



THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB
August & September, 1974

- AUG 4 MARY GRAY BIRD SANCTUARY - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take route of your choice to Rushville. Do not take SR 52 as the bridge is out at Morristown. One suggested route is I-70, ^{miles} east to SR 3 then south to Rushville. Go east from Rushville on SR 44 about 12 to a small sign for the Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary on the right side of the road. Turn right on 525 W and continue south to 150 S, then left to 450 W, and then right to the sanctuary entrance. Park in the parking lot, and the hike will start at 2:00 P.M. 4 miles of easy hiking on a well shaded trail. Shorts not advised because of nettles. A picnic area is available. Leader: Win Pulsifer (784-1835).
- AUG 11 MISSISSINEWA TRAIL - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 10:00 A.M. Take U.S. 31 north to Peru, Ind. Best to follow business 31, US 24. Turn right at highway #21 Immediately across bridge turn left (Highway 124). Go about 7-1/2 miles to road 675 E. Turn right about 2 miles to "T". Turn right and in a short distance you will see a phone booth on the left. Turn into the far parking area. Bring water. (Either eat before the hike or bring food to eat on the trail, as we will not stop for a lunch break). Hike to start at 12:30 P.M. SHARP!! BE ON TIME !! About 12 miles - moderate to rugged. Leaders: Harrison and David Feldman (251-0562).
- AUG 18 MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:00 P.M. Take highway 67 south to Spencer. Turn east on SR #46 and go a couple of miles to the Park entrance. There will be a \$1.25 per car admission charge. Hike will begin at 2:30 P.M. Assemble in the parking area near the Canyon Inn. About 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Odie Cassetty (244-9913)
- AUG 25 NEBO RIDGE HIKE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 11:00 A.M. Take SR 135 south through Nashville and then go east on #135 and #46 far about 4 miles. Follow #135 south to Story (15 miles from Nashville). Assemble in the parking lot of the general store. Hike to start at 1:00 P.M. (10 miles of moderate to rugged hiking). Leader: John Williams (253-5710)
- AUG 31, SEPT 1 and 2 - LABOR DAY WEEKEND AT HUESTON WOODS STATE PARK - (For members and their invited guests only). The reservation supplement for the overnight was mailed previously to our members. For information please contact Ted Fields at 253 7187.
- SEPT 8 MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take SR 37 south to about 7 miles wouth of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to the entrance to the Forest. Turn left into the State Forest and drive to the fire tower (about 5 miles from the entrance). Assemble in the parking lot at the fire tower at 1:30 P.M. for about 10 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Bill Flora (898-0760)
- SEP 12 (THURSDAY EVENING) ELECTION OF OFFICERS, BUSINESS MEETING AND SOCIAL - (For members and their invited guests only.) 7:30 P.M. Thursday evening at the Indiana National Bank branch at 5635 north Illinois. John Williams will present his slides of a trip to South America, showing much of the ancient civilization of the Andes. - SEP 15 RANSBURG BOY SCOUT RESERVATION - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:30 P. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on SR 46 bypass and continue east about 2 or 3 miles to the intersection with SR 446. Go about 15 miles south on 446, you will cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway, and proceed about 1/2 mile and turn right at the second road on the right side and follow the Ransburg Boy Scout Reservation signs. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. About 5 miles- rugged. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717)
- SEP 22 JACKSON STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit. Take US 50 west to Brownstown and then SR 250 south about 3 miles to the Jackson State Forest entrance. Assemble in the parking lot beyond the end of the lake at 2:30 P.M. About 9 miles of rugged hiking. Bring food for a picnic lunch after the hike (either cold food or else something to cook out). There will be a short hike available also, so come on down and visit the beauty of this forest. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
- SEP 28 & 29 -CAVE RIVER VALLEY - MEET WITH THE HOOSIERGROUP OF THE SIERRA CLUB - Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit, then US 50 west to Brownstown, then SR 135 south to Salem then SR 60 west to Campbellsburg. Turn north in the center of town and go about 3 miles and watch for signs to Cave River Valley. There are 7 caves to explore, surface hiking, and trout fishing. (You pay for what you catch by the inch). The Sunday hike will start at 1:30 P.M. - about 4 miles easy. Come early and bring a picnic lunch. Camping is available and some plan to come Saturday and camp overnight. It is about 2-1/2 to 3 hours drive from Indianapolis. Ed Lavagnino will lead a cave hike on Saturday afternoon. The shelter has been reserved Saturday from 3:00 to 7:00 P.M. for those who wish to catch and cook trout. An entrance fee of 25¢ per car and 25¢ per person is charged. There is also a camping fee. Tents and small trailers can be handled. Leaders: Ken & Sylvia Retherford (898 9746)
