The Indianapolis Hiking Club celebrates its 46th birthday in January of 2003. During 1956 a group of people had been working on the construction of the Yellowwood Trail, a 22 mile cross country trail in Brown County. They met in January of 1957 for the purpose of organizing a hiking club. They were interested in providing outdoor recreation through hiking. The Club constitution which they adopted states the purpose as follows: "To encourage a love of nature through the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings, and to sponsor other activities incidental to the foregoing".

Each year the Club publishes the TRAIL BLAZER as a record of Club activities during the year. Mileage records date back to October 1, 1967 when the Club started keeping track of each members' miles. The Club is stronger than ever, and last year scheduled 860 hikes. There were 3 overnight outings, a summer picnic, a Christmas party, and a 45th Anniversary party. In addition there were also two General Assembly meetings. Total membership as of October 1, 2002 was 617 people.

Many of the children practically lived in the creek, where they caught crawdads, etc. Tried to sell them, but no buyers. Sunday evening we were entertained by the Johnson County Folk Singers. Had the usual Sunday noon cook-out with hot dogs and trimmings. We burned dogs and fingers. Monday morning we had the usual Memorial Day ceremony forming a circle around the flag and pledging allegiance. A beautiful weekend.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SCHEDULED HIKES

OCTOBER - This is the beginning of the Club year, and what a beautiful month to hike in Indiana. Started our hiking in Morgan-Monroe and Salamonie forests. Had Volksmarches at Greenfield, Starve Hollow, and Tippecanoe Battlefield. Hiked and ate hot dogs at Gnow Bone. Took the ten o'clock line trail. Ended the month at Eagle Creek with a costume hike including a hayride and wiener roast. Weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Broad Ripple, Ft Harrison, a couple of Malls, and Fall Creek.

NOVEMBER - Most of the month had nice weather, a little rain near the end. Hiked at several State Parks; Shades, Shakamak, Brown County, and Ft Harrison. Struggled up lot\$ of hills on the Knob Lake hike. Explored the Deam Wilderness. We ended the month on the Monon. Weekdays we hiked at Eagle Creek, IUPUI, the Malls, Broad Ripple, Greenwood, Zionsville, Speedway, and Fall Creek.

DECEMBER - December was quite mild with a little rain. Started December with a 26 mile hike along the Monon. Al took a group bushwhacking in Fern Cliff Preserve. Many took part in a Christmas Volksmarch downtown. Then we hiked in the little town of Metamora, decorated for Christmas along the Canal. Ended the month with Newcomer's hike on the Monon. On weekdays we hiked at Plainfield, Southport, Irvington, Eagle Creek, Wash Sq, and Castleton.

JANUARY - Explored Owen/Putnam Forest on a cloudy cold day. Had snow in Eagle Creek West, and in Greenfield. Had an interesting hike in Brown County and Yellowwood. Ran into a little snow on the west side of Eagle Creek, and also as we walked the streets of Franklin. A large bunch revisited Starkey Park in Zionsville. Ended up at Hardy Lake, a beautiful place to hike. Some weekday hikes included Wash Sq., Castleton, Eagle Creek, Bradford Woods.

FEBRUARY - Started February with a Muncie Volksmarch. Took a hike in Carmel. Walked the hills at Starve Hollow. And we explored Ritchie Woods near Fishers. Had a great hike at Cedar Bluffs Preserve near the Monroe Reservoir. Took a hike at Ouabache State Park, and ended February on a Monon Newcomers hike. Weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Wash Sq, Castleton, Butler, Downtown, Broad Ripple, and Southport.

MARCH - We started out the windy month of March on the Skyline Drive, a rugged hike in Jackson Forest. Walked some hills in Brown County Park. Went back to the Deam Wilderness again. Nebo Ridge proved to be a great place to hike. Cindy took us around Yellowwood Lake again. Ended the month with a Volksmarch at McCormick's Creek. On weekdays we hiked at Eagle Creek, shopping malls, Morgan-Monroe, Broad Ripple, Greenwood, and Speedway.

