- JUNE 6 GLENN MILLER PARK AND HAYES ARBORETUM, Richmond, Indiana. Take I-70 east to Richmond and exit Rd. #40 west to the park sign on the north side of the road and park near the rose garden. (Anyone wishing to view the new Whitewater Reservoir should take its exit and start earlier.) Lovely park for a picnic and a visit around the mini zoo before the 2 P.M. hike. We will walk to the adjoining Hayes Arboretum on Elks Road. Shady trails with many trees and plants identified, plus the services of a naturalist available at 3 P.M. should make this a pleasant 2½ hours. Regulations do not permit dogs. Afterwards, those wishing to dine, meet at Miller's Cafeteria on U.S. # 40 in Richmond before hitting the Interstate. Leaders: The Breimeirs 787-8002.
- JUNE 13 JACKSON STATE FOREST - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 12:30 P.M. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit. Then S.R. #50 west to Brownstown and then #250 about 3 miles to the State Forest entrance. Reassemble in the parking lot beyond the end of the lake at 2:30 P.M. About 9 miles of rugged hilly hiking (with a short side trip to the pinnacle - a beautiful overlook). There will also be a short hike. Bring food for a picnic lunch or a cook-out after the hike, as the beautiful lake is an ideal place for a get-together over a relaxing meal. - JUNE 20 CAMP ATTERBURY - Leave the east side of the Statehouse at 1:00 P.M. Take U.S. #31 south to the intersection with S.R. #252. Go west on #252 to the north entrance of Camp Atterbury. The leader will meet you there at 2:00 P.M. with further instructions. About 5 miles of brushy cross-country hiking. Wear long trousers and bring your canteen full, as no water is locally available. - JUNE 27 ZIONSVILLE - Meet at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Lou Bos, 5855 W. Cedar St., Zionsville. Take U.S. #421 northwest to #334, turn west into Zionsville and follow #334 as if going out of town. On the right you will see the Zionsville Christian Church; this is 4th street. One more block and you are at 6th street. Look for the Hiking Club sign. 7 miles of moderate hiking.
