- DEC 6 GNAW BONE CAMP - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 12:00 Noon. Take S.R. 135 south through Nashville, then east on #135 and #46 for about 4 miles. Turn south again on #135 and look for the Gnow Bone Camp sign on the left about 3 miles from where you left #46. Park in the camp area. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. 6 to 8 miles. Moderate. - DEC 12 ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests only) Brookside Park Community House. This is a couple of blocks west of Sherman Drive on the north side of 16th street. - DEC 13 HARDIN RIDGE AND ALLEN CREEK - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 9:00 A.M. Take SR #37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on the SR 46 bypass, and continue east on SR 46 about 2 miles to the intersection with SR #446. Go about 15 miles south on #446; you will cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway, go pass the Paynetown sign and the Allen Creek sign. There is a sign for Hardin Ridge at a very sharp turn around a grocery and bait shop that apparently takes you back towards the north. Proceed about 3 miles to the entrance of the Hardin Ridge Recreation Area. Park in the entrance. Hike will start at 11:00 A.M. About 12 miles - rugged. Bring trail lunch.
