- OCT 28 NEW PALESTINE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:15 P.M. Take S.R. #52 southeast to New Palestine. There is a sign for the High School in the center of town. - N 4 CLARK STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 A.M. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit (about 95 miles). Follow state forest signs to the entrance which is about 1/2 mile north of Henryville on U. 31. Meet in the parking lot in the campground, which is about a mile in from the entrance. (Do not go across the interstate bridge). The main hike will be 16 miles, with a shorter 9 mile hike. Rugged and hilly. Bring a trail lunch and water. (Also raingear). Both the short hike and the long hike will eat lunch together, before separating. Hikes to start at 10:00 A.M. Leader: Jack Gainery 359 6492.
- NOV 8 SOCIAL AND BUSINESS MEETING - (For members and their invited guests) 7:30 P.M. at the Indiana National Branch Bank, 5635 North Illinois Street. Regular business meeting followed by entertainment to be announced later. Come on out and help your club grow. Refreshments will be served.
- NOV 11 GOSE CREEK HIKE - Take S.R. 37 south to about 8 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to the State Forest entrance. Assemble in the parking lot of the fire tower (about 5 miles inside the forest). Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. Moderate to rugged - about 5 miles. Leader: Bill Flora 898 0760 (Wear good footwear !!)
- NOV 18 CROOKED CREEK - SALT CREEK TRAIL - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:30 A.M. Take S.R. #135 south to Nashville and then S.R. #46 west 5.1 miles to the Crooked Creek road. Watch mileage, as road sign had been removed at last report. An old one room white building that was a church sits on the right and the road goes left, to the south. Go 2.7 miles to the parking area to the left of the road, which is below the Crooked Creek dam. About 15 miles of moderate to rugged hiking. Bring water and a trail lunch and equipment for bad weather. Hike to start at 10:00 A.M. Leader: Ted Fields 253 7187
- NOV 25 CLEAN-UP HIKE IN THE MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Meet at the Bryant Creek Lake picnic area at 1:00 P.M. Just inside the west entrance to the State Forest on old State Road # 37, a few miles south of Martinsville. If you turn east of new 37 at top of grade south of Martinsville, you can get on old 37. This is a joint meeting with the Sierra Club.. Litter bags will be furnished. About 5 miles of hiking. Leader: Ken & Sylvia Retherford 898 9746.
- DEC 2 HARDIN RIDGE AND ALLEN CREEK - Leave Indianapolis at 9:00 A.M. Take SR #37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on the SR 46 by-pass, and continue east about 2 miles to the intersection with SR #446. Go about 15 miles south on #446; you will cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway, go past the Paynetown sign and the Allen Creek sign. There is a sign for Hardin Ridge at a very sharp turn around a grocery and bait shop that apparently take you back towards the north. Proceed about 3 miles to the entrance of the Hardin Ridge Recreation Area. Park in the entrance. Hike will start at 11:00 A.M. About 10 miles - rugged. Bring trail lunch. Leaders: Ken and Sylvia Retherford.
