- FEB 11 GOSE CREEK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take SR #37 south to Morgan-Monroe State Forest (about 8 miles south of Martinsville). Meet at the fire tower parking lot at 2:00 P.M. About 5 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Bill Flora - phone 898 0760. (NOTE: If road conditions are bad because of snow, the meeting place at the forest may be changed to Bryant Creek which is just inside the entrance, and there will be somebody there to direct hiking club members)
- FEB 18 WOODS AND FIELDS HIKE AT EAGLE CREEK RESERVOIR - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:15 P.M. Proceed north to 56th street by the route of your choice. Go west on 56th to Eagle Creek reservoir and assemble in the parking lot of west side of the causeway. The hike will begin at 2:00 PM. 6 miles - moderate. Leaders: Ed Lavagnino (phone 291-4495) and Bob Hosley.
- FEB 25 LANTERN HILL - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:15 P.M. Reassemble at the Carl Williams home, 8845 Westminster Court, at 2:00 P.M. To reach their home, take Illinois or Meridian north to Fall Creek and follow it northeast to Lantern Road. (This is a couple of miles northeast of Shadeland Avenue). Turn left on Lantern Road, go to the second street (which is Briarcliff). Turn right one block and then turn left again on Westminster Court. Park in the court or in the Williams' driveway. 4 to 5 miles - easy. Leaders: Carl and Marie Williams. Phone - 849-1344.
- MAR 4 COFFIN AND RIVERSIDE GOLF COURSES - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:30 P.M. Drive to White River and 30th street and assemble at 2:00 P.M. on the west side of White River just north of 30th street. About 4 miles - easy. Leader: Tom Hill (Phone 784 2784)
