The Indianapolis Hiking Club was organized by a group of people who had been working on the completion of the Yellowwood Trail. They met in January of 1957 and founded the Club. As stated in the Club constitution the purpose of the Club shall be "To encourage a love of nature through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing".

Each year the TRAIL BLAZER is published as a record of the activities of the Club during the previous year, and is an ongoing history of the Club. For year ending October 1, 2000 there were 786 scheduled hikes (of which 7 were cancelled). There were 3 overnights, a summer picnic, and a Christmas party. There were two general assembly meetings open to all the members. Total membership as of October 1, 2000 was 580 people.

#### SCHEDULED EVENTS

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - Some 175 people enjoyed the festivities at the Primo Banquet Hall on South Keystone. The buffet was delicious and we all enjoyed the music of the "White River Sounds" group of Sweet Adelines. It was a special time to visit with old friends.

ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - The hikers took off in the morning from Shelter "B" in Eagle Creek Park. What a beautiful day! After the hike we all enjoyed the pitch-in with the rest of the people who had come for the picnic. Really great food - with special recipes. Even had a few games. A great way to enjoy the companionship of other members of the Club.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS - General Assembly meetings serve a special purpose of bringing members together for interesting programs. A good time to visit with other hikers and learn more about the Club. The March 11th meeting was at the Knights of Columbus Hall on west 71st St. Our program featured Major Jeff Ward of Eagle Creek Park. He brought his traveling museum and talked about raptors. Our meeting on September 14th was at the Unitarian Universalist Church on west 43rd St. The first order of business was the election of officers for the coming year. After that there was the presentation of the "25" year awards to 77 members, some who had been members for over 40 years. Three of the original members were present; Frances Ellison, Jerry Johnson, and Edgar Stresino. They were charter members in January of 1957. Over half of the 77 members were present at the meeting to receive their award. Following the presentation of the awards, Al Drehobl showed slides of a hiking tour of England and Scotland and Wales, He also showed some slides from a backpacking trip in the American West.

OVERNIGHT OUTINGS

SPRING MILL STATE PARK - There were 68 members and their guests who enjoyed this winter weekend at Spring Mill. We had lots of hiking and some good weather. Saturday evening in the hotel lobby the Park was featuring an "Old Tyme Jazz Session". It was fun. We had our own program in the Elm room featuring a video and lots of visiting. Spring Mill is a great place for a group like ours.

GREAT SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK - We all stayed in Gatlinburg and Pigeon Forge and there was plenty of activity in both places. Met each day at Sugarlands Center for hiking. Some 25 people climbed Mt. LeConte and spent the night. (Got a little cold by morning). Most of the rest of the people hiked some of the lower trails in the area. Lots of sight-seeing in our spare time. Good restaurants and lots of shows were available. A beautiful time of year to visit this part of Tennessee.

GNAW BONE CAMP - This was the Hiking Club's 30th anniversary to be at Gnow Bone Camp over the Memorial Day Weekend. The weatherman cooperated and we got in lots of hiking along the trails and up and down the hills of this Brown County camp. Played lots of card games Saturday evening, along with a lot of talking. Our Sunday evening program featured the Johnson County Folk Singers performing in the dining room. They always put on a good program of folk and country music. Monday morning we gathered around the flag pole and pledged allegiance as the flag was raised. A time to remember the true meaning of Memorial Day. Tom Hill played taps in the background.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

OCTOBER - What a great month to hike in Indiana! Started out on part of the Knobstone near Delaney. And many enjoyed the festival at Cataract Falls. Many took part in the Second Annual Indianapolis Marathon near Ft. Harrison. We enjoyed the beauty of Gnow Bone Camp as we hiked the trails. And ate fried chicken for lunch. Some of us explored the town of Carthage. And there was a volksmarch at Summit Lake. We saw the tall stacks at Cincinnati. We hiked and explored the trails at Tippecanoe River State Park. And there was a mini-marathon at Morgan-Monroe forest. Hiked some of the trails at two state parks - Spring Mill and Turkey Run. We closed October hiking at Clark forest. Some of the weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Ft. Harrison, Broad Ripple, Washington Square, downtown, and the White River Trail.

NOVEMBER - Hiked at several state parks - Brown County, Turkey Run, Shades, and McCormick's Creek. It was quite warm for a hike at Southeastway Park. And was very warm at Morgan-Monroe. The Little Miami Scenic Trail proved to be very interesting place to hike in Ohio. We hiked weekdays at Eagle Creek, the Indianapolis Zoo, Ft. Harrison, Broad Ripple, Speedway, IUPUI, and Marott Park.

DECEMBER - Had some rain at Brown County and also at Starkey Park. We had a hike at Ft. Harrison and also at Garfield Park. Christmas Day we hiked downtown on a Y2K test. Had a 5 bridge hike near Greencastle. And it was rainy on the Monon trail. Weekday hikes included Washington Square, Eagle Creek, Ft. Harrison, Broad Ripple, Downtown, Beech Grove.

