- April 2 LINK OBSERVATORY

Continue past house with pink porch. Go to Link Observatory sign and parking lot. Leader James Dean.

Leave from State House at 1:00 P.M. Take S.R. 135 to Nashville and turn right on S.R. 46. Continue on S.R. 46 to Belmont. Turn left at small red building. Continue on main road to Steele Memorial.
