The Indianapolis Hiking Club celebrates its 45th birthday in January of 2002. A group of people who had been working on the Yellowwood Trail met and founded the Club. Their purpose as stated in the Club constitution "To encourage a love of nature through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing" Over the years the Club has grown and prospered and has been a leader in outdoor recreation in Indiana.

The TRAIL BLAZER is published each year as a record of the Club's activities. The mileage records date back to October 1, 1967 when the Club first started keeping track of each members activities. Last year the Club scheduled 795 hikes, 5 overnight outings, the summer picnic, and the Christmas party. There were also two General Assembly meetings. Total membership as of October 1, 2001 was 589.

A volunteer organization such as ours needs dedicated leaders to maintain the vitality and the growth. We have been fortunate to have such people each year, and last year was no exception. SCHEDULED EVENTS

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - Over 150 members and friends assembled at the Primo Banquet Hall on south Keystone Avenue on December 1st. It was fun visiting during the social hour before the delicious buffet. Our entertainment was the Perry Meridian Jazz Band performing a wide variety of music from big band to pop to seasonal.

ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - We met at Shelter "B" in Eagle Creek on July 14th. The hikers took off in the morning on a beautiful summer day. The rest of the people joined the hikers for the pitch-in about 12:30. A lot of good food with some special recipes. About 80 members and friends enjoyed this get-together in such a beautiful park.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS: These meetings are designed to serve the purpose of bringing members together for interesting programs while visiting and meeting other members. The meeting on February 28th was at the Unitarian Universalist Church on West 43rd street. Our program featured Carol Barnes who gave a most interesting talk about her experiences as a thru-hiker on the Appalachian Trail in 2000. Carol enjoyed this hike so much that she repeated it in 2001, finishing on September 30th. Our meeting on September 13th was also at the Unitarian Universalist Church. The first order of business was the election of officers for the new year. President Pat Lawler presented 25 year awards to John Woodard and Will Harrer who were present. Steve Warner's award was to be mailed. Our program was a slide show by Al Drehobl, who had some beautiful slides from hiking and rafting trips in the west. Refreshments were served after each of the meetings.

OVERNIGHT OUTINGS

MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - What a beautiful weekend we had at McCormick's the first part of March. 60 members and guests spent two nights at the Canyon Inn, while 19 day hikers joined us at various times for the hiking. The Sycamore Room was the site of our afternoon social and the evening program. Marquita Manley, the naturalist, showed us a lot about owls. And we had a short video about the I.H.C. Ms beauty contest, which had taken place many years ago at Gnaw Bone Camp. Got in lots of hiking.

SMOKY MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK- Most stayed in Gatlinburg and enjoyed the town's hospitality. The hiking was spectacular. The weather cooperated - clear and cold on Thursday, warming up by Saturday. Hal Rynerson led 5 hikes of from 5 to 7 miles. Jean Ballinger led 3 hikes of 11 miles each. Lots of sight-seeing in the spare time. Good restaurants and shows were available. This is a beautiful time of the year to visit this part of the Appalachians in eastern Tennessee.

GNAW BONE CAMP- This was the 32nd Memorial Day weekend for the Hiking Club to be at Gnaw Bone Camp. We dedicated this weekend to Fred Lorenz, founder of Gnaw Bone Camp and a good friend of the Hiking Club. Fred died December 9th and he will be truly missed. We got in lots of hiking each day, although it rained each night. Saturday evening after supper our entertainment was LEE THE MAGICIAN. His tricks and magic fooled all, old and young alike. Sunday evening after supper we had the JOHNSON COUNTY FOLK SINGERS. As usual their brand of music is right at home at Gnaw Bone. There were 59 overnightriders and around 30 day hikers who enjoyed the beauty of the hills of Brown County at this camp.

MAMMOTH CAVE NATIONAL PARK- Around 25 members and guests enjoyed the beautiful weather while hiking at Mammoth Cave. Pat Thomas and Hal Rynerson led hikes from 6 to 13 miles during the four days of hiking during the second of June. There were a lot activities available in the area for additional entertainment and sight-seeing. There was a pitch-in and camp fire in the campground Saturday evening.

HOCKING HILLS STATE PARK- In late October some 25 members and guests enjoyed the trails in this beautiful area of Ohio. Jill McFall led the hikes through the various area of this Park, including Old Man's Cave, Conkles Cave, Rock House, Cantwell Cliffs, Ash Cave, and Zaleski State Forest. Some stayed in the campground and others in motels in the area. Had beautiful autumn weather each day.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

OCTOBER- This is a great time to hike in Indiana. Started out at Shades. Then on to the three lakes trail. Had a volksmarch at Greenfield. Hiked and ate fried chicken at Gnaw Bone Camp on a beautiful day. Visited Summit Lake, Salamonie, and Clifty Falls. Saw the sand hill cranes at Jasper-Pulaski. And ended at Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. Some weekday hikes included Broad Ripple, Morgan-Monroe, Wash. Sq., Eagle Creek, Fall Creek, Tow path, Carmel, and Ft. Harrison.

NOVEMBER- Took some trails in Martin St. Forest, visited Franklin and St. Meinrad. State Parks included Shades, McCormick's Creek, and Spring Mill. T. C. Steele proved to be rugged. We took an interesting hike downtown. Weekday hikes included Speedway, Eagle Creek, IUPUI, Broad Ripple, Ft. Harrison, Holliday Park, Greenwood, and Wash. Sq.

