Schedule for -- August and September, 1975

PLEASE: No pets on hikes

- AUG 3 MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Take SR 37 south to about 7 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to the entrance to the forest. Turn left and drive about 5 miles to the fire tower. Assemble in the parking lot of the fire tower at 2:00 PM for about 5 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538)
- AUG 10 FOREST PARK HIKE AND SWIM AT MORSE RESERVOIR BEACH - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:00 P.M. Go north on SR #37 to Noblesville where we will reassemble at 2:00 P.M. at the south entrance to the Court House. We will then proceed to Forest Park and over to the dam and beach at Morse Reservoir. We will then return to Forest Park for a cook-out. Bring your own food. Hike will be about 5 to 6 miles. Leader: Vic Knarr (773-3149) (Don't forget your bathing suits)
- AUG 17 HICKORY RIDGE FIRE TOWER - (This is a new hike for the club). Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:30 A.M. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington, then east on SR 46 by-pass about 2 miles to the intersection with SR 446. Go about 15 miles south on #446; you will cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway, go past the Paynetown sign and the Allens Creek sign and the Hardin Ridge sign. Stay on #446 and about 1/2 mile past the Hardin Ridge sign you will come to Tower Road. Turn left and go about 6 miles on Tower road to the Hickory Ridge Fire Tower. Park in the parking lot there, and hike will start at 10:30 A.M. About 8 miles - moderate to rugged. Bring trail lunch and canteen of water. Leader: Ted Fields (253-7187)
- G 24 MARY GRAY BIRD SANCTUARY - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take SR 52 to Rushville, then east on SR 44 about 12 miles to a small sign for the Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary on the right side. Turn right on 525 W and go south to 150 S then left to 450 W, and then right to the sanctuary entrance. Park in the parking lot, and the hike will start at 2:00 P.M. 4 miles of easy hiking on well shaded trails. Shorts not advised because of nettles. Leader: May Duckett (631-1523)

- SEP 7 METAMORA CANAL HIKE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 1:30 P.M. Take SR 52 southeast to Metamora. (about 20 miles past Rushville) Turn right and go into the town and assemble at the auto bridge over the canal in the center of town. Easy 3 miles. Hike to start at 3:00 P.M. Leader: Tom Hill (784-2784)
- SEP 11 (THURSDAY EVENING) ELECTION OF OFFICERS, BUSINESS MEETING AND SOCIAL - (For members and their invited guests only) 7:30 P.M. Thursday evening at the Indiana National Bank branch at 5635 N. Illinois. - SEP 14 DUBOIS RIDGE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 9:00 A.M. Take SR 135 south to Nashville. Go west on SR 46 about 6 miles to the sign for Yellowwood State Forest. Turn right and follow the winding road to the steel bridge where you turn left. Follow this narrow road to the north end of Yellowwood Lake and park in the parking area near the group camping area. Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Trail could be muddy. 10 miles - moderate. Leader: Peg Franzen (546-3185)
- SEP 21 WOODS, FIELDS, AND SHORELINE OF WESTERN EAGLE CREEK RESERVOIR - Proceed north to 56th street by the route of your choice. Go west on 56th to Eagle Creek reservoir and assemble in the parking lot on the west side of the causeway. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. About 5 miles - moderate. Leaders: Ed Lavagnino (291-4495) and Bob Hosley.
- SEP 27 and 28 CAVE RIVER VALLEY - MEET WITH THE HOOSIER GROUP OF THE SIERRA CLUB - Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit, then U.S. 50 west to Brownstown, then S.R. 135 south to Salem, then S.R. 60 west to Cambellsburg. Turn north in the center of town and go about 3 miles and watch for signs for Cave River Valley. There are 7 caves, surface hiking and trout fishing. (You pay for what you catch by the inch). The Sunday hike will start at 1:30 P.M. - about 4 miles. Come early and bring a picnic lunch. Camping is available for Saturday night. There is an entrance fee and also a camping fee. Tents and small trailers. Leaders: Ken & Sylvia Retherford (898-9746)
