Sunday, June 3 - YMCA - Flat Rock. (New Hike)

Meet at 10:00 A.M. east side of State House, and proceed via Rd 421 to St. Omer, where we will reassemble at 11:30. We will proceed from there to the area we are to hike. (This is not the Camp proper, but rather a nearby area, but we will hike the Camp as well). Bring food for a cold lunch and a supper cookout. This is a beautiful area along the Flatrock River.
