OCT 4 ANNUAL CAVE HIKE - TUMBLING WATERS - Please refer to the September Schedule for the details of this hike. Leaders: Ed Lavagnino 291-4495 and Bob Archer 251-8554.

OCT 10-11 - OVERNIGHT AT SHAKAMAK STATE PARK - (For members and invited guests only)
NOTE: Our social chairman has requested that those who are coming to this overnight please bring some kind of costume and mask for a Halloween party Saturday evening in the recreation building. Hikes at 2:00 P.M. Sat. and 9:00 A.M. Sun.

OCT 18 CORDRY - SWEETWATER LAKES - Leave the east side of the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take either Rt 31 or Rt 135 south to Rt 252. Go east on 252 (if coming from Rt 135) or west on Rt 252 (if coming from Rt 31) to the road that goes south to Nineveh. Go south from Nineveh and follow the signs to the lakes. Meet in the parking lot at 2:30 P.M. There will be two hikes: a six mile hike around Cordry Lake, and a twelve mile hike around Sweetwater Lake. Leader - Joe Wilhelm 241-8824

OCT 25 WHITE RIVER HIKE - Leave the east side of the State House at 1:00 P.M. Travel north to 16th street, then west on 16th to the first traffic signal after Busch Stadium. This is East Riverside Drive. Turn right and go two blocks north to 18th St., turn left on to 18th street and travel west until the street turns north. Park in the two small parking lots on the west side of the road along the river. The hike will start in the general area of the parking lots at 1:30 P.M. We will hike north along the east side of the river to Oldfields, then back along the west side of the river along riverside and coffin golf courses. 4 to 5 miles of easy hiking. NOV 1 MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Leave the east side of the State House at 9:30 A.M. Take SR 37 south to about 8 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to the State Forest entrance. Assemble in the parking lot of the fire tower (about 5 miles inside the Forest). Hike to start at 11:00 A.M. Moderate to rugged - about 13 miles. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Bill Larrison 359 7538

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- Nov 8 CROOKED CREEK TRAIL - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 9:00 A.M. Take SR 135 south to Nashville, then SR 46 west 5.1 miles to the Crooked Creek sign on the right next to a Jehovah's Witness' church. Turn left or south at the church and go 2.7 miles to the parking place. One hike will be 5 miles and one will be 11 miles. Bring a trail lunch. Moderate to rugged hikes. Leaders: Mary Frances Milam & Jack Gainey.
- Nov 12 (THURSDAY EVENING) SOCIAL AND BUSINESS MEETING - (For members and their invited guests only) 7:30 P.M. at the Indiana National Bank branch at 5635 north Illinois street. There will be a short business meeting followed by a movie "Northwest Passage", a short travelog. This is a good place for our newer members to get acquainted. Refreshments will be served.
- Nov 15 KICKAPOO STATE PARK, ILLINOIS - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 9:00 A.M. Take I-74 west to Danville, Illinois (about 100 miles). Just past Danville there is an exit for Kickapoo State Park. Follow the signs to the State Park (a distance of 4 or 5 miles) Assemble at the shelter house in the picnic area of the park. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. This is an area of old strip mines which have been reforested. There will be a long hike of about 12 miles and a shorter hike will be available for those who desire it. Hikes to start at 11:30 A.M. - Nov 22 LAKE SANTEE - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 1:00 P.M. Take I-74 southeast to SR #3 exit, which is north of Greensburg. Go north on SR #3 two miles to the intersection of Rd 300 N and Base Road. Go 7.7 miles east to a four way stop where there is a machine shop. Lecher Brothers, on the N.E. corner. Turn north following a winding hilly road to a T intersection with a Lake Santee billboard and arrow pointing east. The lake is 2 miles east. You may be stopped and questioned at the entrance.
