SCHEDULE FOR JUNE AND JULY, 1978

(PLEASE: NO PETS ON HIKES)

- JUN 11 SHADES STATE PARK - Allow 1½ hours travel time. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the Shades State Park entrance. Assemble in the parking area near the campground and picnic area at 2:30 P.M. for about 5 miles (8 km) of moderate hiking. Leader: Odie Cassetty (244 9913) Admission fee to park.
- JUN 18 INDIANA DUNES STATE PARK - Trip is about 165 miles. Allow 3½ hours driving time. Take I-65 north to I-94. Go east on I-94 about 14 miles to the Indiana Dunes exit (SR 49 north). Go north about 3 miles to the Park entrance. There will be an entrance fee. Assemble in the parking area by the Pavilion and Bath house at 10:15 A.M. There will be two moderate to rugged hikes of 8 to 9 miles (12.8 to 14.4 km) and 12 to 13 miles (19.2 to 20.8 km) in woodland, marsh, dune and beach. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. You may also wish to bring swimwear for a dip in Lake Michigan after the hike. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (545 5672).
- SATURDAY JUNE 24 HARRISON TRAIL - Allow 1-3/4 hours driving time. Drive northwest from Indianapolis on I-65 to SR 43 (approximately 70 miles). Turn left (south) on SR 43 and proceed one block to Prophet's Rock Road. Turn left and drive about 4 miles to North 9th Street Road. Turn right 1 block to Tippecanoe Battlefield Parking Lot. Trail runs along roads its entire length of 16 miles (25.6 km). There will be a car shuttle, beginning at 9:00 A.M. sharp!! Bring trail lunch and drinking water. A patch may be ordered for \$1.50. Leader: John Behrmann (545 0293)
2. WHITE RIVER - CANAL - Meet at the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple on Westfield Blvd. just east of College Ave. Hike will begin at 2:00 P.M. 5 miles (8 km) easy. Leader: George MacLean (896 5769)
- SATURDAY JULY 8 ANNUAL HIKING CLUB PICNIC - (For members and their invited guests only)
PLACE: DANVILLE PARK. Directions: Take SR 36 west to the park at the east edge of Danville. Plan to arrive between 1:00 and 2:00 P.M. and bring food to contribute to our old-fashioned pitch in dinner. We will plan to eat about 4:00 P.M. PLEASE USE AN ICE CHEST TO PROTECT YOUR FOOD FROM THE HEAT. Also bring your own drinks and table service (plates and utensils). Bring your favorite outdoor games and it might be nice to bring a folding chair or two. The club has reserved a shelter house for this event. We will try to have short hike in the area.
- JUL 9 TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours driving time. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and take SR 234 west to SR 47. Turn left and go about 15 miles to the Park entrance. There will be an admission fee. Park near the tennis courts. Hike to start at 2:30 P.M. About 5 miles of moderate to rugged hiking in the ravines of the park. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852 2439).
- JUL 16 RING OF TREES TRAIL - SOUTHWESTWAY PARK - Take U.S. 31 south to I-465 and then go west to Mann Road exit. Go south on Mann Road to Southwestway Park. (about 4 miles). NOTE: For those coming from the west on I-465, there is no exit for Mann Road. Those people should continue to SR 37 exit south and go south to Southport Road. Then turn right (west) across the river to Mann Road, and then south to the park. Meet in the golf course parking lot at 2:30 P.M. for about 5 miles (8 km) of easy hiking. Leaders: Grace & Joe Breimeir (787 8002)
- JUL 23 ATTERBURY FISH & WILDLIFE AREA - Allow 1 hour travel time. Take US 31 south to Hospital Road (There is a traffic light, and to the left is the town of Edinburg)/ Turn right and go about 1/2 mile. Just before the bridge, turn right on gravel road to the campground, and assemble here at 2:00 PM for about 6 miles (9.6 km) of easy to moderate hiking. Leader: Juanita Lauth (353 6325)

- JUL 30 GRASSYFORK FISHERY HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take SR 37 south to SR 252 (first stop light on Martinsville bypass). Turn right and go to "T". Turn left (west) on Morgan street. Go 3 blocks to yellow blinker. Turn right on Home Avenue about 3 blocks to the Park. Meet at shelter house # 1. Hike to start at 1:30 P.M. About 7 miles (11.2 km) easy to moderate. Leader: Clyde Fulkerson (1 342 4144).
- AUG 6 VERSAILLES STATE PARK - Allow about 2 hours driving time. Take I-74 southeast to the Greensburg exit. Then follow US 421 south to Versailles, and go east on US 50 about 2 miles to the Park entrance. There will be an entrance fee. Follow the park road up the steep hill to the main picnic parking area. Hike to start at 2:00 P.M. About 6 miles - moderate to rugged. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
