As a leader in outdoor recreation in Indiana, the Club scheduled 380 hikes, 2 weekend outings, 1 backpack, and a summer picnic. ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - We met at 10:00 AM at Shelter "B" for the morning hike on a Saturday in July. The rest of the people arrived in time for the pitch-in picnic. Everybody had a good time as we enjoyed the day with hiking club friends. Eagle Creek is a great place for a picnic.

SUGAR CREEK CANOE TRIP - One Friday in June several members met with Larry & Helen Kahl near Turkey Run Park for a delightful canoe trip down Sugar Creek. The beginners learned much from the "Experts".

WEEKEND OUTINGS

MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - About 43 people plus several day hikers enjoyed the beauty of the Park in late January. Got in some 17 miles of hiking during the weekend. Just before dinner we had our social hour in the Oak Room, and after dinner Marquita Manley, a park naturalist presented a slide program about the Park. She had given a similar program the previous year at Spring Mill. It was a nice weekend during the winter.

GNAW BONE CAMP - Some 61 members and guests and about 14 day hikers enjoyed this 24th annual visit to the hills and valleys of Gnow Bone. Had an orientation hike Saturday afternoon. That evening after supper we gathered in the Shelter for some serious harmonizing and singing. The Sunday morning hike was followed by the cook-out by the amphitheater. Sunday afternoon was enjoyed in various ways - some went swimming, some took another hike, some went to town, and many just enjoyed an afternoon of leisure. Sunday evening at the amphitheater we had a musical treat from the "Johnson County Folk Singers" under the direction of Linda Norton. Linda and her dad, Fred Lorenz, sang a duet. Monday morning as part of our observance of Memorial Day, we recited the pledge of allegiance as we had a flag raising ceremony, followed by the playing of taps by Allen Pekar. Another hike and it was time to say goodbye.

REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

OCTOBER - Started the year with a backpack on the Knobstone. Went on the Yellowwood trail, and had a good time at the Cataract Falls festival. The early birds went around Eagle Creek. Visited Mounds and Turkey Run parks. Hiked the hills of Clark and Morgan-Monroe forests. Had an interesting visit to the Falls of the Ohio. Took some more hills at Gnow Bone Camp. Walked along the Turkey Track, and saw the Ghost-N'-Goblins on Halloween. Weekday hikes included Devonshires, Morgan-Monroe, Warren Central, and downtown.

NOVEMBER - Hiked at Shades, Brown County and Versailles parks. Visited Big Walnut Creek. Saw the Indian trails of Frances Slocum. Saw many covered bridges, Weekday hikes included Fort Harrison, Town & Country, Speedway express, Sloshed through the rain and about 4 inches of water with Mary Pulsifer at Eagle Creek.

DECEMBER - Started December near Blackwell Lake. And followed Dennis for a couple of trips across the State. Metamora was beautiful with all the Christmas lighting. Hiked the bricks of Bloomfield, and then took a couple of hikes in downtown Indy to see the lights. We saw the Stone Carvers at Morgan-Monroe, Visited Starky Park near Zionsville. Ended the month at Atterbury Wildlife. Some weekday hikes - Zionsville, Downtown, Irvington.

JANUARY - Began the New Year with Marge & Bob at Ellenberger. Saw some Rushville covered bridges. Visited beautiful downtown Shelbyville. Learned about Eugene Debs in Terre Haute. The little Miami Scenic Trail proved to be interesting. Avis took some to Cincinnati where Dennis slid down a hill. We visited Martin forest and the Glendale Fish area. Went to Mahalasville from Martinsville. Strolled the canal from Broad Ripple. Weekday hikes included Castleton Square, Bradford Woods, Chapel Hill, (Cancelled one hike - 27° below)

FEBRUARY - Took a rugged hike at Cedar Bluff. Then walked along the Ohio road. Went around the Morse Reservoir. The 5 bridges near Greencastle proved to be very icy. Next on the schedule was Patoka Lake and Shirley Creek Horse Trail. Went from Durbin to Strawtown and from Morristown to Blue River area. Visited downtown Greenwood and suburban areas. Some weekday hikes included - Plainfield, Irvington, and Downtown.

MARCH - Braved the winds of March at Fern Cliff preserve, and also at Flat Rock. Saw the trails at McCormick's again. Mabel took us to Brooklyn (Not N.Y.). Spring Mill was beautiful at this time of year. Nan took some to Ferdinand-NAN-NAN-NAN forest. And also to Celina and Indian lakes. Weekday hikes - Morgan-Monroe, Warren Central, and Speedway.

APRIL - A rugged Good Friday hike at Morgan-Monroe. We saw many wildflowers at such places as Eagle Creek, Holliday Park, Lieber S.R.A., and McCormick's Creek. The Bedford Club had a volksmarch at Spring Mill. The trail along the Wabash-Tippecanoe rivers was lovely. And the hills at Starve Hollow were rugged. Hiked again at Walnut Creek, and also at Summit Lake. Visited the Yellow Birch Ravine. Weekday hikes - Eagle Creek, White River Pky, downtown.

MAY - Began at Shades and at Eagle Creek, A 500 mile mini marathon was quite an event. Explored the trails at Versailles and Shakamak parks. It was a long way around the airport. The low gap trail at Morgan-Monroe was next. There were a couple of volkmarches at Fort Harrison. The Vernon special with Jim is always interesting. Dennis went across the State a couple of times. And we walked the Yellowwood trail again. Weekday hikes included - Eagle Creek, Fall Creek Corridor, Chapel Glen, and Warren Central.

JUNE - Visited a couple of state parks - McCormick's Creek and Shades. The T.C. Steele trail proved to be interesting. Walked along the old B & O trail. And walked part of the Knobstone from Deam Lake. Jim took us on a train ride to Bloomington. The town of Chesterfield was an interesting place to visit. Weekday hikes - Fort Harrison, Eagle Creek, Devonshires, downtown.

JULY - Began July at Heritage Lake and the Geist reservoir. Walked the roads near Plainfield. And the old Monon trail was hiked. Explored Turkey Run and Brown County parks. The Wabash Heritage trail is an interesting historical area. Walked along White River in Muncie. The Stueben preserve and Raccoon Lake S.R.A. were also hiked. Carol Ernsting had a picnic at Sweetwater/Cordry lakes. Some weekday hikes - Warren Central, Speedway, Glendale/Broad Ripple.

AUGUST - Hiked to the Stone Carvers in Morgan-Monroe and to Starky Park in Zionsville. Wal and swam at Spring Mill. The Cables showed us the four lakes in Morgan-Monroe. And we finished with a hilly hike at Crooked Creek. Weekdays at Plainfield, Ellenberger, and downtown

SEPTEMBER - There was a volksmarch from German Park. Hiked the Monon trail again. Saw a couple of covered bridges near Rushville. Some early birds went around Eagle Creek, and some visited the Llama farm. The Art Museum was interesting. Saw the old town of Oldenburg. Finished our hiking at Mounds Park. Some weekday hikes - Eagle Creek, Chapel Hill, Ellenberger.
