NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS: Yearly membership dues are now payable. Please pay promptly according to rate schedule below in order that you may be included in our roster of active members to be published as of January 1, 1975.

- OCT 6 MORGAN-MONROE TO BEAR LAKE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 9:30 A.M. Take S.R. 37 south a few miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to entrance to the Forest. Turn left into Morgan-Monroe State Forest and assemble in the parking area at the Tulip Tree Trace, about 4 miles from entrance, at 11:00 A.M. Moderate to rugged 10 to 12 mile hike. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Glenn Norris (852 4234)
- OCT 12 & 13 OVERNIGHT AT SHAKAMAK STATE PARK -(For members and their invited guests only.) Plan for a pitch-in dinner at 6:00 P.M. in the Log Cabin recreation building. Bring food to contribute (a covered dish, or a salad, or desert according to the size of your family or group). The club will furnish paper plates, plastic utensils, and the drinks. Following the meal, we will have an evening of fun and entertainment. For more information please call Bill Larrison at 359 7538.
- OCT 20 FLAT ROCK RIVER YMCA CAMP - Take I-74 southeast past Shelbyville to the St Paul exit. Continue on southeast on S.R. 421 about a mile and a half. Turn right on first road you come to, and then right again after a short distance. Go about a mile or two to the camp entrance. Assemble in parking area near the cabins at 2:00 P.M. for about 5 to 6 six miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
- OCT 27 CORDRY-SWEETWATER LAKES - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take U.S. 31 south to S.R. 252 (a few miles south of Franklin). Turn right (west) and go about 3 or 4 miles to the road that goes south to Sweetwater Lakes and Nineveh. Turn left and go south on through Nineveh and past the Princes' Lakes to the entrance to Cordry-Sweetwater. Meet in the parking lot at 1:30 P.M. for a 5 miles hike around Cordry Lake, or a 10 mile hike around Cordry and Sweetwater lakes. Leader: Joe Wilhelm.
- NOV 3 CLARK STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 7:30 A.M. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit (about 95 miles). Follow State Forest signs to the entrance which is about 1/2 mile north of Henryville on U.S. 31. Assemble in parking lot in the campground about a mile from the entrance. (DO NOT go across the interstate bridge) The main hike will be 16 miles, with a shorter 9 mile hike. Both are rugged and hilly. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Hikes to start at 10:00 A.M. Leader: Peg Franzen (546 3185)
- NOV 10 HILLS OF GALLAHUE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 A.M. Take S.R. 135 south to Bean Blossom. Turn right on S.R. 45 and go to Trevlac. Turn right and go over the railroad tracks. Continue on this gravel road which soon "T's" into another gravel road. Turn left and go less than 2 miles to sign on the left for Gallahue Valley Girl Scout Camp. Assemble at the parking lot in front of the dam. Hike to start at 10:00 A.M. Moderate to rugged - a 6 mile and a 10 miles hike. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Libby Moore (852 4717)
- NOV 14 (THURSDAY EVENING) - CLUB SOCIAL AND BUSINESS MEETING. (For members and their invited guests only) 7:30 P.M. at the Indiana National Bank Branch at 5635 North Illinois. The speaker for the evening will be Robert "Bugs" Armstrong - one of the leaders of the Indiana Spelunkers. His slides of cave explorations and his narration of problems encountered in exploration of caves should make this a most interesting evening. Refreshments will be served.

- NOV 17 (NEW HIKE) IN BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 10:00 A.M. Take S.R. 135 south to Nashville, and turn East on S.R. 46 to the North Park entrance, and proceed, bearing to the left, for approximately 1/2 mile to the parking lot of the Riding Stables. Hike to start at 11:00 A.M. Be prepared for briar, and 8 to 9 miles of moderate to rugged hiking. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leaders: Ken & Sylvia Retherford (898 9746)
- NOV 24 SPRING MILL STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take S.R. 37 south through Martinsville, Bloomington, and Bedford to Mitchell. Turn east on S.R. 60 about 6 miles to the park entrance. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. About 5 miles - moderate. Leaders: Harrison & David Feldman (251 0562)
- DEC 1 RILEY TRAIL - Take U.S. 40 (Washington Street) east to Greenfield. Turn north on SR 9. Go about 2 miles to road 200 N. Turn right (east) and go about 1/2 mile to a parking area on the north side for a private fishing lake. Hike to start at 1:30 P.M. We will hike along historic Brandywine creek to the Irving Game farm and return. About 7 miles of easy to moderate hiking. Will have to climb stiles over several fences. Be prepared for mud. Trail fee 25¢ each. Leader: Nell Larrison (359 7538)
