Schedule for April and May, 1977

PLEASE: NO PETS ON CLUB HIKES

- APR 10 PLEASANT RUN PARKWAY - Meet at the Christian Park Community Center (4200 English Ave.) Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. - 6 miles, easy. Leaders: Hazel Morrison & Doris Gard.
- APR 17 WHITEWATER CANAL TRAIL - Drive southeast on U.S. 52 to SR 121 about 55 miles from I-465. Turn left (north) to Laurel. On Pearl Street in Laurel turn right (east) and proceed across Whitewater River bridge to Dam Road, about 0.4 mile. Turn right (south) on Dam Road and drive 1.2 miles to the parking area at the feeder dam. ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED and limited to 40 hikers. Be sure to contact John Behrmann at 545-0293 for reservations. A fee of 50¢ or a package deal of fee and patch for \$2.00. Because of the need for a car shuttle, please be at the parking area at 9:00 A.M. SHARP. DO NOT BE LATE!! Bring trail lunch and water for a 12 mile moderate hike. Leaders: Harrison Feldman (251 0562) and John Behrmann (545-0293).
- APR 24 MORGAN'S FOREST HIKE - Take SR 37 south to about 7 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to the entrance to the Forest. Turn left and drive about 5 miles to the fire tower parking area. Hike to start at 9:00 A.M. - about 23 to 25 miles rugged. Bring trail lunch and water. There also will be a shorter hike of about 10 miles. Leader: George Newhall (844-0446)
- MAY 1 HILLS OF GALLAHUE - Leave Indianapolis at 9:00 A.M. Take SR 135 south to Bean Blossom. Turn right on SR 45 and go to Trevlac, where you turn right and go over the tracks. Continue on the gravel road to a "T" where you turn left and go a couple of miles to Gallahue Valley Girl Scout Camp. Assemble in the parking lot in front of the lake at 11:00 A.M. There will be 2 hilly and rugged hikes - one of 10 miles and a shorter one of 6 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- MAY 8 SOUTH GROVE GOLF COURSE, RIVERSIDE PARK AND LAKE INDY - Go west on 16th street to the first traffic signal after the ball park. This is East Riverside Drive. Turn north and go two blocks to 18th street, and meet in the parking lot of the golf course at 1:30 P.M. for an easy - 4 mile hike. Leader: Tom Hill (784-2784)
- MAY 12 (THURSDAY EVENING) - CLUB SOCIAL AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY - (For members and their invited guests only) 7:30 P.M. Thursday evening - at the Indiana National Branch Bank at 5635 N. Illinois St. A short business meeting and discussion of the activities and plans of the club. Joan Leibman will show slides and will give a talk on her Trek to the Base Camp of Mt. Everest. Sounds like a real interesting program - so come on out and join with us for this event. Refreshments will be served.
- MAY 15 BEANBLOSSOM LAKE HIKE - Take SR 37 south to about 7 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and follow the old road about 4 miles to the Forest entrance. Turn left and drive 2.7 miles to Beanblossom lake road (Note sign to the Beanblossom shelter house.) Drive about a mile to the parking area. Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. - about 10 miles, moderate. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Wear long pants. Leaders: Peggy Franzen (546-3185) and Ed Chambers (244-4554).
- MAY 22 OVERLOOK TRAIL HIKE - Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit and go west on U.S. 50 about 13 miles to Brownstown. Turn left on SR 250 and go 1.7 miles to the sign for the Overlook. Turn right, and then right again, following signs to the No. 2 shelter on top of the ridge. Allow 2-1/2 hours for drive. Hike to start at 10:30 A.M. - moderate 8 to 9 miles. Bring lunch & water. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
