SCHEDULE FOR OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER 1977

(PLEASE: NO PETS ON HIKES)

- OCT 8 and 9 CAMP RILEY OVERNIGHT (For members and their invited guests only). The reservation supplement for this joint meet with the Louisville Hiking Club was mailed to the members recently. For additional information please contact Bill Larrison at 359 7538.
- OCT 16 JACKSON STATE FOREST - (Allow 2 hours driving time). Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit, then west on US 50 to Brownstown. Take SR 250 south about 3 miles to Jackson State Forest, and assemble in the parking lot beyond the lake at 1:00 PM for about 8 or 9 miles of moderate to rugged hiking in the hills of the forest. There will be shorter hike available. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538).
- OCT 23 CLIFTY FALLS STATE PARK - Take I-65 south to SR 46 near Columbus. Go east to SR 7. Then go south to SR 62 near Madison. Go west to the Park entrance. Meet in the parking area just inside the north gate. Bring trail lunch and water. Moderate to rugged 10 miles. Allow 2 hours travel time from Indianapolis. Hike to begin at 10:30 AM. About 88 miles to Clifty Falls from Indianapolis. Leaders: Bonnie Wolfer (856 3853) and Steve Warner (353 9208).
- OCT 30 WOAPIKAMIKUNK TRAIL - Take I-69 to SR 109 exit near Anderson. Go north to Third street. Turn left (west) past Anderson College and cemetery. Turn north on College Avenue immediately after the cemetery. Turn left on High Street to where 5 streets intersect. Turn diagonally into Fairgrounds. Park in front of the cattle barn. Hike to start at 10:30 AM. Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Bring trail lunch and water. About 12-1/2 miles (20 km) moderate. Leader: Bob Begeman (359 4174)
- OCT 29 & 30 BACKPACK IN HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST - Libby Moore is the leader of this special club activity. If you are going, please contact her at 852 4717 for information and instructions. Meet at the Circle M Ranch at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday. Allow 2 hours driving time from Indianapolis. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Turn east on SR 46 bypass and continue a few miles to the intersection with SR 446. Go south about 15 miles and cross the causeway. The Circle M ranch is on the left about a mile past the causeway.
- NOV 6 BROOMSAGE RANCH - (Allow 2 hours travel time). Take I-65 south to US 50 (Seymour exit) Turn east to North Vernon, and then south on SR 7 about 7 or 8 miles to Broomsage Ranch. Watch for entrance on the left. There will be a fee of 50¢ per person. Park near the shelter house at the lake. About 5 miles of moderate hiking. Be prepared for muddy trails. Hike to start at 1:00 PM. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
- NOV 10 (THURSDAY EVENING) CLUB SOCIAL AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY - (For members and their invited guests only). Meet at 7:30 PM at our NEW MEETING ROOM - the Merchants National Bank branch at 5716 Crawfordsville Road. This is about 2 blocks east of I-465 in the Shopping Center. Enter through side door. We will have a short business meeting with a discussion of the activities and plans of the club. Our guest speaker for the evening will be Dr. Wesley Ward. He will have a film to accompany his talk on exercise and diet for the young at heart. We think you will find this most interesting.
- NOV 13 CLARK STATE FOREST - (Allow 2-1/2 hours driving time). Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit (about 95 miles). Follow signs to the forest entrance (about 1/2 miles north on US 31) Meet in the parking area of the campground. DO NOT DRIVE ACROSS THE INTERSTATE BRIDGE Rugged and hilly 9 mile to start at 10:30 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Peggy Franzen (546 3185). (There may also be a longer hike if anyone so desires)

- NOV 20 BEARS OF BLUE RIVER TRAIL - Take I-74 southeast about 20 miles to SR 9. Turn left (north) and drive one block to Morristown Road. Turn right and go 1/2 mile to WSVL radio station. Allow one hour driving time. Hike to start at 8:30 AM sharp due to car shuttle. Bring trail lunch and water for rugged 15 mile hike (24km). Be prepared for heavy undergrowth. Patch is available for one dollar. Leaders: Clifton Hoard (896 2129) and John Behrmann (545 0293).
- NOV 27 WHITEWATER STATE PARK - Take US 52 to Rushville, then SR 44 to Liberty, and then SR 101 south to Park entrance. Allow 2 hours travel time. Assemble in the beach parking lot at 10:30 AM for a 12 mile moderate hike (19.2 km). Bring trail lunch and water. There will also be a shorter hike of about 6 miles (9.6 km). Leader: Philip Lin (251 2795).
- DEC 4 TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours driving time. Take I-74 to the Jamestown exit, and then go south to Jamestown and take SR 234 west to SR 47. Turn left approximately 15 miles to the Park entrance. (Do not go through Rockville and US 41, as the bridge is out just west of the Park entrance.) Park near the tennis courts. Hike to start at 1:00 PM. About 8 miles of moderate to rugged hiking. (12.8 km). Leader: Marsha Hutchins (545 5672)
