- MAY 4 BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK. Leave the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take S.R. 135 to the Park and meet at the fire tower at 2:00 P.M. The hike will be about 6 miles - moderate and hilly. Leaders - the Retherfords
- MAY 8 CLUB SOCIAL. (Thursday night, 7:30 P.M. at the Indiana National Branch Bank, 5635 North Illinois St.) When asked to talk to our group, Dick Crum, area extension agent of horticulture from Purdue, made the statement, "I've heard such nice things about the Hiking Club and have always thought I'd like to talk to your group." With a combined education in horticulture and entomology, Dick Crum is a week-end camper by vocation. He will identify and describe some of Indiana's plant life that we might see during one of our hikes. Refreshments will be served.
- MAY 11 JACKSON STATE FOREST. Leave the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take U.S. 31 and I-65 south to the Seymour exit and go west on U.S. 50 about 13 miles to Brownstown.
