- AUG 3 TOW PATH HIKE. - Assemble at the Holcomb Gardens on the Butler University campus at 2:30 P.M. For those using public transportation, take the North Meridian - Butler bus north from the circle. Easy hiking along the tow path south - about 5 miles. Leader - Walter Handy.
- AUG 10 NORTHEASTWAY PARK. - Leave the State House at 1:30 P.M. Take S.R. 37 northeast to Castleton. Turn directly north on the east side of Castleton on Masters Road. Go north about one mile. Turn west on 91st street for 1/2 mile and then south into the park. Park at the picnic area parking. Hike will begin at 2:30 P.M. Easy - about 3 to 4 miles. Leaders - Dora and Alois Buehler.
- AUG 17 VERSAILLEES STATE PARK. - Meet at the state house at 1:00 P.M. Take I-74 south-east to the Greensburg exit. Follow U.S. 421 to Versailles, then follow U.S. 50 about 2 miles east to the Park Entrance. There will be a \$1.25 per car entrance fee. Reassemble in the main picnic area parking lot at 2:30 P.M. About 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Leader - Bill Larrison
- AUG 24 GNAW BONE CAMP. - Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take S.R. 135 to Nashville. Go east out Nashville on S.R. 46 and 135, and about a mile past the entrance to Brown County State Park, S.R. 135 again turns south. Continue on south on S.R. 135 about 3 miles to the entrance to the GNAW BONE CAMP for Boys and Girls. About 4 miles of moderate hiking. Leader - John Williams. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M.
- AUG 30 and 31. LABOR DAY WEEKEND AT PENNYRILE FOREST STATE PARK (For members and their invited guests only) The reservation supplement ~~supplement~~ previously mailed to our members contained all the information pertaining to this overnight. If there are any questions, please contact Bill Larrison. The suggested routing was I-65 south through Louisville to Elizabethtown where you turn west on the Western Kentucky Parkway (a toll road). Follow this to the Dawson Springs exit, and follow road 109 about 10 miles to Pennyrile State Park. If you use this routing, the toll charges will be about \$2.50 one way, but you will save quite a good deal of time, by not following the old narrow winding roads. Please try to arrive by noon, so that we will be able to have our first hike at 2:00 P.M.

Sept 7 THE CHANKTANUNGI TRAIL - Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Drive northeast on Fall Creek Parkway to 79th street. Go east across the bridge and then north approximately 1-1/4 miles to where the road turns sharply east. Park along the road being careful not to block the gate. Start at 2:00 P.M., about 5 miles. Sept 14 SHADES STATE PARK - Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take I-74 northwest to the Jamestown exit. Go west on SR 234 to the Park. (There is a \$1.25 per car entrance fee). Meet in the main parking lot for a moderate hike of about 5 miles. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. Leader - Kate Wicker.

Sept 20 (Saturday) BUS TRIP TO ROBERT ALLERTON PARK. (For members and their invited guests) The attached brochure has all details. The bus holds only 41 passengers, and so this will have to be a first come first served basis.

Sept 28 HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST - Leave the State House at 8:00 A.M. Take SR 37 to Bloomington, then SR 46 left (east) about 3 or 4 miles. Turn right on SR 446 and proceed south to the causeway across Lake Monroe and meet in the parking lot at the south side of the causeway. We will leave this area at 9:45 A.M. and proceed by caravan to the hiking area, so DO NOT BE LATE or you will be left behind. Fairly rugged hike of about 14 miles. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leaders - Sylvia & Ken Retherford.

Oct 5 TUMBLING WATERS - (3 to 5 miles of hiking and exploration of Porters Cave.) Leave the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take I-70 southwest from Indianapolis to the Littlepoint exit. Go south on SR 42 to a point 1-1/2 miles south of Eminence where SR 42 turns to the west. Continue on south 4-1/2 miles to the park entrance. There is an entry fee of 50¢ for adults and 25¢ for children. For those going on the cave trip, bring a flashlight and some old shoes. Also we would appreciate any Coleman lanterns in order to help illuminate the cave. The cave is not muddy but the water is 8 to 10 inches deep in some spots. The cave is 800 feet long with an entrance at each end. Plan to picnic after the trip. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. Leader - Ed Lavagnino.
