Loop of the Knobstone. Walked along the Monon trail. Visited Mooresville, Fort Wayne, Greensburg, and Mitchell for the Persimmon Festival. Went to Possum Trot from Morgan-Monroe. Had a final hike at Shades State Park. Some weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Speedway, and Irvington.
