- FEB 2 and 3 OVERNIGHT AT POKAGON STATE PARK - (For members and their invited guests only)
Details were contained in the reservation supplement previously mailed to our members. The hotel has requested that we do not check in before 2:00 P.M. Therefore come dressed for hiking, as we will have a hike around 2:00 or 2:30 Saturday. NOTICE TO THOSE RIDING THE BUS: The bus will leave the Greyhound Bus Station at 9:00 A.M. Sharp - Do not be late. Try to be there about 15 minutes ahead of time. Also bring a sack lunch to eat on the bus as we probably won't arrive at the Park in time for lunch. The bus will leave from Gate # 16 at the station. WEAR YOUR NAME BADGES.
- FEB 10 INDIANAPOLIS MOTOR SPEEDWAY - Take west 16th street to the parking lot of the Speedway Museum at the northeast corner of 16th and Georgetown Road. After a hike around the grounds, we will visit the Museum. Hike to begin at 2:00 P.M. 3 to 4 miles - easy. Leader: Nell Larrison 359-7538.
- FEB 16 MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - (Note: This is a SATURDAY hike) Leave the parking lot of the State House at 9:00 A.M. Take S.R. #37 south to about 7 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left on the old road at the State Forest sign and go about 4 miles to the State Forest entrance. Turn left into the State Forest and assemble in the parking lot of the fire tower which is about 5 miles inside the forest. Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. Moderate to rugged - 8 to 10 miles. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Bill Flora 898-0760.
- FEB 24 SPEEDWAY - EAGLE CREEK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:15 P.M. Go via West 10th Street to High School Road (6200 west). Turn north to 1501 North High School Road. Meet in the parking lot of the Westwood Country Club. Hike will start at 2:00 P.M. There will be a moderate hike along Eagle Creek and woods. Leaders: Odie and Phyllis Cassetty 244-9913. The hike will be about 5 miles.
- MAR 3 COFFIN AND RIVERSIDE GOLF COURSES - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:30 P.M. Drive to White River and 30th street and assemble at 2:00 P.M. on the west side of white river just north of 30th street. About 4 miles - easy. Leader: Tom Hill 784 2784
- MAR 10 BOY SCOUT CAMP BRADFORD - Leave the State House at 1:15 P.M. and go southwest on Kentucky Avenue (Road #67). Beyond Brooklyn, after passing drive-in theater on the left side of Road 67, turn right on a black top road (approximately 23 miles from the the State House). Continue on winding road to Richard General Store and turn right proceeding 1.6 miles to camp. Hiking starts at 2:15 P.M. There is a nearby restaurant on Road 67 for refreshments afterwards. MAR 24 **GEIST RESERVOIR** - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:30 P.M. Proceed by the route of your choice to the intersection of SR #67 (Pendleton Pike) and Post Road. Go northeast on Pendleton Pike about 1-1/2 miles to the yellow flasher at Sunnyside Road. Turn left (north) and go several miles to where the road makes a sharp bend to the right. A little ways north of 81st. Park in small area there, or alongside the road. Do not block the gate or road. Hike to start at 1:30 P.M. About 5 miles of moderate to rugged hiking.
