- FEB 7 EAGLE CREEK PARK - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 1:15 P.M. Go north to 56th street. Take 56th street west to Reed Road. Go north on Reed Road to 62nd street, then west on 62nd to the park entrance. Meet at the shelter house about a mile inside the park. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. 4 miles - easy. - FEB 14 SARAH SHANK GOLF COURSE AND BEECH GROVE PARK.- Meet in the golf course parking lot at 2:00 P.M. (2901 South Keystone Ave. at the corner of Troy and Keystone) If you are taking a bus, use Beech Grove #23A and Keystone. Hike will be about 4 miles - easy. Leader: Grace Breimeir (787 8002).
- FEB 21 DUBOIS RIDGE - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 9:00 A.M. Take S.R. #135 south to Nashville. Go west on #46 about 6 miles to the sign for Yellowwood Forest. Turn right and follow the winding road to the steel bridge where you will turn left. Follow this narrow road to the north end of Yellowwood Lake and park in the Boy Scout camping area.
