Lets all wear bright colored clothing during the hunting season (Oct, Nov, & Dec)

- OCT 5 OVERLOOK TRAIL HIKE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 AM. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit and go west on US 50 about 13 miles to Brownstown. Turn left on SR 250 and go 1.7 miles to the sign for the Overlook. Turn right and follow signs to the No. 2 shelter on top of the ridge. Hike to start at 10:30 AM. Moderate, 8 to 9 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
- OCT 11 & 12 OVERNIGHT AT LINCOLN STATE PARK - (For members and their invited guests only). Details were contained in the reservation supplement previously mailed to the members. For information call Bill Larrison at 359 7538.
- OCT 19 SPRING MILL STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:00 noon. Take SR 37 south through Bloomington and Bedford to Mitchell. Turn east on SR 60 about 6 miles to the park entrance. Assemble in the Village parking lot at 2:30 PM for about 5 miles of moderate hiking. Leaders: Harrison & David Feldman (251 0562)
- OCT 26 SOUTH GROVE GOLF COURSE, RIVERSIDE PARK, AND LAKE INDY - Go west on 16th street to East Riverside Drive (traffic signal just west of the ball park). Go north two blocks and assemble in the parking lot of the South Grove Golf Course at 1:30 PM for about 4 miles of easy hiking. Leader: Tom Hill (784 2784).
- 2 HILLS OF GALLAHUE - Leave Indianapolis at 8:00 AM. Take SR 135 south to Bean Blossom. Turn right on SR 45 and go through Helmsburg and Trevlac, where you turn right and go over the railroad tracks. Continue on this gravel road to a "T" intersection with another gravel road. Turn left and go a couple of miles to the sign for the Gallahue Valley Girl Scout Camp. Turn left and assemble in the parking lot in front of the lake at 10:00 AM. There will be 2 moderate to rugged hikes - 6 miles and 10 miles. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Libby Moore (852 4717)
- NOV 9 CLARK STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 AM. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit (about 95 miles) Follow signs to the forest entrance which is about 1/2 mile north of Henryville on US 31. Meet in the parking area of the campground, about a mile inside the forest. (DO NOT DRIVE ACROSS THE INTERSTATE BRIDGE). Hike to start at 10:30 AM. Rugged and hilly - 9 mile loop. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
- NOV 13 (THURSDAY EVENING) GENERAL ASSEMBLY BUSINESS MEETING AND CLUB SOCIAL (For members and their invited guests). 7:30 PM Thursday evening at the Indiana National Branch Bank at 5635 N. Illinois St.. A short business meeting and discussion of the club's activities, followed by an interesting program. Refreshments will be served. A good time for newer members to learn more about the club and to meet informally with other members.
- NOV 16 THREE-LAKE HIKE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:30 AM. Take SR 37 south to about 7 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left onto old highway where there is a sign to Morgan Monroe State Forest. Go about 3 miles to the entrance to Morgan Monroe. Turn left into the forest and then immediately turn right to the parking lot for Bryant Creek Lake. Hike to start at 10:00 AM - 11 to 12 miles moderate. Bring a Trail lunch and water. - NOV 23 HARDIN RIDGE - Leave Indianapolis at 9:00 AM. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on SR 46 Bypass and go about 3 miles to the intersection with SR 446. Go south about 15 miles on SR 446 (past the causeway and Allen Creek sign). Follow signs to the entrance to Hardin Ridge Recreation Area. Park near the entrance. Hike to start at 11:00 AM. Moderate = about 8 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. Leaders: Ken and Sylvia Retherford. (898 9746)
- NOV 30 MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - Leave Indianapolis at 12:30 PM. Take SR 67 south to Spencer. Turn east on SR 46 and go a couple of miles to the Park entrance. Assemble in the parking area near the Canyon Inn at 2:00 PM for 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Bill Flora (898 0760).