DECEMBER- Had lots of snow and ice in the last half of December. Started out exploring the Deam Wilderness. Then Al took us to Fern Cliff for an interesting walk. Saw the Christmas decorations in Metamora. Walked in the snow at Eagle Creek. A couple of hikes cancelled. Weekdays we hiked at Castleton Mall, Eagle Creek, Broad Ripple, Plainfield, Southport, Wash. Sq., Beech Grove, Fall Creek, Clermont, Garfield Park, and Mooresville

JANUARY- Saw the frozen waterfalls at Pendleton. Then on the Greenfield/Pennsy trail. Trudged through some snow on the Brown County/Yellowwood hike. Visited Ouabache St. Pk. It was a cold walk on the Monon. Several weekday hikes included Bradford Woods (snow covered), Eagle Creek (icy and snow), Clermont, IUPUI, Broad Ripple, Chapel Hill, and Castleton Sq. A couple of hikes cancelled because of weather.

FEBRUARY-It was very cold on the Monon. Explored the hills at Starve Hollow. Visited Ft. Harrison again. We enjoyed the downtown area of Shelbyville with Barbie. Then took another trip to Hardy Lake. Walked around part of Geist reservoir. Donner Park in Columbus was interesting to visit. On weekdays we hiked at Eagle Creek, Butler, Irvington, Ft. Harrison, Wash. Sq., Broad Ripple, Carmel, Southport, Castleton, Holliday Park, Zoo.

MARCH- The winds of March found us on the Monon Trail. Then on to Cedar Bluffs near the Monroe Reservoir. We walked part of the Pleasant Run Trail out of Garfield Park. Explored the Deam Wilderness. Quite a crowd at Fort Harrison. Al showed us the hills at Jackson Forest to the Skyline Drive. Another visit to Mounds St. Park. And Bruce had a little bit of everything at Martin Forest (bushwhack, creek beds, fire trails, lakes, and hills) Some of the weekday hikes included Morgan-Monroe, Eagle Creek, Beech Grove, Greenwood, Wash Sq, Speedway, Castleton, Monon trail, and fall creek.

APRIL- Explored Summit Lake on a cold windy day. The trails and bushwhacks at Crosley Wildlife Area were explored. Then back to Gnaw Bone Camp on a hot sunny day. We visited Columbus again. And then a Volksmarch at Gnaw Bone. Explored the Lockerbie and the Canal. Took a longer hike at Shades. And ended April with a good rugged hike at T.C. Steele. Weekdays found us at Broad Ripple, Ft. Harrison, Holliday Park, Eagle Creek, Wash Sq., Fall Creek, Downtown, and White River Trail.

MAY- Started May at Versailles.. Hiked at Hardin Ridge. Explored the Yellow Birch Ravine. Took most of the trails at Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. Several took the hills on the Low Gap trail in Morgan-Monroe. Many took the Volksmarch at Ft. Harrison. Visited Shadyside Lake again. And ended May with a hike at New Palestine. We hiked some of the following on weekdays. Summit Lake, Greenwood, Wash Sq, Chapel Glen, Eagle Creek, IUPUI, Ft. Harrison, Broad Ripple, Mounds St. Pk.

JUNE- Lots of nice warm days in June. There was a strawberry festival near Pioneer Park. It was a sunny day on the hills of the Knobstone (Elk Creek Loop). Took the trails at Shades a couple of times. Explored the back areas of Lieber SRA. Cass had perfect weather on his Panther Creek hike. Visited the towns of Franklin, Muncie, Greenfield, Columbus, Zionsville, and Fishers (ice cream social). Weekday hikes were at Eagle Creek, Clermont, Broad Ripple, White River, Holliday Park, Wash Sq, Ft Harrison, Beech Grove, Greenwood.

JULY- Went on a couple of Volksmarches, one at Delphi and one at Oldenburg. Hiked at several State Parks, Mounds, McCormick's Creek, Clifty Falls, and Turkey Run. Hiked the Brookville reservoir trail. Shadyside Lake in Anderson was a beautiful place to visit. Some weekday hikes were at Clermont, Broad Ripple, Ft Harrison, Greenwood, Eagle Creek, Castle Sq, IUPUI, Speedway, Holliday Park, Fall Creek, Monon, and the Zoo.

AUGUST- Had lots of guests on the Monon/Newcomers. Then on to the Museum of Art. Explored the trails in several state parks: McCormick's Creek, Turkey Run, and Brown County. Took an interesting walk through the downtown area. Hardy Lake was hiked again. Had a volksmarch in Cicero. The Kal-Haven trail in Michigan was walked for two days. And then again to Shelbyville for another volksmarch. Some weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Clearwater, Castleton Sq, Holliday Park, Broad Ripple, Ft Harrison, Beech Grove, Wash Sq, Monon.

SEPTEMBER- Started the month at Shades State Park. Then on to a hike around Geist. Went to German Park for a volksmarch. Visited Patton Cave in Hoosier National. Saw some old time homes in a new addition in Carmel. The hills at the Deam Wilderness were rugged. Spring Mill State Park was a beautiful place to hike. Several walked at the Brookville Reservoir. Took another visit to the area near the Art Museum. Saw the towns of Zionsville and Columbus. Then it was a perfect day to hike around Yellowwood Lake. Ended up the year of hiking with a walk along the Wabash Heritage Trail, and a hike along the Low Gap Trail in Morgan-Monroe. Several weekday hikes included Ft. Harrison, Greenwood, Wash Sq, Zionsville, Chapel Hill, Castleton Sq, IUPUI, Eagle Creek, Broad Ripple, Holliday Park.
