- JUNE 1 HIKE IN THE ZIONSVILLE AREA. This hike was covered in the May bulletin. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. About 5 miles of easy hiking. Leaders - Lou and Evelyn Bos. Plan for a cook-out afterwards.
- JUNE 8 TURKEY RUN STATE PARK. Leave the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take S.R. 36 west to Rockville. Turn right on U.S. 41 and go about 8 miles to S.R. 47. Turn right and go about 3 miles to the Park entrance. Reassemble at 2:30 P.M. in the main picnic parking lot near the commissary. There will be a \$1.25 per car admission charge. About 5 miles of very scenic moderate to rugged hiking. Excellent place for a cook-out afterwards. Leader - Kate Wicker.
- JUNE 15 MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK. Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take highway 67 south to Spencer. Turn east on S.R. 46 and go three miles to the park entrance. There will be a \$1.25 per car admission charge. Hike will begin at 2:30 P.M. from the Redbud shelter which is near the main picnic area and parking lot. About 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Leader - Janice Wright.
- JUNE 22 RACCOON LAKE. Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take S.R. 36 approximately 50 miles west. Go across the Mansfield Reservoir bridge and turn left into Raccoon Lake Park. There will be a \$1.25 per car admission charge. Continue to parking lot near bait house. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. Those desiring refreshments after the hike, meet at the restaurant right outside park entrance. About 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. There is boating and other activities available for those who wish to come early. Leader - Juanita Lauth.
- JUNE 29 PINE HILLS NATURAL AREA. Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take I-74 to the Jamestown exit. Then follow S.R. 234 nearly to Shades State Park, S.R. 234 makes a right turn to the north. Follow it 3/4 miles north to the sign for the PINE HILLS NATURAL AREA. Park on both sides of the road. About 5 miles of rugged hiking through a beautiful wild area near Shades State Park. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. Bring a trail lunch and water for a picnic along Sugar Creek. Leader - Ed Lavagnino.

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- JULY 6 TOUR THROUGH OLDFIELDS AND GROUNDS. Leave the State House at 1:15 P.M. Go north on Illinois St. to 38th St. Turn left (west) on 38th St. and continue to U.S. 421. Turn right (north) on U.S. 421 and continue to the entrance to Oldfields, which is at 42nd St. Oldfields is the Lilly mansion which is being restored to its original state, and is used as an art museum. A guided tour has been arranged for promptly at 2:00 P.M. at the cost of \$1.00 per person. There will be a short hike around the grounds following the tour. Leader - Geneva Ryan.
- JULY 13 TULIP TREE TRACE. Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take S.R. 135 south to Nashville, then go west on S.R. 46 about 6 miles to road leading to Yellowwood State Forest. Turn right at the State Forest sign and follow winding road approximately 3 miles to the Boy Scout Camp parking area at the north end of Yellowwood Lake. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. About 2 hours of moderate to rugged hiking. Leader - Lee Ramborger.
- JULY 20 HIKE AROUND HOLIDAY LAKE - SOUTH OF CRAWFORDSVILLE. Leave the State House promptly at 1:00 P.M. and reassemble at Lake Holiday office north of dam at 2:30 P.M. Take I-74 to Jamestown exit. Go west on S.R. 234 to U.S. 231. Go north on U.S. 231 approximately 2 miles. Turn left to New Market and follow signs to Lake Holiday. There will be 4 to 5 miles of easy hiking, and a cook-out following the hike. Bring folding lawn chairs for lounging. Swimming is available. Leader - Vic Knarr.
- JULY 27 CLIFTY FALLS STATE PARK. Leave the State House at 12:00 noon. Take I-74 southeast to the Greensburg exit, then take S.R. 421 south to Madison. Turn right (west) on road 107 just before you get to Madison and follow signs to park entrance. There is a \$1.25 entrance fee per car at the park. Meet at the concession stand in the main picnic area just inside the entrance. The hike will start at 2:30 P.M. There will be approximately 6 miles of rugged hiking. This is a nice place for a cook-out following the hike. Leaders - Liz and Virgil Walls.
- JULY 17 ANNUAL HIKING CLUB PICNIC. (For Members and Their Families Only).
