SCHEDULE FOR DECEMBER 1978 AND JANUARY 1979

- DEC 9 (SATURDAY) ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests only):
PLACE: North Liberty Christian Church, 6001 W. 52nd Street. Take either 38th street or 56th street to High School Road (6300 West). Go to 52nd Street and then go a block east of High School Road to the Church, on the south side of 52nd Street.
ARRIVAL TIME: 6:00 P.M. We will have a pitch-in supper to start at 6:30 P.M. Please be on time, and bring food for an old-fashioned pitch-in according to the size of your family group. Bring your own plates and silverware. The club will furnish hot and cold drinks and cups, napkins, and tablecloths. Hazel Morrison has planned the entertainment in keeping with the spirit of the season, including a choral group.
- DEC 10 COFFIN AND RIVERSIDE GOLF COURSES - Assemble at 2:00 PM on the west side of White River just north of 30th Street for about 4 miles (6.4 km) of easy hiking. Leader: Tom Hill 784 2784
- DEC 17 THERE WILL BE 2 HIKES A. DEVON WOODS B. INDPLS ZOO
(A) THE MEADOWS AND DEVON WOODS - Assemble in the parking lot of the Indianapolis Zoo, 3120 East 30th Street at 12:45 PM for a 7 to 8 mile easy hike (11.2 to 12.8 km) We will return to the Zoo by 4:00 PM so that those who wish may take the second hike. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (257-9437).
(B) WASHINGTON PARK AND INDIANAPOLIS ZOO - (3120 East 30th Street) Meet in the parking lot at 4:00 PM for a short hike around Washington Park followed by an optional visit to the Zoo which will be decorated for "Christmas at the Zoo". Admission at the gate will be 75¢ - however you may purchase advance sale tickets for 50¢ at the various branches of Indiana National Bank, Merchants National Bank, and American Fletcher National Bank. - DEC 24 EAGLE CREEK PARK - Proceed to the West 56th Street entrance of Eagle Creek Park (east of the causeway). Meet in the parking lot on the right side of the road just past the gatehouse. - JAN 14 WOODS, FIELDS, AND SHORELINE AT EAGLE CREEK RESERVOIR - Go west on 56th Street to the Eagle Creek Reservoir and assemble in the parking lot on the west side of the causeway. - JAN 21 INDIANAPOLIS MOTOR SPEEDWAY - Take West 16th street to the Speedway Museum entrance and park in the Museum parking lot. About 4 miles of easy hiking around the Speedway grounds and track.
