The Indianapolis Hiking Club was organized in January 1957 by a group of hikers who had been working on the Yellowwood Trail in the Brown County area. This yearly report, detailing some of the events, is a part of the continuing history of the Club. Article II of the Club constitution gives the purpose of the Club --- "To encourage a love of nature, through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing".

The Indianapolis Hiking Club is proud to be a leader in outdoor activities in Indiana. Last year the Club sponsored 515 hikes, 3 overnight outings, a summer picnic, a canoe trip, and a Christmas party. There were also a couple of general assembly meetings. As you look through the listing of hikes on following pages, you will appreciate the diversity of recreation offered by the Club. Total paid up membership at the end of the year was 515.

SPECIAL SCHEDULED EVENTS

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - The First Friends Church on East Kessler was the site of annual Christmas party. After the pitch-in buffet dinner, we were treated to the music of THE CUMBERLAND GAP, a Blue Grass group of singers and musicians. Santa showed up as usual.

ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - Once again Shelter "B" at Eagle Creek was our choice for the picnic. The hikers started at 10:00 AM and the rest arrived in time for the pitch-in. Many ate too much - but what are picnics for. Some really delicious treats on the buffet table. It was enjoyable visiting with old friends on a lovely day in the Park.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS - These meetings are fine opportunities to meet with members on a social basis, get better acquainted, and enjoy a good program. The meeting on March 9th featured Jean Deeds who discussed her recent through-hike on the Appalachian Trail. Her talk and pictures were fascinating as she told about the trials and happenings along the Trail, during this arduous trek. The meeting on September 14th was for the election of officers. The featured speaker was Tom Rumer, author of two books on the Oregon Trail. His story of the people and events on the Trail brought this famous western landmark to life for us.

WEEKEND OUTINGS

CLIFTY FALLS STATE PARK - Some 56 members and guests plus several day hikers enjoyed the hills and canyons of Clifty Falls on a nice weekend in November. Saturday evening found us all together in one of the rooms for an old-fashioned social - talking and munchin' snacks. The trails were in great shape and we got in 20 miles of hiking. What a great way to enjoy one of Indiana's State Parks in the fall.

GNAW BONE CAMP - The Club's 25th anniversary Memorial Weekend at Gnow Bone was a huge success. Some 62 members and guests plus many day hikers enjoyed the trails and hills. An orientation hike Saturday afternoon was followed that evening by the music of the Irish Troubadour, Scotty Grant, who told Irish jokes as he led us in many of the old familiar songs. Had a great Sunday morning hike. Our usual Sunday cook-out was in the dining room as the amphitheater grounds were still muddy. Sunday evening we had special musical treat from the "Johnson County Folk Singers" under the direction of Linda Norton. The Camp presented us with a 25th Anniversary Cake at the Sunday evening meal, and those who had attended all the outings posed for a picture. Monday morning we recited the Pledge of Allegiance as we raised the flag while Tom Hill played taps on the bugle. Another hike and then time to say goodbye.

STARVED ROCK STATE PARK - This beautiful State Park in Illinois was a good choice for a Labor Day weekend outing. 44 members and guests enjoyed the canyons and ridges of this historic park along the Illinois River. The Saturday afternoon hike was a short and easy orientation hike exploring some of the areas near the Lodge. That evening our social hour was in a cabin near the Lodge. Sunday morning we hiked more extensively in several of the canyons along the River. Sunday evening after supper, we met in the cabin for a slide show presented by Sam Lloyd of previous Club events, reviving memories of other occasions. Another hike on Monday morning then it was time to check-out. Our group was impressed by the beauty of this historic Lodge, particularly the dining room and the massive fireplace in the Great Room. The view from the Lodge overlooking the valley was spectacular. We have to go back again.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

OCTOBER - Started the year with a Shelbyville festival and a Fort Harrison Volksmarch. Visited Columbus and Noblesville. Took many hills at Nebo Ridge, Clark forest, and Gnow Bone Camp. Walked along the Turkey Track, and we saw five covered bridges in Parke County. There were other festivals at Cataract and at Greenfield. Explored Turkey Run and were amazed by the fossils at Falls of the Ohio Park. Weekday hikes included Broad Ripple, Morgan-Monroe, and Downtown.

NOVEMBER - We hiked the trails at several State Parks - Versailles, Summit Lake, and White-water. We explored the Blackwell Lake area, and climbed the hills at Brown County and also at Knob Lake (Just one more hill). Hiked along the Knobstone, and took a walk around Hendricks County. Weekday hikes at Eagle Creek, Speedway, and the Butler area.