APRIL - The month was a mixture of beautiful days and rainy days. Had Volksmarches at Mounds State Park, and at Gnow Bone Camp. We explored the Crosley Forest and Wildlife Area. Walked at Shadyside Lake and Anderson. Some walked 36 miles from the Airport area. Explored the Portland Arch area and Fall Creek Gorge. Walked the trails in several State Parks. Hiked in the rain at Martin Forest and at Madison. And had a muddy hike at T.C. Steele. Finished the month on a wildflower hike at McCormick's Creek. Weekday hikes included Monon, Eagle Creek, shopping malls, Broad Ripple, Holliday Park, Ft Harrison, and Fall Creek.

MAY - Had rain the second week of the Month. Lots of hikers took part in the 500 Mini-marathon. We took part in Take Pride in America Day and hiked at Hardin Ridge. Hiked the trails at Mounds and Brown County Parks. Did some off-trail hiking at the Yellow Birch Ravine and Hemlock Cliffs. Took our annual hike on the beautiful trails at the Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. There was a volksmarch at Mississinewa. Then another visit to the Deam Wilderness. Some weekday hikes included Eagle Creek, Wash Sq and Castleton, Broad Ripple, Ft Harrison, and Chapel Glen.

JUNE - Most of the month was hot and humid. Had volksmarches at Charlestown St. Pk, Ft. Wayne and Zionsville. It was hot and muggy on the Knobstone out of Elk Creek. Took a hike around Eagle Creek Lake. Enjoyed a strawberry festival near Pioneer Park. Took a very interesting visit to the town of Wynndale and the Holcomb Estate. Oldenburg was a most interesting town to vist and hike out of. Hiked at Shades, Shakamak, and McCormick's Parks. Hiked the old Erie Canal near Delphi. Ended up June by walking the downtown canal. Some weekday hikes included Southport, Wash Sq., Zionsville, Eagle Creek, Beech Grove, Fall Creek, Ft. Harrison, and Garfield Park.

JULY - This month was also hot and muggy. Had a few beautiful days. Southeastway Park was our beginning hike this month. We also hiked on the levee in Speedway. Took another hike around Eagle Creek Lake. Had many guests on a Newcomer's hike on the Monon. Took a Volksmarch at Oldenburg, and at Carmel. It was a hot day at Turkey Run for hiking. Took a few hills on the 3 lakes trail in Morgan-Monroe. Paid another visit to Oubache Park. And we ended July hiking at Eagle Creek and on the Speedway levee. On weekdays we hiked at Eagle Creek, Broad Ripple, the Monon, Greenwood, Wash Sq., Speedway, Holliday Park, Castleton, Clermont, and downtown.

AUGUST - We continued our summer with many more hot days this month. Started August with another newcomer's hike on the Monon. Rich took a group on a Symphonic Stroll at Conner Prairie. Then back to Eagle Creek for some more hiking. Had a beautiful day for hiking at Versailles St. Park. Also a good day to explore Hardy Lake. We hiked on a couple of Volksmarches, at Potato Creek and at Crown Hill. Back to Shades State Park for an easy hike. Then another visit to the Deam Wilderness. Walked along historic North Meridian Street. Then another visit to the trails in Turkey Run State Park. Took another walk along the Monon. And visited some south side cemeteries. We ended August with another hike at Brown County State Park. Some weekday hikes included Broad Ripple, Eagle Creek, Castleton, Monon, Beech Grove, Wash Sq., Clermont, Ft Harrison, Holliday Park, and Fall Creek.

SEPTEMBER - Some beautiful late summer weather. Had a damaging tornado the third week. We started the month in historic Fountain Square. Then to a new development in Carmel. It was a very hot day to hike in Shades Park. Had some good hikes when we walked at Brown County Park. We visited McCormick's State Park again. Then on to a volksmarch in Irvington. Several took a 26 mile hike on the Monon. And a large group hiked the Mason Ridge in Morgan-Monroe forest. On the hike at Spring Mill we all hiked through the Donaldson Woods Preserve in complete silence. Hiked the historic Wabash Heritage Trail near Lafayette. We ended our hiking for the year at the Art Museum and another visit to T.C. Steele. Weekday hikes this month included the towpath, Eagle Creek, Broad Ripple, Greenwood, Monon, Wash Sq., Chapel Glen, Irvington, Fall Creek, and downtown.
