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- DEC 11 ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY (For members and their invited guests only)
PLACE: Holliday Park Community House. Holliday Park is at the Southeast corner of Springmill Road and 64th Street. One route would be to take Meridian Street to 64th, and then left (west) to Springmill Road. The club has reserved from 2:00 PM until 6:00 PM
- ARRIVAL TIME: 2:00 P.M. We will have a pitch-in dinner to start at 2:30 P.M. Please be on time, and bring food for an old-fashioned pitch-in according to the size of your family. Bring your own plates and silverware. - DEC 18 WASHINGTON PARK AND ZOO - 3120 East 30th Street. Meet in the parking lot at 4:00 P.M. for a short hike around Washington Park followed by a visit to the zoo all decorated for the holiday season. - DEC 25 EAGLE CREEK PARK - Proceed by the route of your choice to the West 56th Street entrance to Eagle Creek Park (just east of the causeway). Meet in the parking lot on the right side of the road just past the gatehouse. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. About 5 miles (8 km) of easy hiking. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
- JAN 1 UPPER FALL CREEK - Meet in the parking lot of Fall Creek School, 4900 Kessler Blvd, East Drive (located between SR 37 and Emerson Way, next to Masonic Temple). Hike to start at 1:00 P.M. About 5 miles (8 km) easy. Leader: Marsha Fields (259 7933).
- JAN 8 NORTHEASTWAY PARK - Take Allisonville Road north to 91st street. Turn right (east) and go to the entrance of the park. Park on the right just south of the picnic area. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M.. About 4 miles (6.4 km) easy. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251 0562)
- JAN 15 HOLLIDAY PARK, WHITE RIVER, AND MAROTT PARK - Assemble at 12:45 P.M. at Holliday Park, 6349 Spring Mill Road, in the parking area just east of "THE RUINS" monument. Moderate hike of 8 miles (12.8 km), to start promptly at 1:00 P.M. Leaders: Rick Harris (255 3204) and Marsha Hutchins (545 5672)
- JAN 22 GRASSYFORK FISHERY HIKE - (Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time) Take SR 37 south to SR 252 (first stop light on Martinsville bypass). Turn right and go to "T". Turn left (west) on Morgan Street. Go 3 blocks to yellow blinker. Turn right on Home Avenue about 3 blocks to the Park. Meet at shelter house #1. Hike to start at 1:30 P.M. - about 7 miles (11.2 KM) - easy to moderate. Bring wieners and buns for a cook out after the hike. Leader: Clyde Fulkerson (1 342-4144).
- JAN 29 SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Go southeast on I-74 to the Pleasant View exit. Turn left (west) at the road in town and go 1/2 mile to the parking lot of the bank. Hike to start at at 2:00 P.M.. About 5 miles (8 km) easy. Leaders: Alois & Dora Buehler (786 0380)

FEB 5 ARBUCKLE ACRES PARK - Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right (south), and go about a mile to Arbuckle Acres Park entrance on the right (just before the railroad tracks). Go to end of lane and use the parking lot on the right. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. About 4 to 5 miles (6.4 to 8km) - easy. Bring wieners and buns for a wien roast after the hike.
