- MAR 2 LAUGHERY CREEK TRAIL. This 13 mile hike was covered in our February bulletin. Be sure to bring a trail lunch, and you must be at the Versailles Park entrance by 10:45 A.M.
- MAR 9 BOY SCOUT CAMP BRADFORD. Leave the State House at 1:15 P.M. and go southwest on Kentucky avenue (Rd 67). Beyond Brooklyn, after passing drive-in theater on the left side of Rd 67, turn right on a black top road (approximately 23 miles from the State House). Continue on winding road to Richard General Store and turn right, proceeding 1.6 miles to camp. Hiking starts at 2:15 P.M. There is a nearby restaurant on Rd 67 for refreshments afterwards. Moderate - 4 to 5 miles. Leaders - Joe and Dan Breimeir.
- MAR 13 SOCIAL - (Thursday night, 7:30 P.M. at the Indiana National Bank, 5635 North Illinois.) This meeting, for members and their invited guests, is a fine opportunity to become acquainted, particularly for our newer members. Dorothy Hanson, Hoosier Motor Club travel representative, is presenting a beautiful color movie, and you can "let your eyes do the hiking for you!" The film "U.S. TRAILS" is 30 minutes of fascinating footage which might give you some vacation ideas for the coming summer. In addition, what the smart and comfortable hiker could wear while on "the trail" will be modeled with a stylish narration by Mrs. Hanson. Refreshments will be served.
- MAR 16 SOUTH GROVE GOLF COURSE, RIVERSIDE PARK, AND LAKE INDY. Go west on 16th Street to the first traffic signal after Victory Field. This is East Riverside Drive. Turn right and go two blocks north to 18th Street and the entrance to South Grove Golf Course. Meet in the parking lot about 1:30 P.M. Easy - 3½ miles. Leader - Ed Lavagnino.
- MAR 23 FORREST PARK TO MORSE RESERVOIR. Meet at 1:00 P.M. at the east side of the State House. Proceed via Rd. 37 north to Noblesville where we will reassemble at 2:00 P.M. at south entrance to the Court House. We will then proceed to Forrest park and over to the dam at Morse Reservoir. We will then return to Forrest Park for a cook-out. Bring your own food. Hike about 5 to 6 miles. Leader - Vic Knarr.
- MAR 30 MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST. Meet at the State House at 1:30 P.M. Take S.R. 37 south. Go through Martinsville and follow signs about 8 miles south of Martinsville to Morgan-Monroe State Forest. Assemble at the fire tower which is about 5 miles inside the forest from the entrance at 2:30 P.M. Moderate hike - about 5 miles. Leaders - Liz and Virgil Walls.