DECEMBER - There were some long hikes at Deam Wilderness, Ferdinand Forest, Martin Forest, and Franklin County. Christmas hikes at Garfield Conservatory and Ellenberger. We walked the Bloomfield bricks. Also saw the towns of Plainfield and Speedway. Some of the weekday day hikes were in Zionsville, Fall Creek, Downtown, and Starky Park.

JANUARY - Our usual New Year's day at Ellenberger. Several took a couple of days in Ohio on the Little Miami Scenic Trail and the town of Lebanon, Ohio. Oubache Park was an interesting place to visit. Saw five bridges on a hike near Greencastle. Saw the Cedar Bluffs preserve. And ate chili after a hike at Morgan-Monroe. The canal near Metamora was an historic area in which to hike. Weekdays we hiked at Bradford Woods, Chapel Hill, Target East, & Wash Sq Ma.

FEBRUARY - Walked along the Ohio Road. Visited the Stone Carvers in Winter. Some long hikes at Brown County, Crosley Preserve, and the Thousand Acres Walkabout near Washington. Weekdays found us at Broad Ripple, Plainfield, Downtown, and Irvington. Also Greenfield Cardinal Points.

MARCH - Began March at Fern Cliff Preserve. Hiked the T.C. Steele Memorial area. Visited the towns of Brooklyn and Anderson (Shadyside), and Carmel. Went to Mounds Park. Longer hikes at Blue River/Morrison, Martinsville forestry, and Flat Rock. Some weekday hikes included Morgan-Monroe, Broad Ripple, and Speedway.

APRIL - Started April at Muscatatuck Refuge. Then we visited the Williams Dam, Versailles Park, and the forks of Salt Creek. A large group strolled through the grounds of Crown Hill. A Good Friday hike at Morgan-Monroe, and then back to the hills of Brown County. An enjoyable Easter hike at Garfield. We visited the Art Museum and Holcomb gardens. Longer hikes at Jackson forest, Yellowwood Lake, and Walnut Creek. On weekdays we hiked in Broad Ripple, Greenwood, Downtown, and Eagle Creek.

MAY - A group hiked the 500 Mini Marathon. The Whitewater Gorge was an historic area to explore. Had volksmarches at Fort Harrison and in Greenfield. The Mary Gray sanctuary was a nice place to hike. Longer hikes at Hardin Ridge, Low Gap Trail, and Portland Arch. Broad Ripple, Warren Central, Naval Armory, and Chapel Glen were weekday hikes.

JUNE - Walked around Eagle Creek on National Trails Day. Visited the cities of Columbus, Mooresville, Muncie, Vernon, Seymour, and Pendleton. Hiked at Spring Mill and Whitewater Parks. Longer hikes included the B & O Trail, Arlington/Homer, Blue River Valley I. Yellow Springs and the Buckeye Trail in Ohio were hiked by one group. Weekday hikes included Brownsburg, Broad Ripple, and Fall Creek.

JULY - Hiked at Geist reservoir and at Salamonie Reservoir. Took a hike in Bloomington at IU. Went to Turkey Run, Spring Mill, Shakamak, and McCormick's Creek. Some long hikes on the Knobstone, the Four Lakes, North Salem, and Heritage Lake. Some spent a weekend at Mammoth Cave hiking the surface trails. There were weekday hikes at Broad Ripple, Irvington, Lake Maxinshall, and Speedway.

AUGUST - Walked the Wabash Heritage Trail. Went to Raccoon, Turkey Run, Mounds, & McCormick's Creek Parks. Some of the longer hikes were at Franklin County, on the Knobstone, Omega/Aroma, and around Hendricks county. Visited Chesterfield, and hiked the Butler area. Plainfield, Warren Central, Broad Ripple, Downtown, and Eagle Creek were weekday hikes.

SEPTEMBER - Several camped and hiked at the Dunes over Labor Day. Had a hike through historic Irvington. The James Dean festival was at Fairmont. Hiked from Mooresville to Monrovia. Hiked the Old Northside. Visited Brown County and Starky Parks. Longer hikes included Crooked Creek, Clark forest, Green-Sullivan forest, Covered Bridge trail, and Starve Hollow. Weekdays at Eagle Creek, Fall Creek, Chapel Hill and Broad Ripple.

The write-up of the Highlights of the hiking year above is a partial account of hiking activities of the Club. On following pages is a complete detailed listing of all the hikes and outings. Following this is the mileage records of members. New members voted in during the year are at the end with the month of admittance by their name. The last listing is the records of children and grandchildren who hiked during the year.
