- DEC 9 HILLS OF GALLAHUE - Leave Indianapolis at 8:00 A.M. Take road 135 south to Bean Blossom. Turn right on SR 45 and go through Helmsburg to Trevlac, where you turn right and go over the railroad track. Continue on this gravel road which soon T's with another gravel road. Turn left and continue less than 2 miles to sign on your left for Gallahue Valley Girl Scout Camp. Assemble inside camp at the parking lot in front of the lake. Hike to start at 10:00 A.M.
