Schedule for June and July 1976

(PLEASE: NO PETS ON HIKES)

The officers and directors of the Indianapolis Hiking Club voted at the Board Meeting on May 20, 1976 to recommend the following increase in the "SHARE THE CAR EXPENSE". For people who ride with others and desire to help out with the cost of transportation, the suggested donation for gas is 2-1/2¢ per mile from each rider if there are 1 or 2 passengers, and 2¢ per mile from each if there are 3 or more. The Board feels that this is a realistic increase in view of the current **cost** of gas.

- JUN 6 SHADES STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:45 P.M. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go into Jamestown and then follow #234 west to the Shades Park entrance. Assemble in the parking area near the picnic area at 2:15 P.M. for about 5 miles of moderate hiking. Admission charge to the Park. Leader: Odie Cassetty (244 9913)
- JUN 13 MISSISSINewa TRAIL - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 9:00 A.M. Take US 31 north to Peru, Ind. Best to follow business 31, U.S. 24. Turn right at #21. Immediately across bridge turn left (highway 124). Go about 7-1/2 miles to road 675E. Turn right about 2 miles to "T". Turn right and in a short distance you will see a comfort station on the left. Turn into far parking lot. Hike to start at 11:00 A.M. Bring trail lunch and water. About 12 miles, moderate to rugged. Trail patch available. Leaders: Harrison & David Feldman. (251-0562)
- JUN 20 PINE HILLS NATURE PRESERVE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 12:30 P.M. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Turn left and follow SR 75 into Jamestown. Take SR 234 west almost to the Shades State Park where #234 turns sharply right. Follow this for about a mile north to the Pine Hills Parking area. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. - about 5 miles, rugged. Bring old shoes as we may have to do quite a bit of wading down the creek. Leader: Ed Lavagnino (291 4495).
- JUN 27 HARDIN RIDGE - Leave Indianapolis at 9:00 A.M. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on SR 46 Bypass and go about 3 miles to the intersection with SR 446. Go south about 15 miles on SR 446 about 15 miles (past the causeway and Allen Creek sign). Follow signs to the entrance to Hardin Ridge Recreation Area. Park at the Twin Oaks information center, about 1-1/2 miles from entrance. Hike to start at 11:00 A.M. Moderate to rugged - about 8 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Phil Lin. (251 2795)
- JUL 4 UPPER FALL CREEK - Meet in the parking lot of AFNB bank at 5500 north Emerson Way. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. About 5 miles - easy. Leader: John Behrmann (545 0293)
- JUL 11 VERSAILLES STATE PARK - Allow about 2 hours driving time from Indianapolis. Take I-74 southeast to the Greensburg exit. Then follow US 421 south to Versailles, and go east from Versailles on U.S. 50 about 2 miles to the entrance to the State Park. There will be an entrance fee. Follow the park road up the steep hill to the main picnic parking area. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. About 6 miles - some hilly and rugged - possibly down a creek bed. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
- JUL 18 WEED PATCH HILL - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 A.M. and take SR 135 south to Brown County State Park. Meet at the Fire Tower in the park at 9:30 A.M. for about 16 to 18 miles of rugged hiking. Bring a trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Ray DeFalque (291 8059)

JUL 25 ANNUAL HIKING CLUB PICNIC - (For members and their invited guests only)
 PLACE: EAGLE CREEK PARK. Proceed to west 56th street by route of your choice and the entrance is just east of the causeway. Entrance fee \$1.00 for cars with Marion County licenses, and \$2.00 for all others. We have reserved Shelter House "B" from 11:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. There is swimming, boating, and fishing in the reservoir. We plan to have a hike about 2:30 P.M. and our old-fashioned pitch-in dinner at 5:00 P.M. Bring food to contribute. Also your own table service and drinks. PLEASE USE ICE CHESTS TO PROTECT YOUR FOOD FROM THE HEAT!! Bring your favorite games and perhaps some folding chairs.
