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- DEC 7 (SATURDAY) ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests only). - DEC 8 WEED PATCH HILL - Leave the east side of the State House at 7:30 A.M. and take SR 135 south to Brown County State Park. Meet at the Fire Tower in the Park at 9:00 A.M. for about 16 miles of rugged hiking. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Dr. Ray DeFalque (291 8059) NOTE: There will be a leader for a shorter hike also.
- DEC 15 WASHINGTON PARK AND ZOO - 3120 East 30th Street. Meet in the parking lot at 4:00 P.M. for a short hike around Washington Park followed by a visit to the Zoo, which will be decorated for the holiday season. Admission 50¢ includes a ride on the train. Leader: Nell Larrison (359 7538)
- DEC 22 WOODS, FIELDS, AND SHORELINE OF WESTERN EAGLE CREEK RESERVOIR - Proceed north to 56th street by the route of your choice. Go west on 56th to Eagle Creek reservoir and assemble in the parking lot on the west side of the causeway. Hike will begin at 1:30 P.M. 8 miles - moderate. Leaders: Ed Lavagnino (291 4495) and Bob Hosley.
- DEC 29 ARBUCKLE ACRES PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:30 P.M. Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right for one mile to Arbuckle Acres entrance on the right and on this side of the railroad tracks. Go nearly to the end of the lane and use the parking lot on the right. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. About 3 to 4 miles - easy. Bring wieners & buns for a cook-out after the hike. Drinks will be furnished. Leader: Libby Moore (852 4717)
- JAN 5 FALL CREEK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:30 P.M. Go northeast on Fall Creek Parkway to Keystone ave. Meet in the parking lot on the northeast corner of intersection at 2:00 P.M. 6 miles - easy. Leader: Joe Wilhelm.
- JAN 12 THATCHER COMMUNITY LEVEE HIKE - Take West Michigan St. to 4200 block, turn left (south) at automatic signal onto Roena St. Cross the Eagle Creek bridge, then turn right onto Vermont St. to the Thatcher Community Center, 4649 W. - JAN 19 GNAW BONE CAMP - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take SR 135 south through Nashville, then east on #135 and #46 for about 4 miles. Turn south again on #135 and look for Gnow Bone Camp entrance on the left about 3 miles from where you left #46. Park in camp area. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. 6 to 8 miles. Moderate. - JAN 26 SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:15 P.M. Go southeast on I-74 to the Pleasant View exit, turn left at the T in town and go approximately 1/2 mile to parking lot of the Bank. Hike to start at 2:00 PM. 5 miles - easy. Leaders: Alois & Dora Buehler (786 0380)
