October 1 - BROWN COUNTY PARK

Leave State House at 1:00 p.m. Take S.R. 135 (S. Meridian) to Nashville. From Nashville take S.R. 46 east to main entrance of the park and follow signs to Lake Strahl. Park and meet at the dam. Hike to start at 2:30 p.m. Hilly. Hike to be about 6 miles. Meet at Fiesta Restaurant on the south side of Nashville for refreshments after the hike. LEADER - GRAEME MILLER

October 8 - HANGING ROCK

Leave State House at 10:00 a.m. Take N. Meridian (U.S. 31) thru Kokomo to the junction of U.S. 31 and U.S. 24. Go right on U.S. 24 around Wabash to Lagro. At Lagro turn south on S.R. 524. Cross the bridge and continue on blacktop. Take road to Salamonie Dam. Cross 2nd. bridge, continue less than a mile to a turn around on the left side of the road. Park at the turn around.
