Schedule for Oct and Nov 1976

(PLEASE: NO PETS ON HIKES)

- OCT 2 & 3 HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST BACKPACK - Please call Libby Moore (852 4717) if you are planning to go on this backpack. Allow 2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to SR 46, turn left and go to SR 446. Turn right and go south across causeway to Tower road. Turn left about 1/2 mile to Horseman's Camp. Hike to start at 11:00 A.M. Saturday. You will need food for 2 lunches, 1 breakfast, and 1 dinner. Should be back to the cars by 3:00 P.M. Sunday.
- OCT 3 MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - Take SR 67 south to Spencer. Turn east on SR 46 and go a couple of miles to the Park entrance. There will be a \$1.25 per car admission charge. Hike will begin at 2:30 P.M. Assemble in the parking area near the Canyon Inn. About 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Allow about 1-1/2 hours travel time from Indianapolis. Leader: Bill Flora (898 0760)
- OCT 9 & 10 OVERNIGHT AT BRADFORD WOODS - (For members and their invited guests only)
The reservation supplement was previously mailed to all the members. For further information please contact Bill Larrison (359 7538). This is our annual joint outing with our friends from the Louisville Hiking Club. If you haven't sent in your reservation, please do so at once.
- OCT 17 THREE-LAKE HIKE - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:30 A.M. Take SR 37 south to about 7 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left on the old highway at the State Forest sign and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left and then immediately right to the parking area for Bryant Creek Lake. Hike to start at 10:00 A.M. About 11 to 12 miles moderate to rugged. Bring a trail lunch and water. Leaders: Ed and Ralph Chambers (241 1555)
- OCT 24 HOOSIER NATIONAL FORESTS - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 7:30 A.M. Take SR 37 south to Forest route 1011 (about 142 miles) (approx 12-1/2 miles south of St. Croix). Turn left and go east and park at the Marchand Lookout Tower. Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. About 10 miles of moderate hiking. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Bob Hosley (251 5338)
- OCT 31 WOATIKANIKUK TRAIL - Take I-69 to SR 109 exit near Anderson. Go north to SR 32 (Third street). Turn left (west) past Anderson College and cemetery. Turn north on College Ave immediately after the cemetery. Turn left on High Street (west) to where 5 streets intersect. Turn diagonally into Fairgrounds. Park in front of the cattle barn. Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Bring trail lunch and water. About 12-1/2 miles - moderate. Leader: Bob Begeman (359 4174)
- NOV 7 YELLOW TRACE - Take SR 37 to Morgan-Monroe State Forest, about 7 miles south of Martinsville. (See directions for Oct 17). Meet at Yellowwood Trail Parking lot about 3 miles inside park entrance. Hike to start at 8:30 AM sharp DO NOT BE LATE!! Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time from Indianapolis. About 17 miles - moderate to rugged. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: George Newhall (844 0446)
- NOV 11 (THURSDAY EVENING) - GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETING AND CLUB SOCIAL - (For members and their invited guests only) 7:30 P.M. Thursday evening at the Indiana National Branch Bank at 5635 N. Illinois St. A short business meeting and general discussion of club activities. Films of a recent trip to Alaska will be shown by Bill Larrison. Refreshments will be served.

- NOV 14 CLARK STATE FOREST - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 8:00 A.M. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit (about 95 miles). Follow signs to the forest entrance which is about 1/2 mile north of Henryville on U.S. 31. Meet in the parking area of the campground, about a mile inside the forest. DO NOT DRIVE ACROSS THE INTERSTATE BRIDGE) Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. Rugged and hilly 9 mile loop. There may also be a longer hike. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Peg Franzen (546 3185)
- NOV 21 SPRING MILL STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 11:30 A.M. Take S.R. 37 south to Mitchell and S.R. 60 east to park entrance. Meet in Village parking lot at 2:00 P.M. About 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251 0562)
- NOV 28 BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Leave the parking lot of the State House at 9:30 A.M. Take S.R. 135 south to Nashville, and turn east on S.R. 46 to the North Park entrance. Proceed bearing to the left, for approximately 1/2 mile to the parking lot of the Riding Stables. Hike to start at 11:00 A.M. Be prepared for briar and 8 to 9 miles of moderate to rugged hiking. Bring a trail lunch and water. Leaders: Ken and Sylvia Retherford (898 9746)