JANUARY - There was some snow in January. We hiked in the towns of Greenfield, Shelbyville, and Franklin. Owen-Putnam forest was an interesting place to explore. We walked along the Tow Path and the Monon. There was some snow along the hills of Starve Hollow. We took some of the trails in Holliday Park. Weekdays found us hiking at Clermont, Chapel Hill, Broad Ripple, IUPUI, Eagle Creek, Castleton Sq., Wash. Sq., and Bradford Woods.

FEBRUARY - Had some snow and rain in the middle of February. The Low Gap trail was a cold one, with a little snow. One group explored Clermont on a hike. Ohio Road and Greenfield were both very cold hikes. The hills at Panther Creek gave us a stimulating hike. Had lots of rain in Carmel. Jackson forest and the Skyline Drive was a beautiful hike. Followed a rail trail in Zionsville. Several visited Craig Park in Greenwood. Some hikes on weekdays were at Eagle Creek, Wash. Sq. Marott Park, Downtown, Irvington, Carmel, Clearwater, Ft. Harrison, and Southport.

MARCH - The winds of March found us exploring the trails in several of our State Parks - Mounds, Summit Lake, Ft. Harrison, and Spring Mill. Also took some trails in Eagle Creek. There was snow on the trails at Fern Cliff. However it was beautiful the next day at Yellowwood/ Dubois. Had a good 13 mile hike at Cedar Bluffs. Jill took a group into Deam Wilderness on a 16 mile rugged hike. Some weekday hikes included Clermont, Speedway, Eagle Creek, IUPUI, Morgan-Monroe forest, Greenwood, Clermont, and Broad Ripple.

APRIL - Began April with a Volksmarch at Mounds State Park. Then on the hills of Gnaw Bone Camp. It was cold and drizzly at Crosley forest. And very windy on a 5 mile hike along Walnut Creek. A beautiful sunny 14 mile hike at Morgan-Monroe. Several state parks including Shades, Versailles, and Ft. Harrison. Had an Easter hike at Eagle Creek. Saw some beautiful ravines at Turkey Run, and finished April with a rugged hike near T.C. Steele. Weekdays we walked at Ft. Harrison, Broad Ripple, Eagle Creek, Downtown, Wash. Sq., and Holliday Park.

MAY - Joined with some 20,000 others in the 500 mini-marathon. The Deam wilderness proved to be quite rugged. Hiked the trails in Whitewater, Summit Lake, and Brown County Parks. There were some beautiful trails in Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. We explored the Yellow Birch Ravine and also the Carnes Mill Nature preserve. Had a rainy hike along Geist. Weekdays we walked at Eagle Creek, Wash. Sq., Greenwood, Clermont, Greenwood, and Mounds.

JUNE - Went up to Tippecanoe River State Park for a Volksmarch. It was hot and humid at Brown County Park. Took some of the trails at Spring Mill and also at McCormick's Creek state parks. Had an interesting hike at Hardy Lake. Hiked in Morgan-Monroe forest. And joined a Volksmarch near the Hinkle fieldhouse. During the week we had hikes at Irvington, Eagle Creek, Ft. Harrison, Broad Ripple, Clermont, Carmel, and Holliday Park

JULY - Started July with a good hike at Pendleton. Then explored the town of New Castle. We enjoyed a hike and ice cream social in Fishers. Walked some of the trails in several State Parks - Shakamak, Clifty Falls, Lieber, and Ouabache. Also took some of the hills at Brown County State Park. The Oldenburg Volksmarch proved to be very interesting. Visited the town of Clermont again. And walked some of the trails in Anderson near Shadyside Lake. Some of the weekday hikes were at Ft. Harrison, Eagle Creek, Broad Ripple, Speedway, Carmel, Greenwood, and on the tow path.

AUGUST - Took another Volksmarch at Brown County Park. Walked some of the streets in Plainfield. Hiked at several state parks - Ft. Harrison, Whitewater, Brown County, and Turkey Run. We also visited the town of Franklin. Took a hike near the Museum of Art. Some weekday hikes included; Broad Ripple, Beech Grove, Downtown, Washington Square, Eagle Creek, Clearwater, White River trail, Ft. Harrison, and Marott Park

SEPTEMBER - Had a very hot hike at Eagle Creek Park. A large group went to the Volksmarch at Versailles State Park. We hiked along the Monon Trail. And we walked through a new development in Carmel. The Wabash Heritage Trail proved to be very interesting. Another exploration of Southeastway Park. We ended our hiking year with one group in Eagle Creek Park, and another group in the Deam Wilderness. We had some weekday hikes in September at Broad Ripple, Eagle Creek, Greenwood, Washington Square, Ft. Harrison, IUPUI, Clermont, Chapel Hill, and Fall Creek.
