- OCT 6 MORGAN COUNTY HIKE THROUGH WOODED AND HILLY COUNTRY. - Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take road #135 south to Morgantown. Follow road #252 west about 2 miles to the first county road. Turn left and go to the "T". Turn right, follow the blacktop to Mt. Zion Church. The hike starts at 2:30 P.M. The longer hike is 4 to 5 miles and the shorter one will be 2 miles. Leader - Margret Veale.
- OCT 13 BROWN COUNTY IN IT'S GLORY ! - Leave the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take U.S. 31 south to I-65. After 8 miles on I-65, turn west on S.R. #46 for about 12 miles. Look for the Jack Weddell farm on the north side of the road. A white farmhouse with a small log cabin on the side of the front yard. We suggest the route given in order to avoid going through Nashville on this Sunday. However, if you take road #135 south, the Weddell farm is 3 miles east of Nashville on road #46. The hike will begin at 1:30 P.M. Leader - Renie Stevens.
- OCT 19-20 MCCORMICK'S CREEK OVERNIGHT - (For members and their guests)
The Hiking Club has 10 cabins reserved for this weekend outing. All cabins have a living room with twin beds, a bedroom with 2 double deck bunks, a small room with a lavatory and a toilet, an efficiency kitchen with a sink, an electric stove with an oven, and an electric refrigerator. Showers are available at a central washhouse. A screened dining porch adjoins the kitchen. A wood heating stove is provided in the living room for use during fall and spring months. Each person will have to bring his own dishes and silverware, bedding, blankets, pillows, personal toilet articles including soap. Also food for the weekend.
- Each cabin will accommodate up to 6 people. The cost is \$6.00 a cabin. This is payable in advance at the park when checking in. Please try to arrange your own groups for occupancy of the cabins. Of course it is desirable to have as many as possible in each cabin. We will go on the basis of first come, first served, in allocating the cabins. Please get your reservations in as soon as possible. Use the reservation form below. Tent and trailer camping is also available.
- OCT 27 EAGLE CREEK PARK - Leave the State House at 1:30 P.M. Take U.S. #52 west to 56th street. Turn left of 56th to Reed Road and then north to 62nd street. Turn left and continue west on 62nd to the park entrance. Go about 1 mile into the park to the parking lot beside the small lake. Hike will begin at 2:30 P.M. About 3 miles. Moderate. Leader - Dr. Ray DeFalque.

- NOV 3 ANNUAL LONG HIKE - FLAGS OF THE NATIONS TRAIL. Meet at the State House at 9:00 A.M. Take S.R. 135 south to Bean Blossom, and turn left on the first road past the Lavender House Restaurant. This is the Bean Blossom - Gatesville road. Proceed 2.7 miles to the Bear Wallow road and turn right. The turn is marked by a wooden sign. Reassemble at the parking area on top of Bear Wallow Hill. The hike will begin at 10:30 A.M. There will be a trail fee of 35¢ per hiker. Bring a trail lunch and water to drink. The hike will be 13 miles and should take about six hours. Leader - Peg Franzen.
- NOV 10 ELLENBERGER PARK AND PLEASANT RUN PARKWAY. Meet at the swimming pool parking lot in the park at 2:00 P.M. This is just west of Ritter Avenue about 2 blocks south of 10th street. About 4 miles - easy. Leader Mel Godfrey.
- NOV 17 TURKEY RUN STATE PARK. Leave the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take S.R. 36 to Rockville. Turn right on U.S. 41 and go about 8 miles to S.R. 47. Turn right and go about 3 miles to Park entrance. Reassemble at 2:30 P.M. in the main picnic parking lot near the commissary. About 5 to 6 miles of some of the finest trails in the State Park system. Leaders Bill and Nell Larrison
- NOV 24 MOUNDS STATE PARK Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take North Meridian to 38th street. Turn right (east) on 38th to S.R. 67 and continue east to point where S.R. 67 and S.R. 9 separate. Take S.R. 9 north to sign indicating park 8 miles. Turn as indicated. Continue on Muncie road. Follow signs to park entrance. Park in parking lot near gatehouse. There may be a \$1.00 per car admission charge. Leader Frank Burnett. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M.
