April 4 -- Pileated Woodpecker Timber Area

April 11 -- Flags of Our Nation

Head east on the Bean Blossom-Gatesville Road from the junction of 135 and 45 for 2.7 miles to Bear Wallow Road. The route to Bear Wallow Hill (beginning point of the hike) is marked by wooden signs. This trail is 12.1 miles long, cross country, and requires the average hiker 5 to 6 hours to complete. There is a designated lunch stop on the trail. Plan to carry your lunch and drink.
