- 7 and 8 (SATURDAY AND SUNDAY) BACKPACK TRIP - This overnight backpacking into Hoosier National Forest will start at 10:00 A.M. Saturday from the Ransburg Boy Scout Reservation. Allow 2 hours driving time from Indianapolis. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on SR 46 bypass and continue east about 2 miles to the intersection with SR 446. Go about 15 miles south on #446 (you will cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway) and proceed about 1/2 miles and turn right at the 2nd road on the right side and follow the Ransburg Boy Scout Reservation signs. Assemble in the parking lot at 10:00 A.M. Saturday. Please call the leader, Libby Moore, at 852 4717 if you need information about equipment or food necessary for the trip.
- OCT 8 CORDRY-SWEETWATER LAKES - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take either Rt 31 or Rt 135 south to Rt 252. Go east on 252 (if coming from Rt 135) or west on 252 (if coming from Rt 31) to the road that goes south to Nineveh. Go south from Nineveh and follow the signs to the lakes. Meet in the parking lot at 2:30 P.M. There will be two hikes; a six mile hike around Cordy Lake, and a twelve mile hike around Sweetwater Lake. Leader: Joe Wilhelm.
- OCT 14 and 15 OVERNIGHT AT SHAKAMAK STATE PARK - (For members and their invited guests only) A reservation supplement giving all details was mailed last month. For further information please call Ted Fields at 253 7187. NOTE: We plan a Halloween party Saturday evening in the recreation building. Please try to bring some kind of costume and mask. Hikes to be at 2.00 P.M. Sat and 9:30 A.M. Sun.
- OCT 22 DUBOIS RIDGE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 9:00 A.M.. Take SR 135 south to Nashville. Go west on #46 about 6 miles to the sign for Yellowwood State Forest. Turn right and follow the winding road to the steel bridge where you turn left. Follow this narrow road to the north end of Yellowwood Lake and park in the parking area at the Boy Scout camping area. Hike to start at 10:30 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. Trail could be muddy - be prepared. 10 miles - moderate. Leader - Peg Franzen 546-3185
- OCT 29 HAYES ARBORETUM - (Richmond, Indiana) Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:30 PM. Take I-70 east to Richmond and exit at the West US 40 exit. Go west about 1-1/2 miles to Elks Road where you will see a sign for Hayes Arboretum. Turn right on Elks Road and go a few blocks north to the entrance. Assemble in the parking lot at the Nature Center at 2:00 PM. About 5 miles of easy hiking. In our Hoosier accent on ecology, Hayes Arboretum is among the leaders. There are restaurants nearby for those who wish to eat supper before heading for home. Leader: Nell Larrison 359 7538
- NOV 5 CLARK STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 AM. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit (about 95 miles) Follow State Forest signs to the entrance which is about 1/2 mile north of Henryville on US 31. Meet in the parking area in the campground, which is about a mile from the entrance. (Do not go across the interstate on the forest bridge). The main hike will be 16 miles, with a shorter 9 mile hike also available. Rugged and hilly. Bring a trail lunch and water. Both the short hikes and long hikes will eat lunch together before separating. Hike to start at 10:00 AM. Leader: Jack Gainey 359-6492.

- NOV 26 RING OF TREES TRAIL - SOUTHWESTWAY PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:30 PM. Take Madison Ave (Road 31) south to I-465 and go west to the Mann Road exit. Those people should continue to #37 exit south and go south to Southport Road. Then turn right (west) to Mann Road, then south to the golf course parking lot.)
